

# **STUDENT MARKETS 2008**

## **Rules & Regulations:**

- Campus Events will provide each student stall holder group with one table and a space on AUT Campus during the assigned market days only.
- There is no power facility available to student groups trading on campus. Campus Events also do not provide BBQ's or Microwaves.
- Any SBE groups that have business plans that involve drugs, party pills or alcohol, or groups that risk bringing AUT into disrepute, will not be allowed to trade on AUT property.
- Student stallholders are not permitted to enter any AUT buildings to sell or promote their products.
- All posters and promotions put up by student stall holders must be removed by the end of each student market day.
- Any group wanting to sell food on campus will need to acquire a Food & Hygiene Certificate from Auckland City Council, unless the food is pre-packaged (wrapped chocolate, etc) and has not been handled by yourselves at any point. The food should also not require any refrigeration or heating.
- Any group cooking any food (if they hold a Food & Hygiene Certificate) is required to wear gloves when handling food.
- If you are proposing to sell food elsewhere that is *not* pre-packaged then you need to have a food licence and the food must be prepared in a commercially registered kitchen.
- Sushi may not be on AUT Campus due to Health & Safety regulations.
- Raffle tickets may not be sold on campus due to gambling laws.
