Amount and Type of Award	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The value of each scholarship is \$6000 for full-time students and \$3000 for part-time students. The stipend will be paid as one payment at commencement of the tenure.
Number offered	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The number allocated is dependent on available funds
Tenure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One year
Selection Criteria:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• These scholarships are available to part-time and full-time students who are in their thesis stage of their Masters or, have been accepted into a doctoral degree at AUT University, or in exceptional circumstances are preparing to enrol in a doctoral degree at AUT• Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents• Applicants cannot be full-time AUT staff
Application requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applicants must complete the AUT Application Form and attach;<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Academic Transcript(s)◦ A two page statement outlining their research proposal using the template provided with the application form◦ A letter of support from the applicant's proposed primary supervisor
Selection Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The selection panel will include the PVC Māori Advancement or nominee, the AUT Equity Advisor or nominee, and at least one member of the AUT professoriate.• Selection will be based on demonstrated excellence in the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ the applicant's academic record (including prizes, awards and any publications),◦ the applicant's research proposal and background,

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ support from the primary supervisor, and ◦ any other relevant information that may be available, including that which meets the University's strategic needs
Conditions of Acceptance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recipients must be prepared to participate and take a leadership role in the Māori and Pasifika Postgraduate Students Wānanga and any other AUT activities that promote post-graduate scholarship. • Support AUT recruitment and marketing activities, if and when required
Monitoring and reporting requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Successful applicants will be expected to make satisfactory progress as attested by six monthly progress reports
Renewal Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • These are one off awards
