

GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN CAREER DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 11 FEBRUARY 2011

The purpose of this scholarship is to support students who are obtaining an academic qualification in career development.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- Up to five scholarships will be offered annually
- One award is reserved for Maori/Pasifika applicants
- The scholarship covers the tuition fee, learner services levy, student services fee and Students' Association fee for one paper in the Graduate Diploma in Career Development.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is one semester.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form
- Please attach a minimum 300 word statement describing your goals for work in the careers field. Specific focus must be on your vision for assisting the career development of clients and how attainment of the Graduate Diploma will support you in fulfilling this vision.
- Also include a statement of your financial need.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents
- Recipients must be accepted onto the Graduate Diploma in Career Development programme.

SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel consisting of staff from the Graduate Diploma in Career Development Programme
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office
- Recipients will not be considered for automatic renewal of this scholarship, but may submit a second application for consideration.
