

### CLOSING DATE: 21 OCTOBER 2011

The purpose of this grant is to support and encourage Research Honours, Masters, or PhD students in the Occupational Health and Safety research area.

### AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- \$2,000 dollars is to be awarded to up to three Research Honours, Masters, or PhD students.
- The grant is intended to support postgraduate students with a thesis-based research project, conference attendance or article publication in the Occupational Health and Safety research area.

### TENURE

- The majority of the activity needs to be completed before the end of 2011.

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must complete the AUT Scholarship Application Form
- Applicants must supply a current CV (max 4 pages).
- Applicants must supply a covering letter explaining how they would make use of the grant (max 1 page).
- Applications will not be accepted after the closing date of 4pm, 21 October 2011.

### CRITERIA

- The grant is open to full-time and part-time students enrolled at AUT who are qualified to commence the thesis or dissertation component of a research Honours, Masters or PhD degree at AUT.
- Applicants must be NZ citizens or permanent residents.
- An applicant's thesis or dissertation must focus on the Occupational Health and Safety research area.
- The grant should be used towards a thesis-based research project, conference attendance or article publication.
- Successful applicants may request other uses for the grant beyond the criteria listed above. The selection panel has the right to decline the request.

### SELECTION

- Applicants will be considered by a selection panel from the Centre for Occupational Health and Safety Research and the New Zealand Work and Labour Market Institute.
- No grant will be awarded upon any occasion if the panel is of the opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit applying for the grant.

### CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- Recipients must acknowledge the CVOHR and NZWALMI in any publications as supporters of their project, attendance or publication.
- Recipients may be asked to participate in media advertising.
- Recipients must write and submit a report to the institute office upon conclusion of their report.
