

MASTERS' SCHOLARSHIP IN COMPUTING AND MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES

CLOSING DATE: OPEN

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage and support participation of students at Masters' level programmes within the School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually.
- The maximum value of this scholarship is the equivalent to New Zealand tuition fee and learners services fee as published each year. The school reserves the right not to award the maximum amount.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for the first year of study.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Applicants must be full-time students accepted into a Master's level programme with the School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences.
- The scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic excellence.

SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by the School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences Selection Panel.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office.
- The School of Computing and Mathematical Sciences reserves the right to use the names, photographs and details of successful recipients for promotional purposes.
- The School may, from time to time, request the recipient to participate in promotional activities. Such activities will be done in full consultation with the recipient.
