BACKGROUND

This scholarship is supported by Seddon Memorial Technical College alumni and other AUT donors. The scholarship was established to recognise an academically able student who is making a positive contribution to the community and to encourage them to study at Honours, course work Master's or Postgraduate Diploma level at AUT University

TYPE OF AWARD

The award consists of tuition fees for one semester only at Honours, course work Master's or Postgraduate Diploma level (excluding Master of Business Administration)

TENURE

One semester only; this award is not renewable

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must:

- Be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident
- Have completed a Bachelor's programme at AUT by the end of the year prior to application
- Normally be enrolled in an Honours, course work Master's or Postgraduate Diploma programme at AUT in Semester 1 of the year of application. If not already enrolled in an Honours, course work Master's or Postgraduate Diploma programme the applicant's transcripts must provide evidence of eligibility to enrol in the programme
- Have demonstrated strong academic achievement to date
- Contribute positively to their community

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Application is through the AUT online scholarship application portal. Applicants are expected to upload:

- Academic transcripts for tertiary study other than that completed at AUT
- A brief outline of their community contribution and/or activities (Max. one A4 page)

Applicants must nominate one referee in the portal. This referee must be a person of standing in the applicant's area of community involvement who will attest the community contribution and or involvement.

If not already enrolled in an Honours, course work Master's or Postgraduate Diploma programme, proof of eligibility to enrol in the programme

CONDITION OF AWARD

Successful applicants are expected to write a letter of thanks to the AUT Foundation Alumni and donors. This will be sent to scholars@aut.ac.nz on acceptance of the award.
