Amount and Type of Award	Two scholarships at \$5,000 each
Tenure	One calendar year
Eligibility:	<p>Applicants must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Zealand citizens or permanent residents • Enrolled in a postgraduate health science degree within the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences <p>AUT staff members are not eligible to apply for this scholarship</p>
Application requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applications are to be submitted using the Maurice and Phyllis Paykel Trust Scholarship Application form • The signed hard copy of the application is to be submitted along with any additional documents and information as listed on the application form • Completed applications and supporting documents are to be submitted to the Scholarships Office, WB 102, Level 1, WB Building, City Campus, Wellesley Street • Incomplete or late applications will not be considered • Applications submitted without signatures will not be considered
Selection Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recipients will be selected by the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences Postgraduate Scholarships and Awards Committee • The scholarship shall be awarded by the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences Postgraduate Scholarships and Awards Committee and with the approval of the Trustees of the Maurice and Phyllis Paykel Trust • Applicants must demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and experience in previous years of study, and the ability to carry out research • The student must present a quality research proposal that aligns well with the AUT strategic plan (Theme 2 – research) • No scholarship will be granted upon any occasion if the Committee considers that there are no applicants of sufficient merit applying for the scholarship
Conditions of Acceptance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The scholarship may be held concurrently with any other bursary or scholarship but only with the express written approval of the Faculty of Health and Environmental Sciences Postgraduate Scholarships and Awards Committee • Research carried out during the tenure of the scholarship must conform to the codes of ethical principles governing health

	<p>research and be approved by the AUT Ethics Committee and/or other relevant ethics committee(s)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any publication resulting from work done during the tenure of the scholarship shall include an acknowledgement of support provided by the Trust
Monitoring and reporting requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reports on progress may be requested by the Trustees or the Associate Dean Research of the Faculty at any time. Regardless, the recipient(s) shall submit to the Trustees, through the Associate Dean of Research, a final written report on the work that has been achieved during the tenure of the scholarship
