

ONEHUNGA HIGH BUSINESS SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 5 OCTOBER 2011 (APPLICATIONS TO HEAD OF SCHOOL - ONEHUNGA HIGH BUSINESS SCHOOL)

The AUT Business School in recognition of its relationship with Onehunga High Business School has provided scholarships for the purpose of recognising Onehunga High Business School students who have demonstrated strong academic achievement in their final year at secondary school.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- There are four Onehunga High Business School scholarships offered on a contestable basis per year.
 - › At least one scholarship will be awarded to an applicant of Maori descent.
 - › At least one scholarship will be awarded to an applicant of Pasifika descent.
- This scholarship is awarded for the payment of the recipient's full-time tuition and learner services levy fees (up to a maximum of 360 points) in the Bachelor of Business programme.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for the three year period of the Bachelor of Business programme, renewed annually.
- Renewal of the scholarship will be based on the student achieving a minimum B grade average at the end of each year of study in the Bachelor of Business programme.
- In exceptional circumstances, recipients may apply to the Scholarships Office for a deferment of their scholarship.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed AUT Application For Enrolment (AFE) completed for the Bachelor of Business programme.
- Completed Onehunga High Business School Scholarship Application Form.
- A covering letter addressed to the Head of School, Onehunga High Business School.
- Academic CV including achievement at NCEA Level 2 and NCEA

Level 3 in Year 13.

- A Business related article. Details of the requirements to be obtained from the Head of School, Onehunga High Business School.

CRITERIA

All applicants for this scholarship must:

- Be a NZ citizen or permanent resident.
- Be a full-time school student at Onehunga High Business School in the year applying for the scholarship.
- Demonstrate strong academic performance in NCEA level 2 and higher (or in an equivalent qualification) and in their final year of study at Onehunga High Business School.
- Be enrolling for the first time, full-time in the AUT Business School Bachelor of Business programme.

CONDITIONS OF SELECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

- Recipients will be selected by Onehunga High Business School and the applicant's nomination approved by the AUT Business School Scholarships Selection Panel.
- The award of this scholarship is conditional on the student gaining entry into the Bachelor of Business programme.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - › The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Business School and the Scholarships Office.
- The Business School has the power to terminate or suspend a scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a recipient.
- Recipients will be expected to make a commitment to involve themselves in service based activities organised by the AUT Business School.

- The final decision for the award of an Onehunga High Business School Scholarship is held by the Business School Scholarship Selection Panel. If the Panel is of the opinion that there is no suitable applicant of sufficient merit applying for a scholarship, no scholarship will be awarded.
