TECHNICAL SKILLS DAYS, 2010

Day 1

Follows a low risk scenario concentrating on correct referrals/consultations and documentation. Looking at legislation, standards, competencies and appropriate assessment in labour.

Day 2

Covers four obstetric emergencies; shoulder dystocia, cord prolapsed, breech and postpartum haemorrhage (PPH). The focus is on hands on learning, documentation, and communication related to the emergency.
