

SCHOOL OF COMPUTING AND MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES EQUITY SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 1 FEBRUARY 2012

The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences has introduced Equity Scholarships for the purpose of promoting the participation and success of students who are under-represented in Computer and Mathematical Sciences, including women, Māori and/or Pasifika students.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually
- The maximum value of this scholarship is the equivalent to the New Zealand domestic tuition fee and learner services fee as published each year. The school reserves the right not to award the maximum amount.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for the first year of study.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript or secondary school mid year reports and/or record of learning, or letter of recommendation.

CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- Be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Qualify to enrol as a full-time or part-time student in a School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences programme.

SELECTION

- The recipient will be determined by the School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences Selection Panel.
- Should there be more applicants than awards available then the applicants previous academic record will be considered.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office.
- The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences reserves the right to use the names, photographs and details of successful recipients for promotional purposes.
- The School may, from time to time, request the recipient to participate in promotional activities. Such activities will be done in full consultation with the recipient.
