

## CERTIFICATE IN COMPUTING AND MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES EQUITY SCHOLARSHIP

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### CLOSING DATE: OPEN

The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences has introduced Equity Scholarships for the purpose of promoting the participation and success of students who are under-represented in Computer and Information Sciences, including women, Māori and/or Pasifika students.

### AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually
- The amount of the scholarship is payment to the value of \$1,000 towards the cost of tuition fees
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

### TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form
- Academic Transcript or secondary school mid year reports and/or record of learning
- Please ensure you have completed and sent in an AUT Application for Enrolment (AFE).

### CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- Be NZ citizens or permanent residents
- Qualify to enrol as a full-time student in the Certificate in Computing and Mathematical Sciences.

### SELECTION

- The recipient will be determined by the School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences Selection Panel
- Should there be more applicants than awards available then the applicants previous academic record will be considered
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

### CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship
  - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office
- The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences reserves the right to use the names, photographs and details of successful recipients for promotional purposes
- The School may, from time to time, request the recipient to participate in promotional activities. Such activities will be done in full consultation with the recipient.
