

TUAKANA/TEINA SCHOLARSHIP IN COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP AND EXCELLENCE (ART AND DESIGN)

CLOSING DATE: 17 FEBRUARY 2012

These scholarships are offered to Māori and Pasifika students within the School of Art and Design to:

- Reward leadership qualities and academic excellence.
- Encourage and support Māori and Pasifika students to pursue postgraduate tertiary education.
- Provide mentorship through the model of Tuakaka/Teina for undergraduate students.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- Up to three scholarships are awarded annually.
- The value of the scholarship is full tuition and learner services levy fees.
- The scholarship does not cover the Students' Association fee.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript.
- Copy of Research Proposal.
- No Referee Reports required.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents of Māori or Pacific Island descent.
- Applicants must be enrolling into a postgraduate degree within the School of Art and Design.
- Applicants must have an excellent academic record, an approved research proposal and have completed an application form.

SELECTION

- Recipients will be selected by the Head of School and Head of the Postgraduate Department.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of Department and the Scholarships Office.
- During the year, recipients will be expected to be available as student ambassadors or mentors.
