The Master of Business is a 180-point research master's degree, which develops critical and reflective graduates with highly developed research capabilities. This study is grounded in a rigorous understanding of a specialist field relevant to your professional and research interests. The MBus enhances knowledge, research and critical reflective capabilities increasingly sought after in complex and changing business environments.

Points

Coursework and research components carry 15, 30, 60 or 90 points. They are based upon proportions of an annual full-time student study load of 120 points. One point represents 10 hours of student learning. Accordingly, a 15-point course represents 150 hours of student learning or 12.5% of an annual full-time programme of study. On a weekly basis a 15-point course has an expectation of 10-12 hours of independent learning.

Time Limit

The total time from first enrolment in the MBus until the completion of all requirements must not exceed four years. The MBus will normally be completed over one and a half years for full-time students or four years for part-time students. Please note that the thesis/dissertation examination period may take two-three months.

Progress through the programme

The programme is made out of three components: advanced courses in your specialisation, research methods courses and an independent research component (thesis or dissertation). You may choose to undertake either a thesis or dissertation in your MBus. You may be able to include elective courses from outside your specialisation into your MBus, from the list of MBus courses on offer. Please seek course advise from the PGR Office.

Research

Research processes and guidelines for MBus theses/dissertations are explained in the Faculty Research Processes Handbook. Full-time students completing a thesis are strongly recommended to spread the remaining 30-points of courses across two semesters.



Minimum grade average for enrolling in a thesis or dissertation

Before any student can proceed to the thesis or dissertation, you must have a minimum B- (minus) average across your courses.

Acceptance onto the MBus programme is on the understanding that your thesis or dissertation be approved within the Faculty's postgraduate process. This is necessary to ensure there are supervisors with suitable expertise for your placement and research. The student is responsible to find a topic and supervisor in the semester prior to starting the thesis/dissertation, and submitting their research proposal by the deadlines provided by the Postgraduate Research Office.

Taking leave from the programme

Where you are suffering from ill health, or there are exceptional circumstances, a leave of absence of up to one year may be approved. Please email business.postgraduate@aut.ac.nz to request a leave of absence. Note: if you are enrolled in the thesis/dissertation component of MBus, a separate process for applying for leave of absence applies (PGR6 form).

Unsatisfactory progress

If you fail a course twice, you cannot be re-enrolled in that course unless you are authorised by the Postgraduate Research Programmes Examination Board to do so. This requires an application from you.

Awards of the MBus are made with classes of honours in accordance with the University's regulations. The classes are based on Grade Point Average (GPA) as follows:
