CLOSING DATE: 1 FEBRUARY 2012

The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences has introduced Academic Excellence Scholarships for the purpose of promoting the participation and success of tertiary study in computer sciences by students who have demonstrated excellent academic achievement.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually.
- The maximum value of this scholarship is the equivalent to the New Zealand domestic tuition fee and learner services fee as published each year. The school reserves the right not to award the maximum amount.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for the first year of study.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- AUT Scholarship Nomination Form, to be completed by the school.
- Secondary School midyear reports and/or record of learning.

CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- Have been a full-time New Zealand secondary school student in the year prior to applying for the scholarship.
- Enrol as a full-time student in the Bachelor of Computer and Information Sciences.
- Demonstrate excellent academic performance in their final year at a secondary school.
- Have achieved 56 credits in NCEA Level 3, including 14 credits in mathematics and 14 credits in English or a language rich subject.

SELECTION

- The recipient will be determined by the School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences Selection Panel.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office.
- The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences reserves the right to use the names, photographs and details of successful recipients for promotional purposes.
- The School may, from time to time, request the recipient to participate in promotional activities. Such activities will be done in full consultation with the recipient.
