

MASTER OF ARTS (APPLIED LANGUAGE STUDIES) SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 13 FEBRUARY 2012

The purpose of this scholarship is to promote the Master of Arts (Applied Language Studies) programme nationally and to encourage and support New Zealand citizens or permanent residents to enrol in a postgraduate course of study in the area of Applied Language Studies.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- Full tuition and Learner Service Levy for full-time study or part-time study.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.
- One scholarship awarded annually.

TENURE

- One year of full-time study or part-time equivalent.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript.
- Two testimonies relating to the candidate's applied language/linguistic background, as well as their general academic performance and potential.

CRITERIA

Applicants must be:

- NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Available for full-time or part-time students accepted into the Master of Arts (Applied Language Studies).
- The scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic excellence.

SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the School of Languages.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- The scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
- The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with approval of the Head of Department and the Scholarships Office.
- The scholarship may be terminated at any point should any unfavourable report be received from lecturers regarding grades, or attendance.
