Bachelor of Business (Honours) (AK3712)

The Bachelor of Business (Honours) – BBus (Hons) is a one-year programme that provides exceptional Bachelor of Business graduates with postgraduate study and research experience. Honours students develop postgraduate research capability and extend their understanding of a specialist business field. They work closely with academic staff, researchers and other high-performing students in a learning environment that challenges them to excel. An honours degree demonstrates a high level of achievement that is recognised by employers in New Zealand and overseas and leads to greater opportunities for further study.

The Honours is completed in one specialisation so students who have been studying two majors for the BBus must specify the specialisation which they will study in the honours degree.





Points

Coursework and research components carry 15, 30 and 45 points. They are based upon proportions of an annual fulltime student study load of 120 points. One point represents 10 hours of student learning. Accordingly, a 15-point course represents 150 hours of student learning or 12.5% of an annual full-time programme of study. On a weekly basis a 15-point course has an expectation of 10-12 hours of independent learning.

For the research component of the BBus (Hons), students must consult the Faculty Research Processes Handbook and the University Postgraduate Handbook.

Points

Coursework and research components carry 15, 30 and 60 points. They are based upon proportions of an annual fulltime student study load of 120 points. One point represents 10 hours of student learning. Accordingly, a 15-point course represents 150 hours of student learning or 12.5% of an annual full-time programme of study. On a weekly basis a 15-point course has an expectation of 10-12 hours of independent learning.

For the research component of the BBus (Hons), students must consult the Faculty Research Processes Handbook and the University Postgraduate Handbook.

Time Limit

The total time from first enrolment in the BBus (Hons) until the completion of all requirements must not exceed two years.

Entry to the Master of Business for BBus (Hons) graduates

BBus (Hons) graduates may apply to be admitted to the MBus with Advanced Standing. Honours graduates admitted in this way will be eligible to complete the MBus with a programme of 120 points.

Acceptance of applications for MBus is dependent upon availability of staff to supervise research in the student's specialist field of study.

Awards

Awards of the BBus (Hons) are made with classes of honours in accordance with the University's regulations. The classes are based on Grade Point Average (GPA) as follows:

First Class	0 (A- grade average or better
Second Class First Division (2:1)		B+ grade average
Second Class Second Division (2:2)		B⁻ - B grade average

In the case of a student who is not maintaining a B grade average in the coursework component, or has failed to maintain an overall B- grade average, may be required by the Examination Board to have their points reassigned to the Postgraduate Diploma or Postgraduate Certificate in Business.
