Master of Health Science, Postgraduate Certificate in Advanced Nursing Practice, Postgraduate Diploma in Registered Nurse Prescribing, Postgraduate Diploma in Health Science in Paramedicine

Am I eligible to enrol in this course?

This paper is part of the Extended Care Paramedic education pathway. Students would normally be enrolled in the Postgraduate Diploma in Health Science in Paramedicine (Option 1: Extended Care Paramedic), however the paper is open to other students interested in advanced assessment of patients.

What is this course about?

Develops advanced clinical assessment and diagnostic reasoning skills for the diagnosis and management of common acute and chronic illnesses. Emphasises the application of science, assessment and diagnostic data in the care of individuals in the clinical setting.

What can I expect to learn?

- Advanced assessment skills
- Clinical decision making processes
- Management of common conditions with an emphasis on New Zealand health priorities, within specialty
- Evidence-based literature in a patient/whānau-centred care environment
- Advanced practice models of care
- Health promotion/health education
- Legal, ethical and inter-professional issues in decision making
- Critical reflection on decision making in professional health care practice

How is this course taught?

This paper will utilise a blended learning approach.

This is not a classroom-based paper - most of the theoretical learning will be conducted via online platforms. However, there will be a single <u>compulsory</u> one-day block course, held at the AUT South Campus in Manukau, South Auckland.

How will I be assessed?

- 1. Written Assignment (3500 words)
- 2. Practical Assessment

Who will be teaching me?
