

## OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY SCHOLARSHIP

### CLOSING DATE: 12 MARCH 2012

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to applicants who are: Māori; Pasifika; male; or who have a disability, who wish to enrol or re-enrol in the BHSc (Occupational Therapy) in the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences.

### AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- Two scholarships are available annually.
- The value of each scholarship is \$400.

### TENURE

- Not applicable.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Applicants must submit a typed statement of at least 400 words in English or Te Reo Māori which details their proposed career path, future goals and educational aspirations as a developing occupational therapist.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

### CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Applicants must have been selected for enrolment or re-enrolment in the BHSc (Occupational Therapy).

### SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the Department of Occupational Science and Therapy.
- If there are no applicant(s) of sufficient merit, the panel reserves the right not to make the award.

### CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- The scholarship will be paid on enrolment at the start of the academic year.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
  - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of Department and the Scholarships Office.
