

# EPSOM GIRLS GRAMMAR SCHOOL BUSINESS MAORI/PASIFIKA SCHOLARSHIP

## CLOSING DATE: 5 OCTOBER 2011 (APPLICATIONS TO HOD BUSINESS MGMT - EPSOM GIRLS GRAMMAR SCHOOL)

The Business School in conjunction with Epsom Girls Grammar School has provided a Business Maori / Pasifika Scholarship for the purpose of recognising an Epsom Girls Grammar School student of Maori or Pasifika descent who has demonstrated strong academic achievement at secondary school and is intending on enrolling full time in the Bachelor of Business at AUT.

### AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- There is one Epsom Girls Grammar School Business Maori / Pasifika Scholarship offered on a contestable basis per year.
  - » One scholarship is awarded to an applicant of Maori or Pasifika descent.
- This scholarship is awarded for the payment of the recipient's full-time tuition and learner services levy fees (up to a maximum of 360 points) in the Bachelor of Business programme.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

### TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for the three year period of the Bachelor of Business programme, renewed annually.
- Renewal of the scholarship will be based on the student achieving a minimum B grade average at the end of each year of study in the Bachelor of Business programme.
- In exceptional circumstances, a recipient may apply to the Scholarships Office for a deferment of their scholarship.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Completed AUT Application for Enrolment (AFE) for the Bachelor of Business programme
- Completed AUT Business School Epsom Girls Grammar School Scholarship Application Form.
- A covering letter addressed to the Head of Department Business Management, Epsom Girls Grammar School.
- Academic CV including achievement at NCEA Level 2 and NCEA Level 3 in Year 13.

- A Business related article. Details of the requirement to be obtained from the Head of Department Business Management, Epsom Girls Grammar School.

### CRITERIA

All applicants for this scholarship must:

- Be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Be a full-time student at Epsom Girls Grammar School in the year applying for the scholarship.
- Be enrolling for the first time, full-time in the Business School Bachelor of Business programme.
- Demonstrate strong academic performance in NCEA Level 2 and higher (or in an equivalent qualification) and their final year of study at Epsom Girls Grammar School.

### CONDITIONS OF SELECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

- Recipients will be selected by the Epsom Girls Grammar School and the applicant's nomination will be approved by the Business School Scholarships Selection Panel.
- The award of this scholarship is conditional on the student gaining entry onto the Bachelor of Business programme.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
  - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Business School.
- The Business School has the power to terminate or suspend a scholarship if it received an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a recipient.
- Recipients will be expected to make a commitment to involve themselves in service activities organised by the Business School.
- The final decision for the award of an Epsom Girls Grammar School Business Maori / Pasifika Scholarship is to be held by the Business School Scholarships Selection Panel. If the Panel is of the opinion that there is no suitable applicant of sufficient merit applying for a scholarship.
