

CHINESE SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 26 FEBRUARY 2010

The purpose of this scholarship is to reward academic excellence and to encourage and support students to undertake tertiary level study in the area of Chinese.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- One scholarship will be available annually to a suitable applicant each academic year
- The scholarship covers full tuition and student services fee for full-time study or part-time equivalent
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form
- Academic Transcript.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents
- Secondary school leavers accepted onto the Bachelor of Arts (Chinese) or Diploma in Chinese programmes are eligible to apply for this scholarship
- Year 13 students who are sitting NCEA Level 3 or equivalent Chinese and wish to study Chinese are eligible to apply for this scholarship
- The scholarship is based on academic excellence with NCEA Level 3 results as the main criterion.

SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the School of Languages and Social Sciences
- Applicants who are aiming to staircase into mainstream study will be given preference
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship
 - The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office.
