Scholarship Regulations

Focus

Female, Research

Level of Study

Postgraduate

Purpose

The purpose of the postgraduate scholarship is to provide recognition and financial assistance to outstanding women who undertake postgraduate research. Graduate Women New Zealand believe in empowering women through lifelong education.

Value and Tenure

The value of the scholarship is a one-off grant between \$2,000 and \$10,000. The scholarship is tenable for one year.

Typical Number on Offer

Multiple awards

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- a New Zealand citizen
- female
- enrolled or intending to enrol in a postgraduate research degree at Auckland University of Technology North Campus

Selection Criteria

The selection will be based on:

- academic merit and achievements
- research topic and contribution of intended research
- academic references
- applicant's financial situation and intention for the award, if granted
- the ethics approval status of the research, if applicable.

Selection Committee

The selection process is undertaken by the Awards Committee of the Graduate Women North Shore Charitable Trust (GWNSCT) which funds the scholarships.

Conditions of the Scholarship

By submitting an application, the applicant consents to:

- The disclosure of personal information provided as part of the scholarship application, to staff within the University, and Awards Committee members of Graduate Women North Shore Charitable Trust, for the purpose of assessing the application for a scholarship
- Publication of the recipient's name and details of any scholarship awarded
- Details of the scholarship being shared with Graduate Women New Zealand
- Submitting a written report to the Graduate Women North Shore Charitable Trust within 12 months of receiving the scholarship.
