## How to apply

- 1. Complete the Application Form and return it with your IELTS Result (or other equivalent) and a copy of your passport by email to <a href="mailto:autadmissions@aut.ac.nz">autadmissions@aut.ac.nz</a> or to your local agent.
- 2. Your Application Form will be processed by the Admissions team, and if you are successful, an Offer of Place will be sent. You will need to pay your fees as per the Proforma Invoice which is sent with your offer.
- 3. Accept your Offer of Place by signing the Offer and returning it to <u>autadmissions@aut.ac.nz</u>.
- 4. Once the invoice is paid, you will receive a receipt of payment and can apply for your student visa.
- 5. Please apply for your student visa as early as possible to allow at least 8 weeks for processing. More information on applying for your student visa.
