

ELECTRICITY ENGINEERS' ASSOCIATION (EEA) SCHOLARSHIP

The Electricity Engineers' Association (EEA) Scholarship was established by EEA in 2012 to assist students studying for the degrees of Bachelor of Engineering (BE) (honours) and the Bachelor of Engineering Technology (BET).

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- \$4,500

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- A two page personal statement by the candidate based upon attributes outlined in the selection criteria.
- Two reference statements supporting the applicant's personal statement.

CRITERIA

- The scholarship is available to a student who is:
 - » A New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
 - » Enrolled full-time for Year 4 of the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) or Year 3 of the Bachelor of Engineering Technology at AUT specialising in the fields of electricity generation or production; power systems; or electricity utilisation.
- Selection will take into account academic achievement, leadership potential, personal qualities, communication skills and the candidate's potential contribution to the future development of power engineering.

SELECTION

- The award will be made on the recommendation of a selection Committee comprising a member of the University Scholarships Committee; the Head of Department – Electrical & Electronic Engineering, or nominee; and a representative of the EEA.
- Interviews shall take place in April or May each year.
- No award shall be made if it is considered that there is no suitable applicant in any year.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- Conditions of the award of the Scholarship may be varied from time to time by the Scholarships Committee after consultation with the EEA.
