

BACHELOR OF ARTS (JAPANESE) SCHOLARSHIP

CLOSING DATE: 24 FEBRUARY 2012

The purpose of this scholarship is to reward academic excellence and to encourage and support students to undertake tertiary study in the area of Japanese.

AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- There is one scholarship awarded annually.
- The scholarship does not include the Students' Association fee.
- The scholarship covers full tuition fee and learner services levy and student services fee for full-time study or part-time equivalent.

TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for one year.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- AUT Scholarship Application Form.
- Academic Transcript.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- Year 13 students who are sitting NCEA Level 3 or equivalent Japanese and wish to study Japanese are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- Applicants must be accepted into the Bachelor of Arts (Japanese) programme.
- The scholarship is based on academic excellence, especially in Japanese.
- This scholarship does not apply to existing students in the Bachelor of Arts (Japanese) programme.

SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the School of Languages.
- This scholarship will be awarded after NCEA results become available at the end of January.
- No scholarship will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the award.

CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship.
 - » The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee based scholarships with the approval of the Head of School and the Scholarships Office.
