

UNDERGRADUATE FULL FEE SCHOLARSHIP (ENGINEERING)

CLOSING DATE: 27 JANUARY 2012

These scholarships are offered to encourage school leavers with proven academic excellence to study engineering.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually.
- The value of each scholarship is full tuition and learner services levy fee.
- The scholarship does not cover the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must intend on enrolling full-time in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) programme.
- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- These scholarships are available to applicants with excellent course work school grades and/or those who can provide evidence of past academic excellence.

SELECTION

- Selection will be based on applicants NCEA Level Two and Level Three or equivalent results in achievement standards.
- Recipients will be selected by the School of Engineering Selection Panel.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship is only valid for students who meet the entry criteria and enrol at AUT.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of Department and the Scholarships Office.
