Purpose:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To provide a merit-based scholarship towards payment of postgraduate fees for an approved programme of study in the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences
Closing Date:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 12 noon, 13 January 2012
Amount and Type of Award	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The number of Effective Full Time Students (EFTS) supported by the Postgraduate Fee Scholarships is determined annually• Regardless of how many EFTS are offered annually, 1 EFTS will be set aside for applicants living with a disability or of Maori or Pacific Island descent. This represents the equity dimension of the scholarship• The value of each Postgraduate Fee Scholarship will vary according to the workload of the applicant• Each Postgraduate Fee Scholarship provides for full or partial tuition as well as the learner service levy of the papers the applicant is enrolled in. The Scholarship does not include the Students' Association Fee
Tenure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fees incurred in one calendar year (February-November)
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All applicants must be:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- NZ citizens or permanent residents- Enrolled in one or more papers for the current year in either<ul style="list-style-type: none">- PG coursework (including DHSc papers) OR- A thesis or dissertation component of the MHSc, M.App.Sci, MPH, MEmMgt, MSpEx, MPsychotherapy, MHPrac, MPhil OR- the BHSc (Hons) programme• Applicants wishing to apply for the equity dimension of this scholarship must also be:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Of Maori or Pacific Island descent or- A person assessed as having a physical, psychiatric, intellectual, sensory or age related disability (or a combination of these) which is likely to continue for a minimum of six months and result in a reduction of independent function to the extent that ongoing support is required. <p>PhD thesis candidates and DHSc thesis candidates are not eligible to apply for this scholarship. These students should consider applying for the FHES Doctoral Fee Scholarship</p>
Application requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applications are to be submitted using the Postgraduate Fee Scholarship Application Form, available from the Scholarships Office website; the AUT online website for FHES or the Faculty Research Administrator (Brigitte.vangils@aut.ac.nz)• Students applying for the equity dimension of this scholarship must complete the extra sections of the application form as indicated• The signed hard copy of the application is to be submitted along with:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Official course enrolment confirmation for 2012 - Academic transcript - If relevant, verification of Maori or Pacific Island descent or disability or impairment as indicated - Other information listed on the application form • Completed applications and supporting documents are to be submitted to the Scholarships Office, WB 102, Level 1, WB Building, Wellesley Campus • Incomplete or late applications or those without signatures will not be considered
<p>Selection Process</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Scholarships will be reviewed and awarded by the FHES Faculty Contestable Scholarships Committee • The Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of demand and will be distributed over the eligible applicants within the maximum amount available, at the discretion of the FHES Contestable Scholarships Committee • Applications will be scored using the Universities New Zealand Committee Grade Point Average calculator and preference will be given to those applicants with the highest GPA • Applicants enrolled in DHSc coursework components must hold an approved and signed D2 • Applicants enrolled in thesis components must have already submitted a PG 1 to the FHES Postgraduate and Research Committee or had their PG1 already approved • No Postgraduate Fee Scholarship will be granted upon any occasion if the Committee considers that the applicant is not of sufficient merit
<p>Conditions of Acceptance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enrolment must be complete before the Scholarship can be taken up (i.e. before the end of Semester 1) • The successful applicant must notify the University Scholarships Office of their acceptance of the scholarship offer within two weeks of the formal date of notification • This Scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees-based award or scholarship awarded by AUT or any other external organisation. If a recipient should be awarded another fees-based award or scholarship, they will notify the Associate Dean Research upon offer of that award. This FHES Postgraduate Fee Scholarship must be forfeited and the funds returned to the faculty. External scholarships or awards will take precedence over this scholarship • The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based awards or scholarships • Should the student withdraw from the postgraduate programme, they may be required to repay AUT University for the full amount paid by AUT University during the tenure of the scholarship. This shall be determined by a sub-committee of the University Scholarships Committee • The student must advise the Scholarships Office and the Faculty Research Office immediately of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - any suspension or withdrawal from full-time study in the approved programme of study -any change of supervisor (thesis component students) -the date of submission of the student's thesis (thesis component students)
