#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

All prices are exclusive of GST and are quoted in New Zealand Dollars.

#### Payment:

All sponsorship must be paid to and recorded by AUT. AUT will issue a tax invoice. Any tax benefits associated with the money received from the sponsorship package are available to registered NZ businesses. Payment must be made in full.

#### **Regulations at events:**

- Any sound utilised is to remain at a low level so as not to interfere with participants.
- Material may not be suspended from the ceiling or attached to AUT's walls. Exhibition dividers or poster boards to be arranged at sponsor's expense.
- Exhibitors are financially responsible for any loss or damage caused to the property or equipment by organisers and guests before, during and after the event. Includes failure to return equipment such as power boards, cables and other such items.
- It's the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure their stand and goods on display are adequately insured for theft and damage.

#### Allocation of exhibition space:

Any exhibition spaces will be allocated by AUT Hospitality Services according to the type of sponsorship package. A trestle table with two chairs, and power boards will be supplied. Any further requirements will need to be managed by the sponsor.

#### Cancellation:

A sponsor must inform AUT by written notice if they wish to cancel their sponsorship. A cancellation fee of 60% will be applicable for any sponsor who cancels one month after initial agreement with AUT.
