

COMMUNICATION STUDIES POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 20 JANUARY 2012

The purpose of this scholarship is to promote the postgraduate programmes in Communication Studies nationally and to encourage and support New Zealand citizens or permanent residents to enrol in a postgraduate course of study.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually.
- The scholarship covers the full tuition and learner services levy fee or part-time equivalent.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association Fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Applicants must be full-time or part-time students accepted into the PhD or the Master of Communication Studies, or the Bachelor of Communication Studies (Honours).
- The scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic excellence.

SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the School of Communication Studies.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of Department and the Scholarships Office.
