

ERIN WHITE SCHOLARSHIP (SOCIAL SCIENCES)

CLOSING DATE: 13 FEBRUARY 2012

The Erin White Scholarship commemorates the memory of Erin White, one of the first graduates in the Bachelor of Arts (Social Sciences), and a postgraduate student and administrator in the Department of Social Sciences. The scholarship is designed to encourage access to postgraduate study in the Social Sciences for students who would otherwise find it difficult to do so.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- One scholarship is available annually.
- The scholarship covers full tuition and learner services levy fees.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year, or part-time equivalent study.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript.
- Statement outlining personal and financial circumstances.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents
- The scholarship is available to full-time or part-time students who are enrolled in a Master's programme in the Department of Social Sciences.
- Applicants will need to demonstrate a record of academic success in their undergraduate degree.
- Financial and personal circumstances.

SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the Department of Social Sciences.
- Preference will be given to students graduating from the Bachelor of Arts (Social Sciences) who would find postgraduate study difficult to undertake due to family, financial or other reasons.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of Department and the Scholarships Office.
