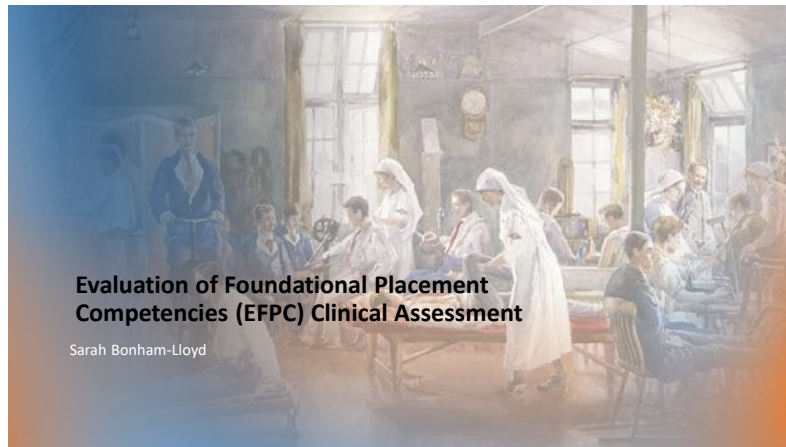

EFPC - Domains...

EFPC: four (4) domains

1. Professional Behavior
2. Learner behavior
3. Communication
4. Information gathering

EFPC: six (6) domains

1. Professional Behavior
2. Learner behavior
3. Communication
4. Information gathering
5. Documentation
6. Understanding professional Scope

Items...

- Each Domain has a variable number of items (or attributes)
- The items are lettered in each Domain e.g. 1a, 1b, 1c etc
- The items are individually scored
- Supervisors asked to complete brief comments for each Domain

Completing the EFPC form...

- Page 1:
 - complete clinical placement information
 - complete the record of student attendance (total number of days completed)

What is the result of the EFPC for students...

- Supervisors are NOT required to 'add up' the final score
- Students need an overall score on the EFPC of 50% or more to pass the foundational clinical placement
- If you are likely to score mostly '0' or '1' ensure you have sought support from the CCL or University Clinical support before discussing results with the student

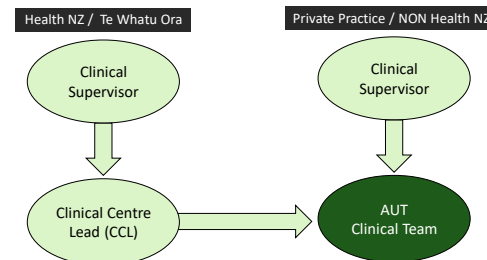

Completing and submitting the EFPC...

1. Follow instructions from the CCL or relevant Tertiary Programme Clinical Manager
2. Ensure you complete the supervisor EFPC form the day before meeting with student(s)
3. Meet with the student(s) on or before the FINAL DAY of the placement
 - View the students self-assessment version of the EFPC
 - Discuss your feedback with student(s)
 - Sign your completed form
4. Ensure the completed EFPC is submitted **ON OR BEFORE THE FINAL DAY** of placement
