

## HOSPITALITY MANAGEMENT POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

### CLOSING DATE: 1 FEBRUARY 2012 AND 15 JUNE 2012

The purpose of this scholarship is to support and encourage hospitality managers undertaking part-time study in a Master of International Hospitality Management.

#### AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually.
- The scholarship covers the full tuition and learner services levy fee.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.

#### TENURE

- The scholarship is tenable for a period not exceeding four years of part-time study.

#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Letters of support from senior industry representatives.
- Academic Transcripts from previous qualifications.
- Recent CV outlining in detail relevant industry experience.
- Cover letter outlining the candidate's commitment to gaining the qualification and why they believe they should be selected for the scholarship. The letter should also highlight managerial work experience including but not limited to: Examples of key management related activities such as project management, human resource management accomplishments and financial management responsibilities.

#### CRITERIA

- Applicants must be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.
- Applicants must be employed during the duration of the scholarship as hospitality managers in New Zealand.
- The scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic excellence and relevant hospitality management experience.

#### SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the School of Hospitality and Tourism and industry representatives.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

#### CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- The award of this scholarship is conditional on the applicant gaining entry to the Master in International Hospitality Management.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
  - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office.
- The scholarship may be terminated or suspended at any point if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a recipient from the Programme Leader of the programme in which they are enrolled or if any other conditions of the scholarship are breached.
- Scholarship holders may be asked to participate in media advertising and other promotional activities for the School of Hospitality and Tourism.
