

BUSINESS AND LAW UNDERGRADUATE ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 5 OCTOBER 2011

The Business and Law Undergraduate Academic Excellence Scholarships are for students who have demonstrated an outstanding record of academic achievement at secondary school and are intending enrolling full time in the Bachelor of Business or Bachelor of Laws at AUT.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- There are three Business and Law Undergraduate Academic Excellence Scholarships offered on a contestable basis per year.
- These scholarships are awarded for the payment of the recipient's tuition fee and learner services levy fees up to a maximum of 360 points in the Bachelor of Business programme or 480 points in the Bachelor of Laws programme.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for the three year period of the Bachelor of Business or the four year period of the Bachelor of Laws programme, renewed annually.
- Renewal of the scholarship each year will be based on the student achieving a minimum B+ grade average each year.
- In exceptional circumstances, recipients may apply to the Scholarships Office for a deferment of their scholarship.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed AUT Application for Enrolment (AFE) for the Bachelor of Business or Bachelor of Laws.
- Completed AUT Business and Law Undergraduate Academic Excellence Scholarship Application Form.
- Letter of endorsement from nominating secondary school.

CRITERIA

All applicants for these scholarships must:

- Be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Be a full-time New Zealand secondary school student in their final year of full-time study.
- Demonstrate outstanding academic performance in NCEA Level 2 or higher (or in an equivalent qualification) and be in their final year of full-time study at a secondary school.
- Be enrolling for the first time in the AUT Bachelor of Business or Bachelor of Laws full-time programmes.

CONDITIONS OF SELECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

- Recipients will be selected by the Faculty of Business and Law Scholarships Selection Panel.
- The award of these scholarships is conditional on the student gaining entry onto the Bachelor of Business or Bachelor of Laws programmes.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Faculty of Business and Law.
- The Faculty of Business and Law has the power to terminate or suspend a scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a recipient.
- Recipients will be expected to make a commitment to involve themselves in service activities organised by the Faculty of Business and Law.
- The final decision for the award of a Business and Law Undergraduate Academic Excellence Scholarship is held by the Faculty of Business and Law Scholarships Selection Panel. If the Panel is of the opinion that there is no suitable applicant of sufficient merit applying for a scholarship, no scholarship will be awarded.
