

DOCTORAL FEE SCHOLARSHIP (ENGINEERING)

CLOSING DATE: OPEN

This scholarship is offered to PhD candidates in order to nurture and support the research culture of the School of Engineering.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- The number of new scholarships to be awarded is determined annually.
- The value of each scholarship is tuition fees for up to three years of full-time study.
- The scholarship does not cover the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- This scholarship is awarded for up to three years but subject to satisfactory progress reports.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form
- Academic Transcript

CRITERIA

- Fees scholarships will be awarded on the basis of:
 - » Official confirmation of enrolment.
 - » Normally applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
 - » The likely contribution to the overall research goals of the School of Engineering.
 - » The provision of evidence of past academic excellence, including research.

SELECTION

- Recipients will be selected by the School of Engineering Selection Panel.
- Selection meetings are held in May and November of each year.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School (Engineering) and the Scholarships Office.
- Grants may also be available on a contestable basis for research related costs. Applications and information are available through the School of Engineering.
