



## The AUT ANZAC Memorial Lecture

**Topic:** Thousands of young New Zealand and Australian men gave their lives for their countries at Gallipoli, many years ago, as did the young men of Turkey and England. Today, Australians and New Zealanders flock to Gallipoli and are hosted by their Turkish counterparts, for whom the battle also has deep significance. What drives Australians and New Zealanders to travel all the way to Turkey on Anzac Day? The fascinating answers to this question throw light once again on the similarities and differences of Australians and New Zealanders, as the research of two leading Australasian academics shows.
