Terms of Reference & Selection Criteria

It is important that students applying for the AUT & Pasifika Scholarship Award understand the conditions on which the scholarship is awarded. This agreement sets out these conditions. If you have any queries or do not understand any of the following information please discuss with the School of Communication Studies Equity and Diversity Domain Leader.

Duration of Scholarship:

1. The Scholarship shall be awarded for under-graduate study in Communication Studies at AUT University. The Scholarship is awarded for one-year full time study only.

Conditions:

2. All recipients must maintain regular contact with designated AUT Student Services Pasifika Support centre staff.

What the Scholarship covers:

3. The scholarship covers full tuition fees for a maximum of 4 papers per semester and learners services fees for one year.

Costs excluded: books, material fees, NZQA, Administration charges when changing a programme of study and miscellaneous charges.

Community activity:

4. As an AUT Pasifika Scholarship recipient, you will be required to undertake at least one community/promotional activity during the year for the School, such as:
 - The Polyfest (AUT)
 - AUT Open Days and Maori/Pasifika Days
 - Involvement in the School's Pacific Media Centre
5. All recipients must provide evidence of their community/promotional activity to the School Programme Leader: Student Matters.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1.1 The successful applicant will be chosen according to the following criteria:
- 1.1.1 Demonstrated commitment to their community measured by:
- Leadership attributes within School community
 - Involvement in general community projects & activities
- 1.1.2 Academic excellence measured by:
- Overall meritorious academic performance in secondary school
- 1.1.3 A Pasifika student who at the time of their application was a secondary school student, and who has been accepted onto a programme of study in the School of Communication Studies at AUT, or is a continuing student in the School.

2. APPLICATION PROCESS

PART 1

- 2.1.1 Complete a scholarship application form
- 2.1.2 Provide a record of academic background
- 2.1.3 CV
- 2.1.4 All applications shall provide endorsement of support from one or more of the following:
- Community leader
 - School Principal

PART 2

- 4.2.1 From these applications AUT and their representatives will jointly select applicants to form a shortlist

PART 3

- 4.3.1 Short-listed applicants will attend an interview.
- 4.3.2 The interview panel may consist of representatives from the Pacific Island Media Association, School of Communication Studies, AUT and a Pasifika representative from the Office of Pasifika Advancement.

- 4.4.1 AUT shall determine closing dates for the scholarship. You can find the closing date on the Terms of Reference. The Scholarship winners will be announced in February.
