NZWALMI Doctoral Award

The New Zealand Work and Labour Market Institute employs New Zealand's largest concentration of experts in human resource management, employment relations and labour economics.

Purpose

The purpose of this award is to support a doctoral student enrolled at AUT University in the research area of work and labour market studies in the Pacific region. Applicants pursuing a research programme focused on the development of employment relations capacity and institutions in the Pacific Islands will be particularly favoured.

Closing date

4pm, 30 November 2011

Amount and type of award

The value of this award covers full-time domestic student doctoral fees at AUT University for three years plus an annual stipend of \$25,000.

Criteria

The award is open to full-time doctoral students enrolled at AUT University in the Doctor of Philosophy programme AK3518.

Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents of New Zealand.

Applicants are required to have a Masters Degree or Honours degree with second class division one or better in a discipline related to work and labour market studies, such as Employment Relations, Human Resource Management or Labour Economics.

Application requirements

Applicants must complete the NZWALMI Doctoral Award Application Form

Applicants must supply a current CV (max 4 pages)

Applicants must supply a one page letter outlining their research topic

Applications will not be accepted after the closing date of 4pm, 30 November 2011

Selection Process

Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from NZWALMI.

If the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award then none shall be awarded.

An applicant's thesis or dissertation must focus on work and labour market studies in the Pacific region. Applicants pursuing a research programme focused on the development of employment relations capacity and institutions in the Pacific Islands will be particularly favoured.

Conditions of Acceptance

Recipients must complete and accept Doctor of Philosophy enrolment documentation prior to receiving the award and stipend.

Recipients must acknowledge NZWALMI in any publications as supporters of their postgraduate study.

Recipients may be asked to participate in media advertising and institute events.

Renewal of the award for the second and third year will be conditional on satisfactory academic progress.
