

POSTGRADUATE FULL FEE SCHOLARSHIP (ENGINEERING)

CLOSING DATE: 28 JANUARY 2011

The purpose of this scholarship is to support postgraduate students and engender research culture within the School of Engineering.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually
- The value of each scholarship is full tuition, learner services levy and student services fees
- The scholarship does not cover the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- This scholarship may be awarded for a maximum of two years' full-time equivalent
- The scholarship may be available for subsequent years depending on satisfactory academic performance.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form
- Academic Transcript.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be enrolled in one of the following programmes:
 - » Master of Engineering
 - » Master of Engineering Studies
 - » Master of Philosophy
 - » Postgraduate Diploma in Engineering (Research)
- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents
- These scholarships are available to applicants with high course work grades and/or those who can provide evidence of past academic excellence and research.

SELECTION

- Recipients will be selected by the School of Engineering Selection Panel
- Priority is given to students undertaking a thesis
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School (Engineering) and the Scholarships Office.
