### LOCATION:

(Academic) score - overall 5.5 with no band less than 5.0 or Overall score of 6.0 with no band less than 5.5

TOEFL score: Paper-based - total score of 550 with minimum of 4.0 in Test of Written English (TWE) or Computer-based - total score of 213 with minimum Essay rating of 4.0 or Internet-based - total score of 80

#### UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE - IELTS

(Academic) score - Overall score of 6.0 with no band less than 5.5

TOEFL score: Paper-based - total score of 550 with minimum of 4.0 in Test of Written English (TWE) or Computer-based - total score of 213 with minimum Essay rating of 4.0 or Internet-based - total score of 80

#### POSTGRADUATE - IELTS

(Academic) score - Overall band score of 6.5 & band score of 6.0 in all bands

TOEFL score: Paper-based - total score of 575 with minimum of 4.5 in Test of Written English (TWE) or Computer-based - total score of 233 with minimum Essay rating of 4.5 or Internet-based - total score of 90
