### Selection Criteria for Programmes: 2011

In addition to **entry criteria** listed in the current AUT Calendar for the listed programmes, the following selection criteria will apply to domestic applications for programmes operating in 2011 until further notice:

<b>Programme</b>	<b>Selection Criteria</b>
Certificate in Introduction to Early Childhood Education <sup>1</sup>	Applications will be evaluated when fully complete and in order received. Restricted entry will apply. See notes.
Certificate in Education <sup>2</sup>	Priority will be given to acceptable graduates from AUT's Certificate in Introduction to Early Childhood Education. Other applications will be considered according to general selection criteria for teacher education programmes <sup>3</sup> and under note <sup>2</sup> . Restricted entry will apply. See notes.
Certificate in Tertiary Teaching	Restricted entry may apply. In this case, preference will be given to those that have some responsibility for adult learning. An appropriate level of academic literacy is required.
National Diploma in Teaching (Early Childhood Education, Pasifika) <sup>4</sup>	Priority will be given to applications from Pasifika peoples. Applications will be considered according to general selection criteria for teacher education programmes. Restricted entry will apply. See notes.

Programme	Selection Criteria
Bachelor of Education <sup>5</sup>	Applications will be considered according to general selection criteria for teacher education programmes. Restricted entry will apply. See notes.
Graduate Certificate and Graduate Diploma in Career Development	No specific selection criteria apply. Entry is not restricted.
Graduate Diploma in (Specialty) Education	Priority will be given to applicants for Montessori, Steiner and Pasifika specialties. Restricted entry will apply. <b>Note – this is not a teacher education programme and will not result in teacher registration.</b>
Graduate Diploma in Secondary Teaching <sup>6</sup>	Applications will be considered according to general selection criteria for teacher education programmes. Restricted entry will apply.
Graduate Diploma in Tertiary Teaching <sup>7</sup>	Restricted entry may apply. In this case, preference will be given to those that have some responsibility for adult learning. An appropriate level of academic literacy is required. See notes.
Master of Career Development	No specific selection criteria apply. Entry is not restricted.
Master of Educational Leadership	No specific selection criteria apply. Entry is not restricted.
Master of Education (Incl. PG Cert & PG Dip)	No specific selection criteria apply. <b>Note – this is not a teacher education programme and will not result in teacher registration.</b> Entry is not restricted.
Doctor of Education	No specific selection criteria apply. Entry is not restricted.

The notes listed below will give further information that might influence students' choices.

<sup>1</sup> There will only be one intake for this programme (in semester 2, 2011), although applications for entry will be received from Jan 5, 2011.

<sup>2</sup> There will only be one intake for this programme (in semester 1, 2011). In semester 2, 2011, applications may be considered for 2012. Applicants will be considered in terms of potential success of study at level 5, their understanding of the role of a teacher, their ability to communicate, and personal/professional qualities.

<sup>3</sup> All applications for teacher education programmes will be evaluated against the following criteria:

- fully completed application form
- fully completed disclosure form
- fully completed police vetting form
- referees' reports that are received and satisfactory

Please note that all applicants must meet the New Zealand Teachers Council criteria of Fitness to be a Teacher. They may be required to complete a literacy and numeracy test.

In addition, all applicants for primary and early childhood programmes may participate in an interview that contributes to judgments being made regarding potential for tertiary study, potential for sound professional practice, communication, personal/professional qualities, and involvement and experience with young people.

<sup>4</sup> There will only be one intake for this programme (in semester 1, 2011). In 2012 it is likely that a Bachelor of Pasifika Education will replace this programme. It will have different entry criteria.

<sup>5</sup> There will only be one intake for this programme (in semester 1, 2011). In semester 2, 2011, applications may be considered for 2012.

<sup>6</sup> All applicants for secondary programmes must meet the general criteria outlined under note 3. They will also participate in an interview that assesses subjects and strengths, knowledge of sector, knowledge of adolescents, and disposition.

<sup>7</sup> This programme is under review and likely to be replaced by a postgraduate programme in 2011-12.
