

BUSINESS SCHOOL YOUNG ENTERPRISE TOP ACHIEVERS SCHOLARSHIP

AWARDED ON: 1 DECEMBER 2011

The Business School Young Enterprise Top Achievers Scholarship is for each member of the winning team in the Lion Foundation Young Enterprise Scheme National Awards competition to undertake study on the Bachelor of Business programme at AUT.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- There will be one scholarship awarded to each member of the winning team.
- The amount of the scholarship is payment of the recipient's tuition, learner services levy and student services fees for the first year of study of the Bachelor of Business (up to a maximum of 120 points).
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year of full time study of the Bachelor of Business programme.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

No formal application is required. The successful recipients will be notified by the Business School. On taking up the scholarship, the recipients should provide:

- AUT Application For Enrolment (AFE) completed for the Bachelor of Business.
- Completed AUT Business School Young Enterprise Scholarship Application Form.
- A copy of the New Zealand Lion Foundation Young Enterprise Scheme National Awards certificate.

CRITERIA

All candidates for this scholarship must:

- Be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Have been a full-time New Zealand secondary school student in the year prior to being considered for the scholarship.
- Be a member of the winning team in the New Zealand Lion

Foundation Young Enterprise Scheme National Awards competition.

- Be enrolling for the first time, full-time in the Business School Bachelor of Business programme in either 2012 or 2013.

CONDITIONS OF SELECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

- The award of this scholarship will be based on a team's performance in the New Zealand Lion Foundation Young Enterprise Scheme National Awards competition.
- The award of this scholarship is conditional on the candidate gaining entry onto and enrolling in the Bachelor of Business programme within the Business School at AUT.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Business School.
- The Business School has the power to terminate or suspend a scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a recipient.
- The final decision for the award of a Business Young Enterprise Scholarship is held by the Business School Scholarships Selection Panel. If the Panel is of opinion that there is no suitable candidate of sufficient merit, no scholarship will be awarded.
- The Business Young Enterprise Scholarship may be taken up by the recipient within two years from the time it was awarded. The recipient must notify the Scholarships Office of the year the scholarship is due to be taken up.
