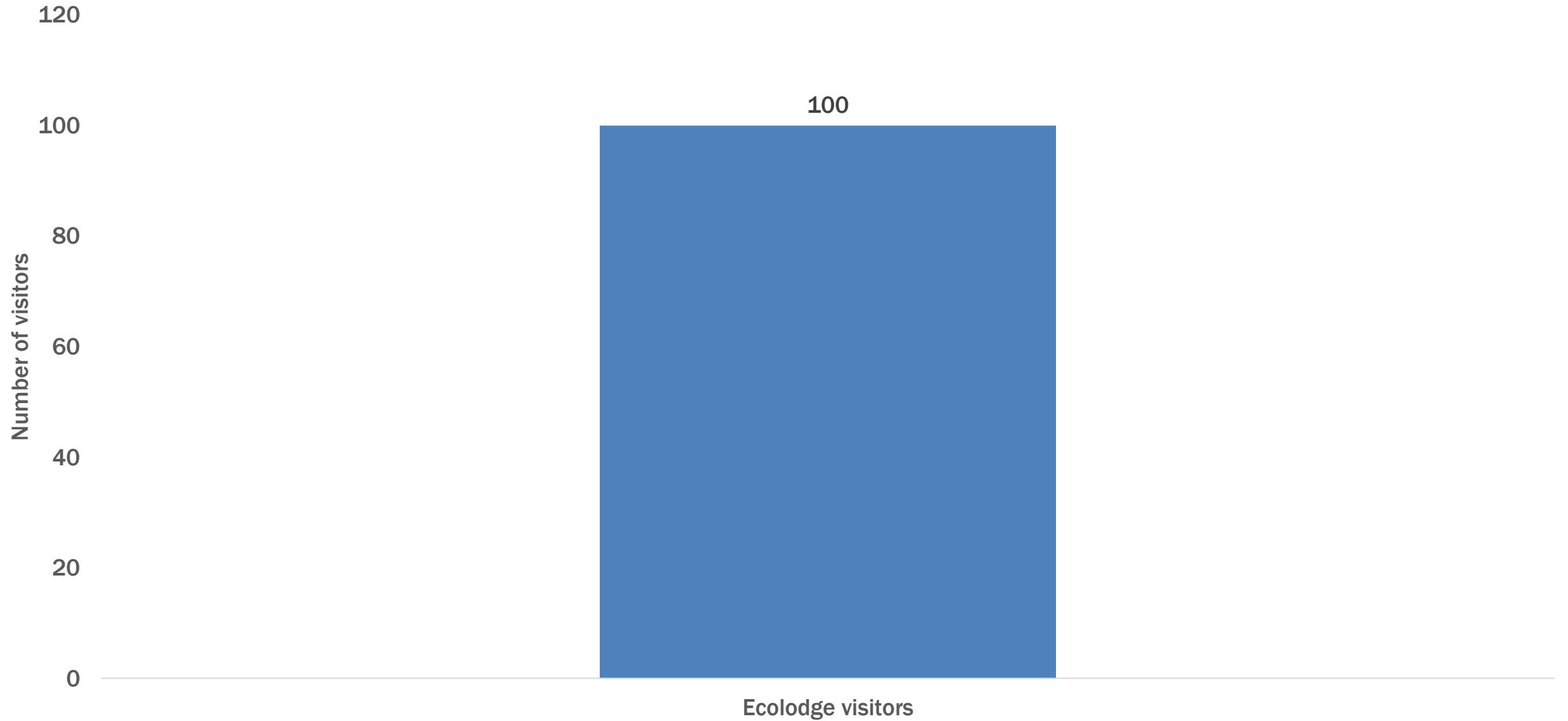

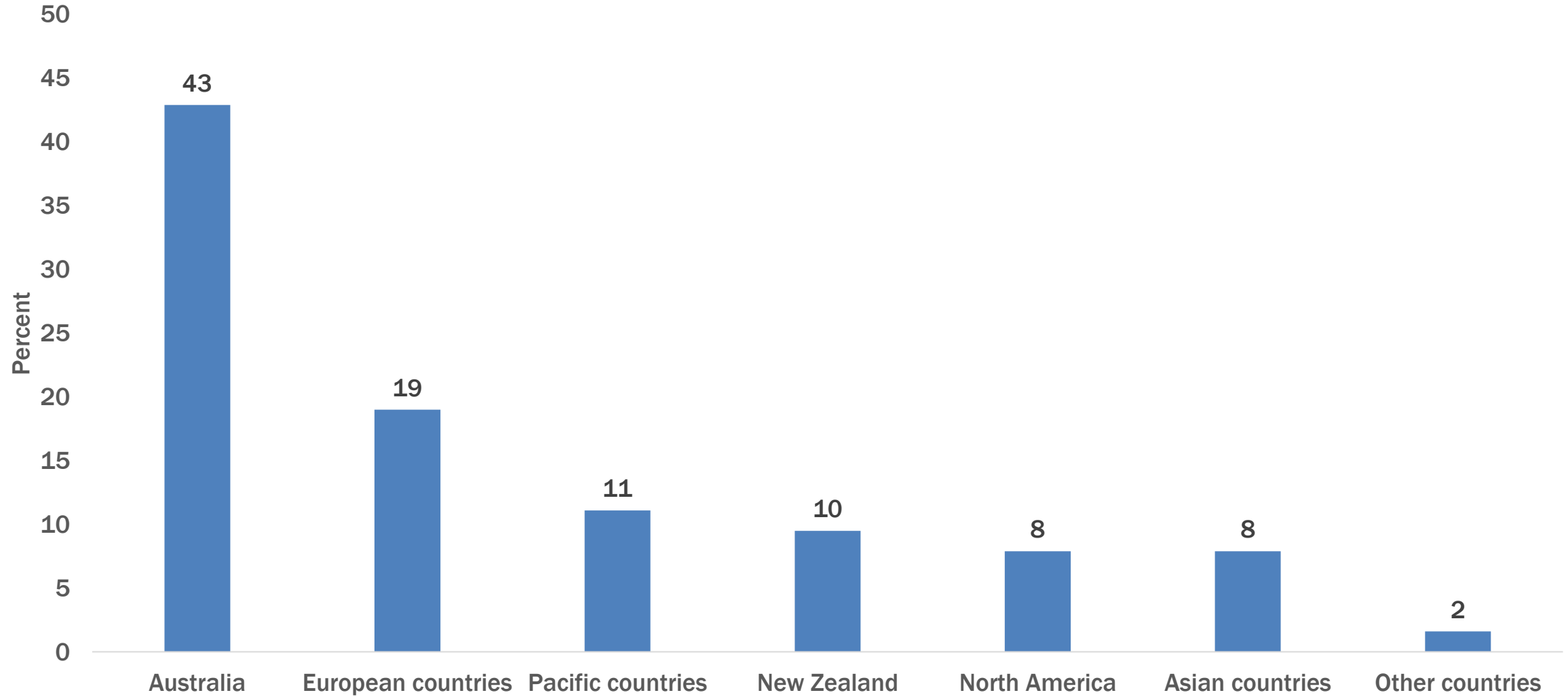

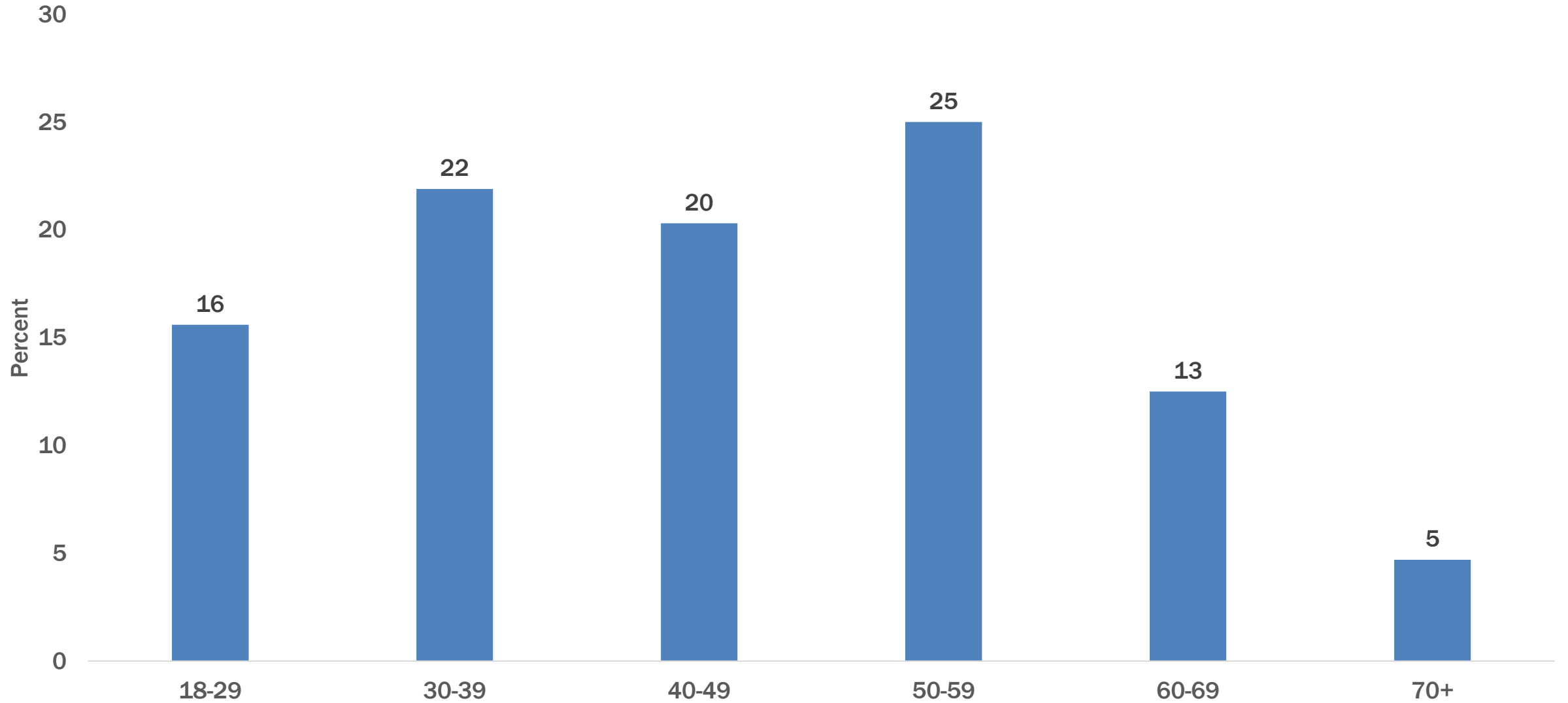


Country Of Origin



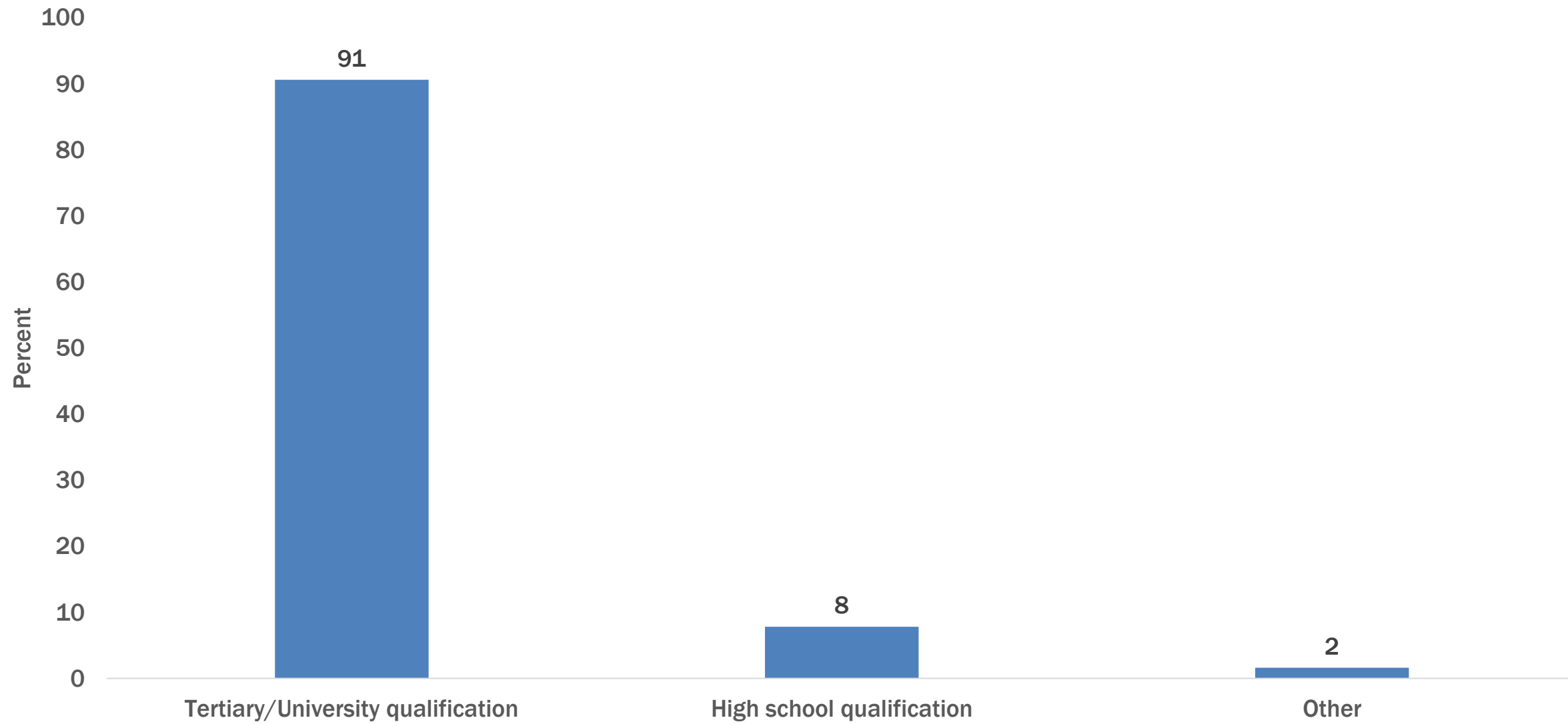

Age Distribution



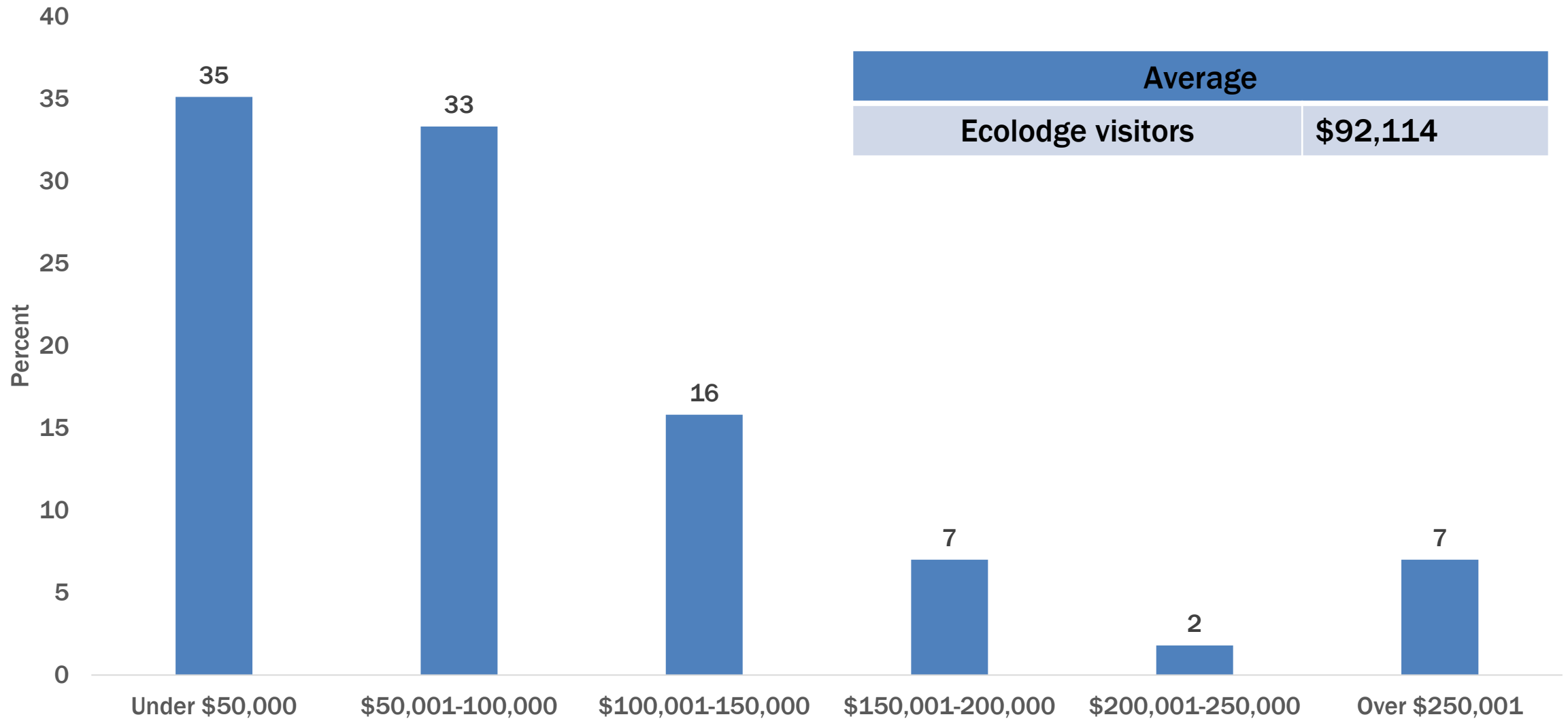

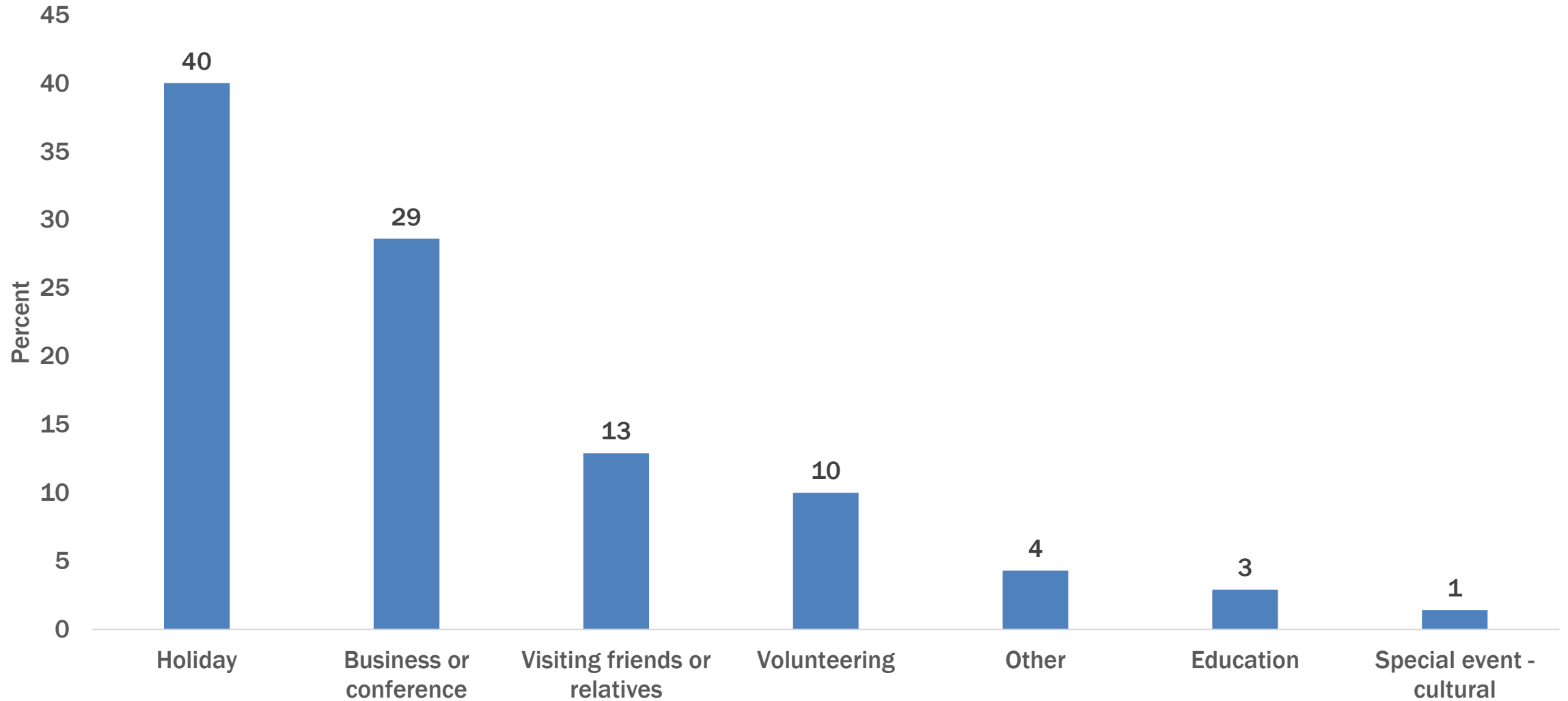

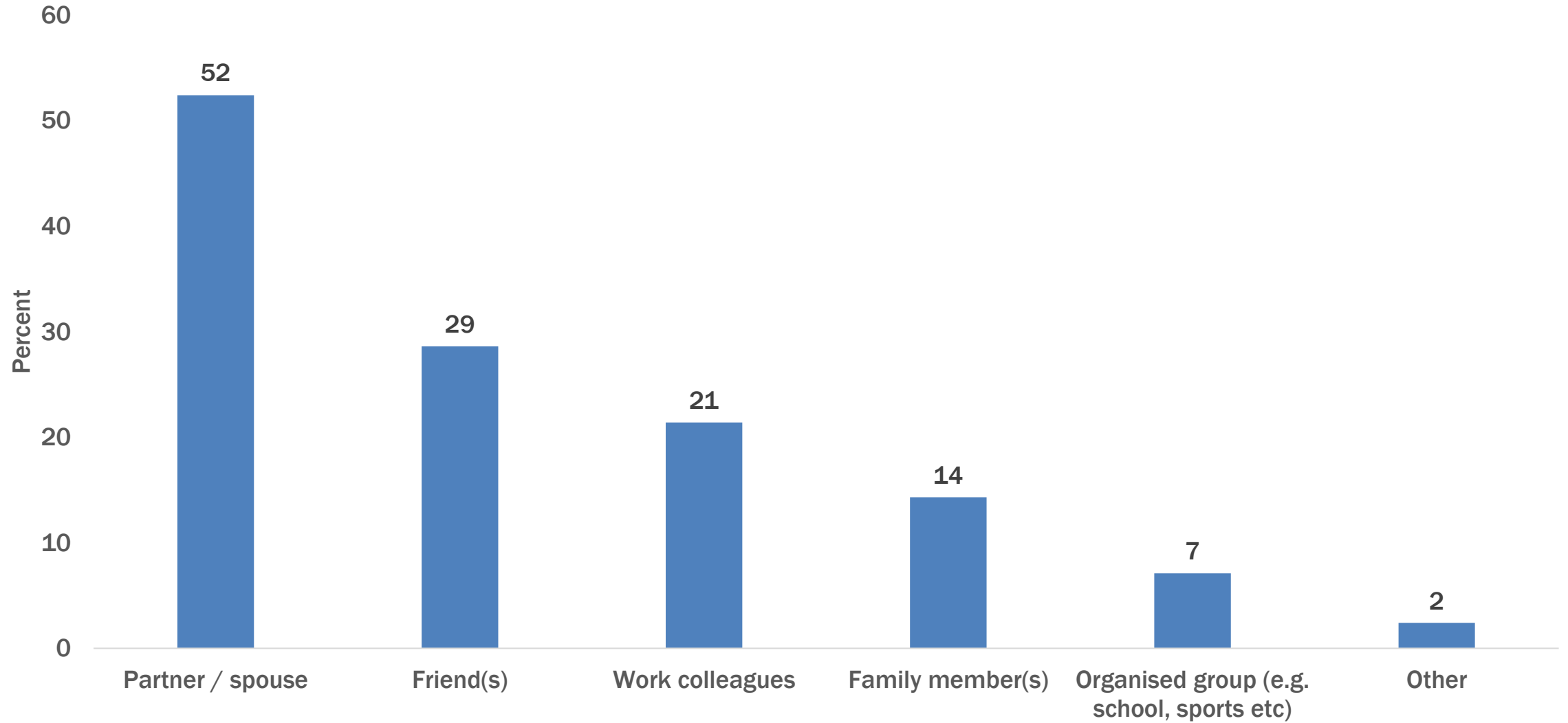
Annual Household Income In USD

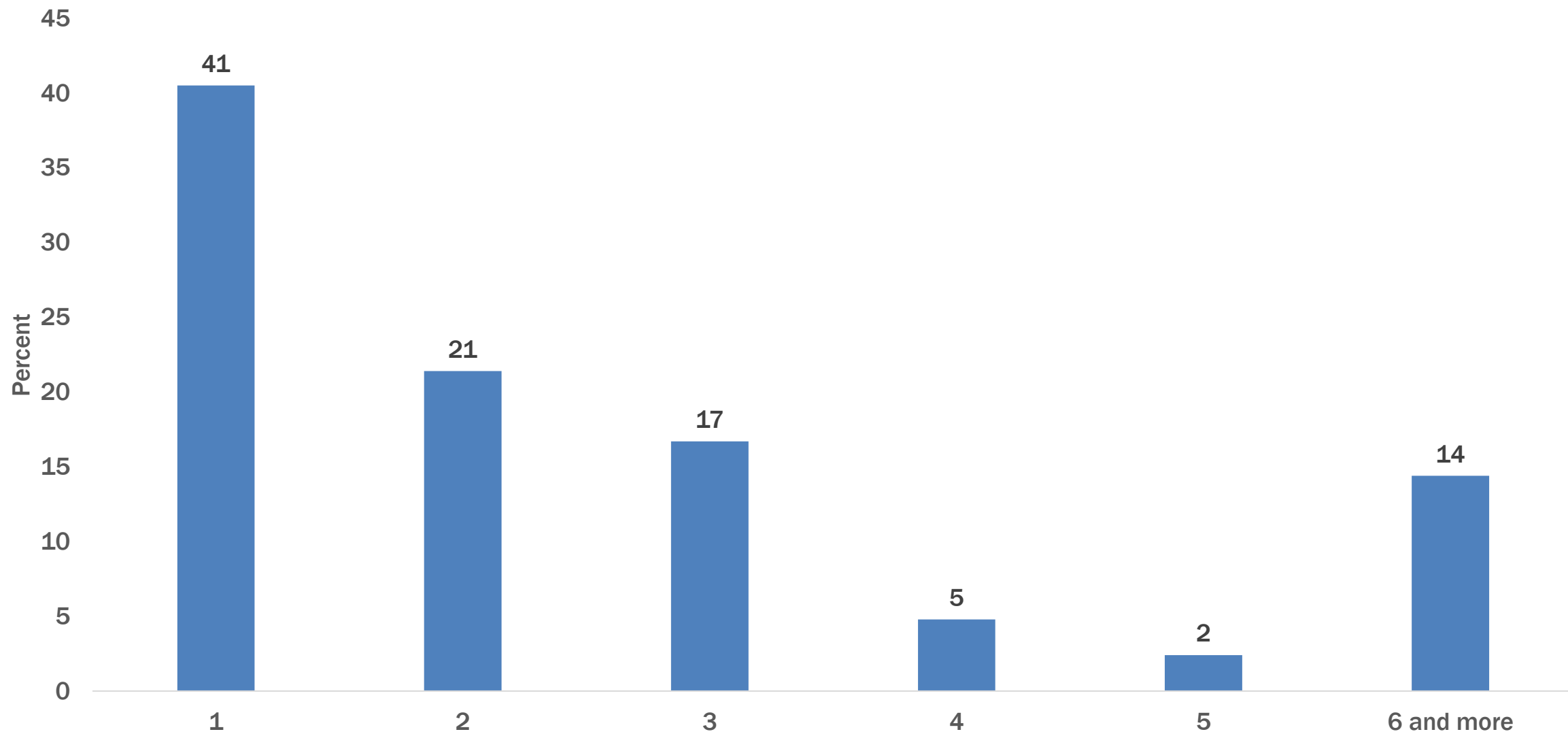

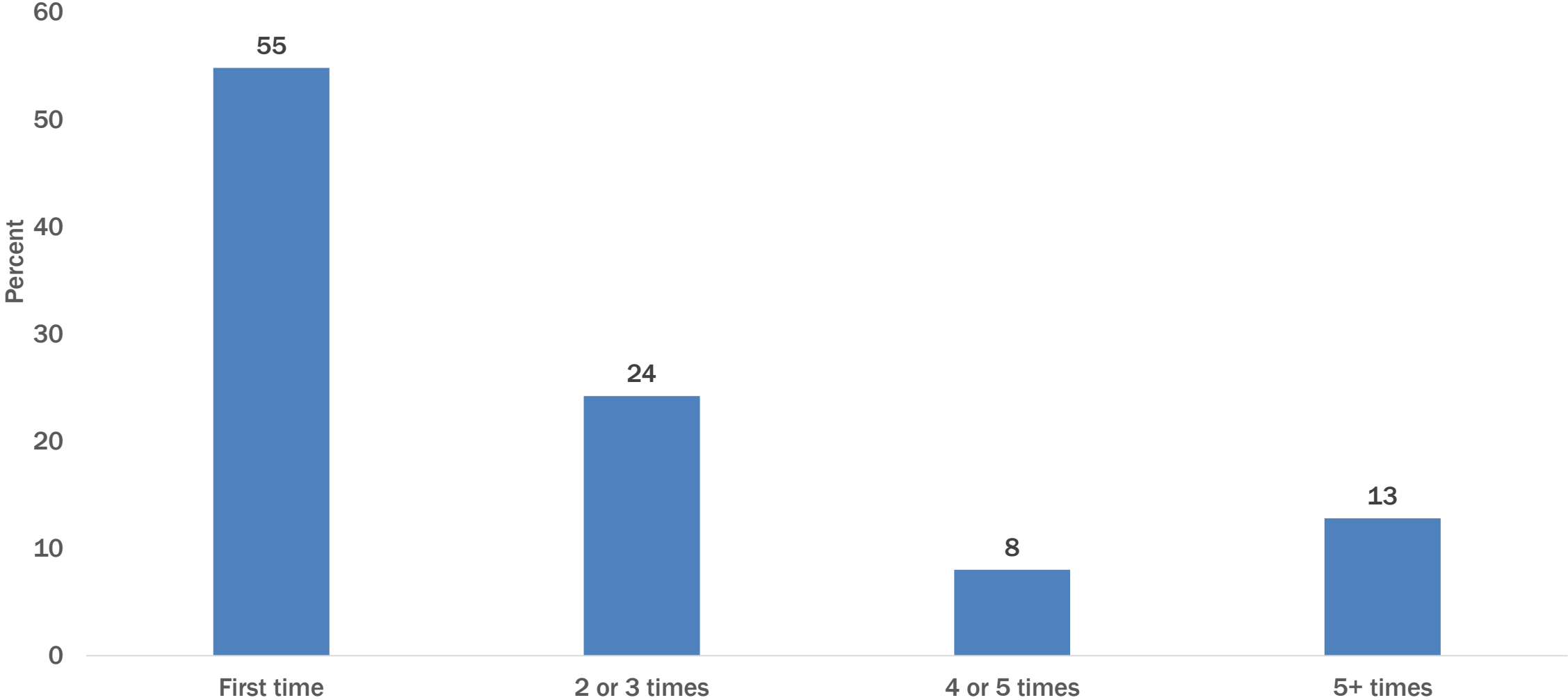

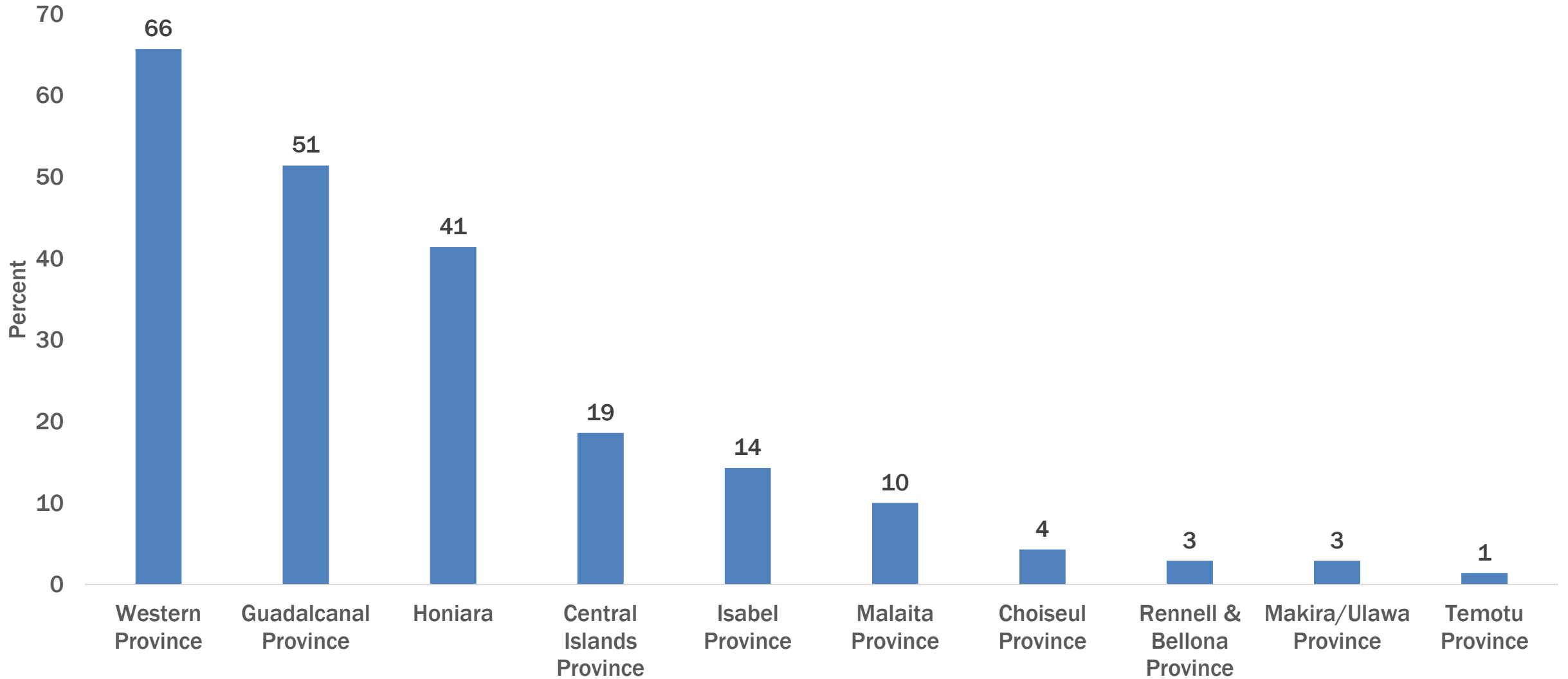
Number Of Companions



Previous Visits (Including Most Recent)

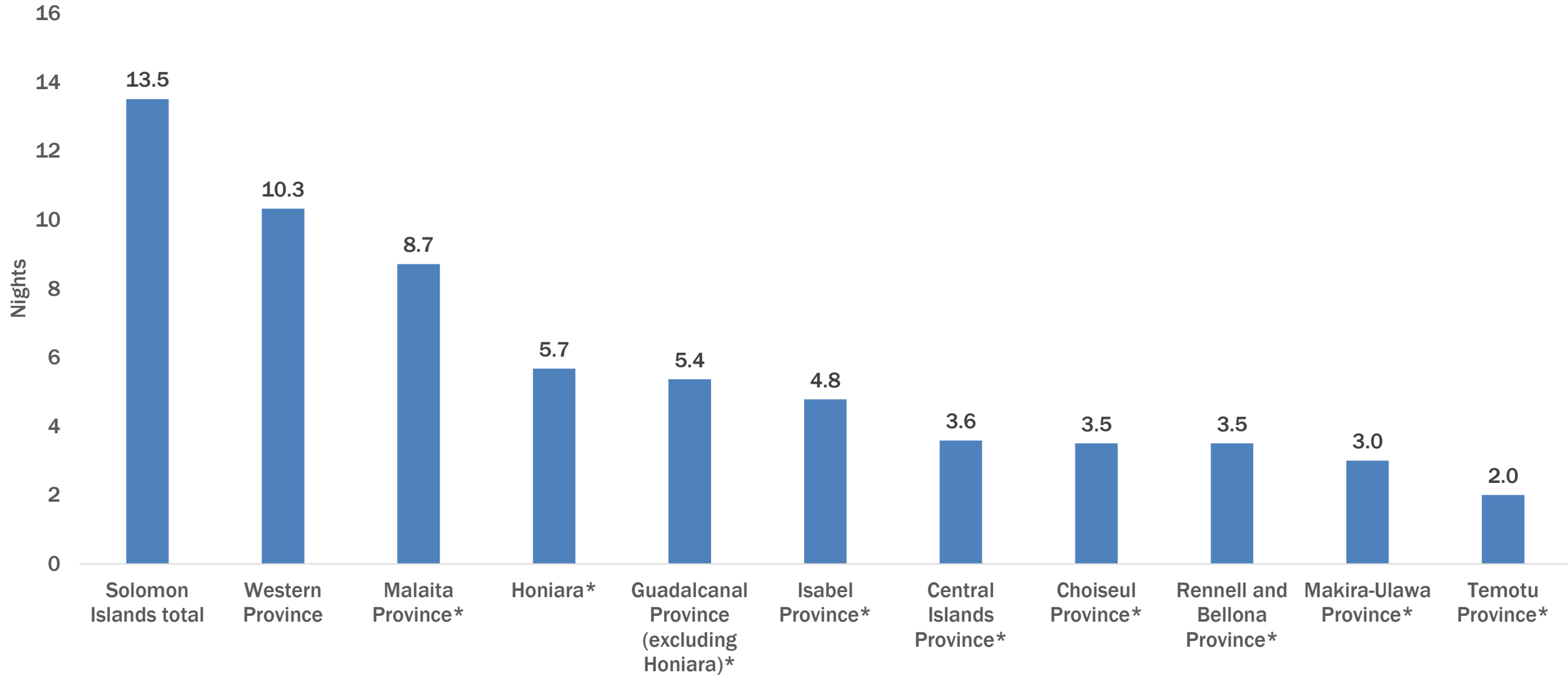


Provinces Visited



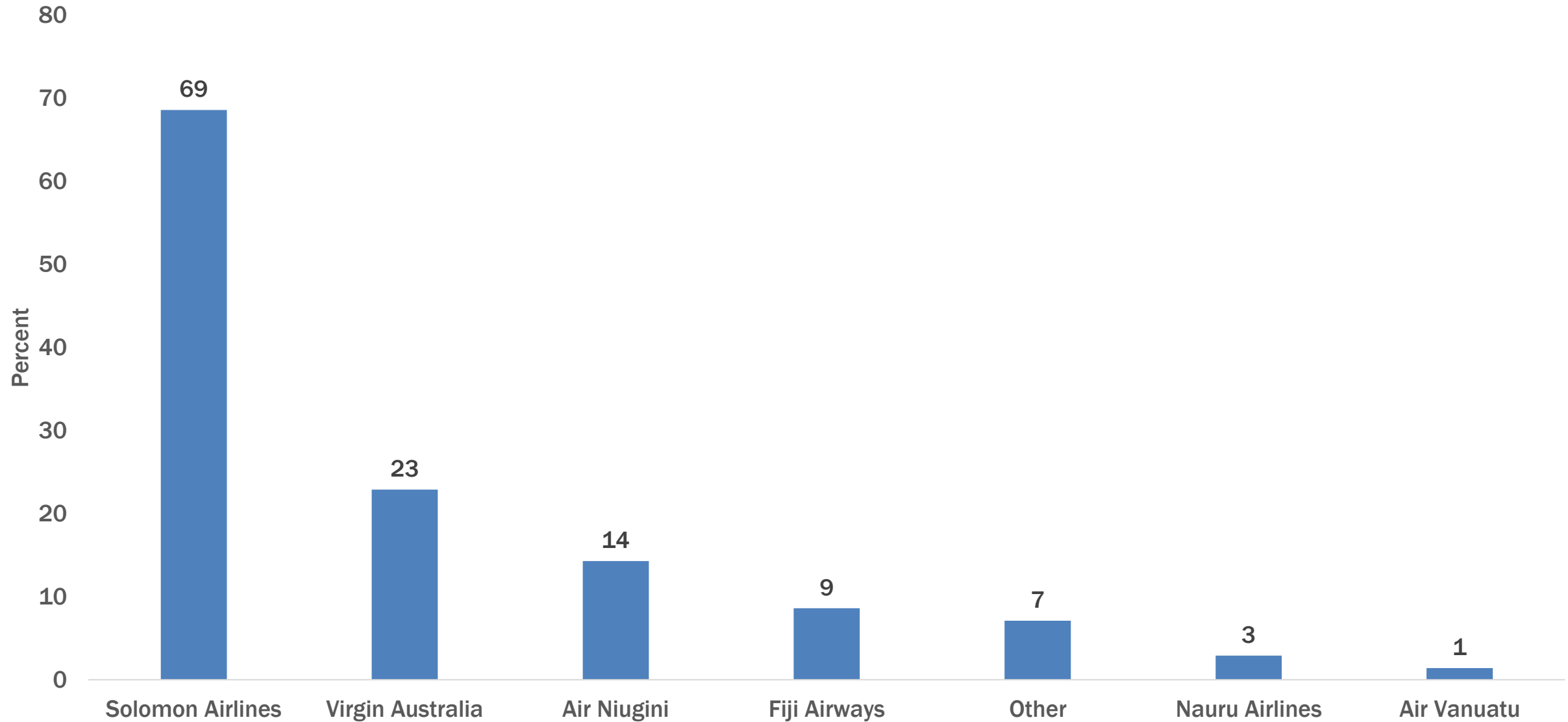

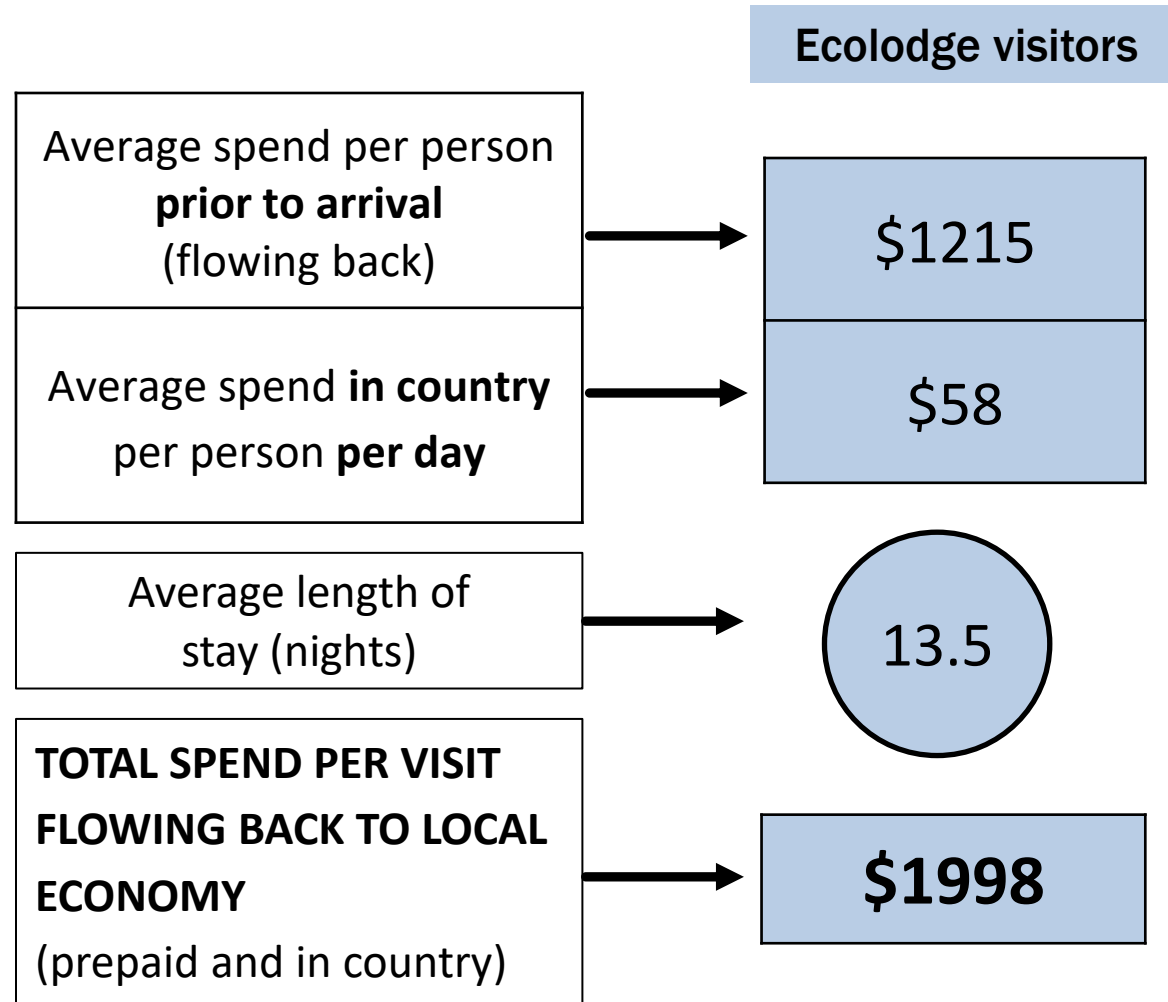

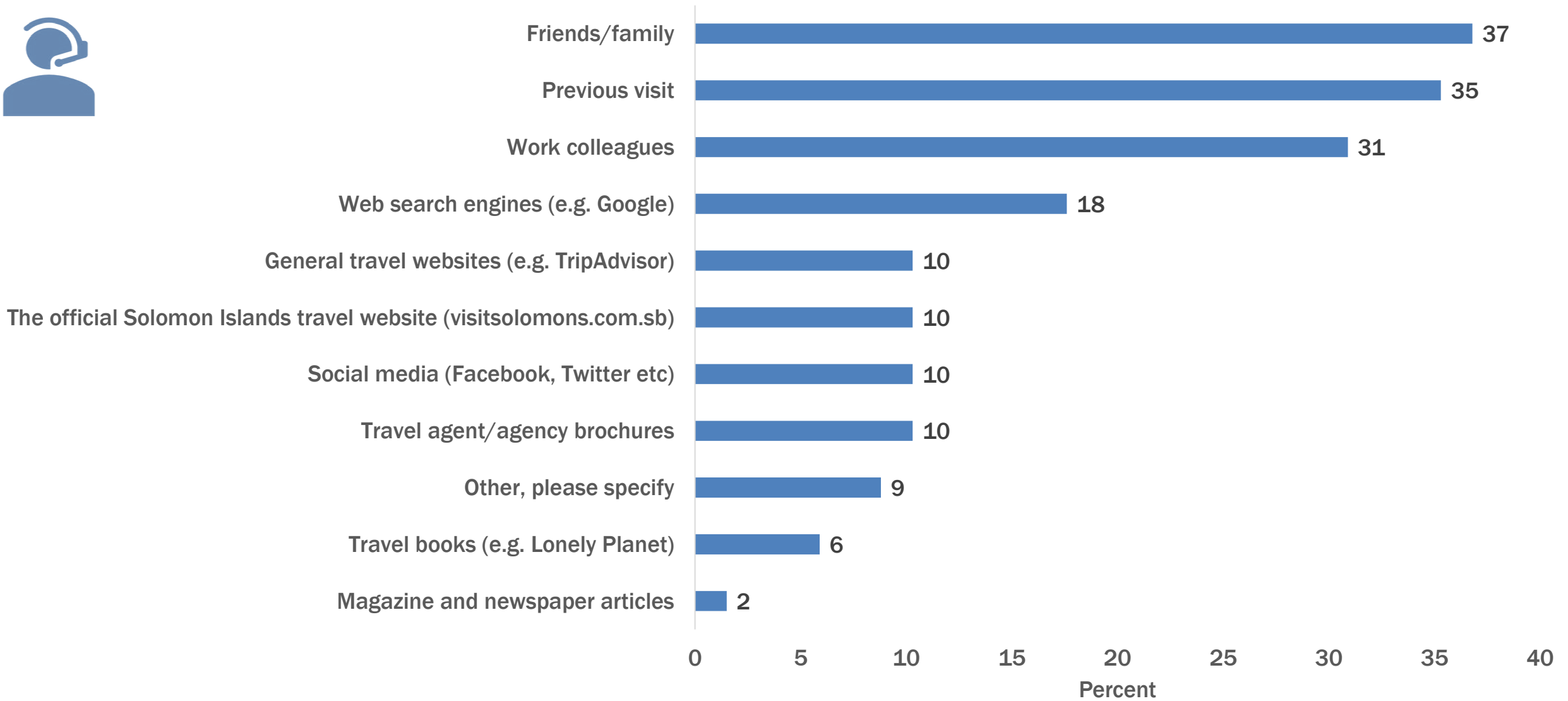

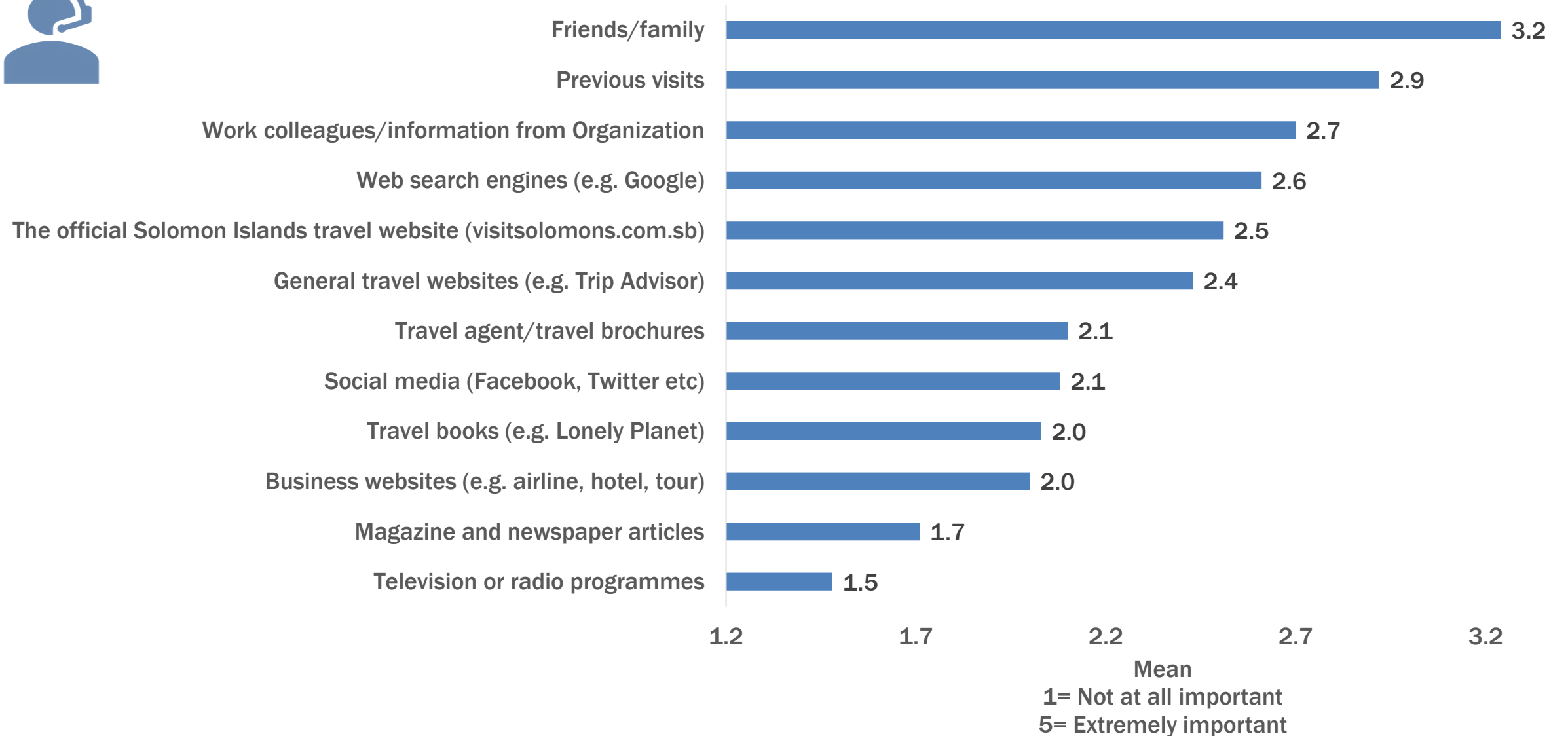

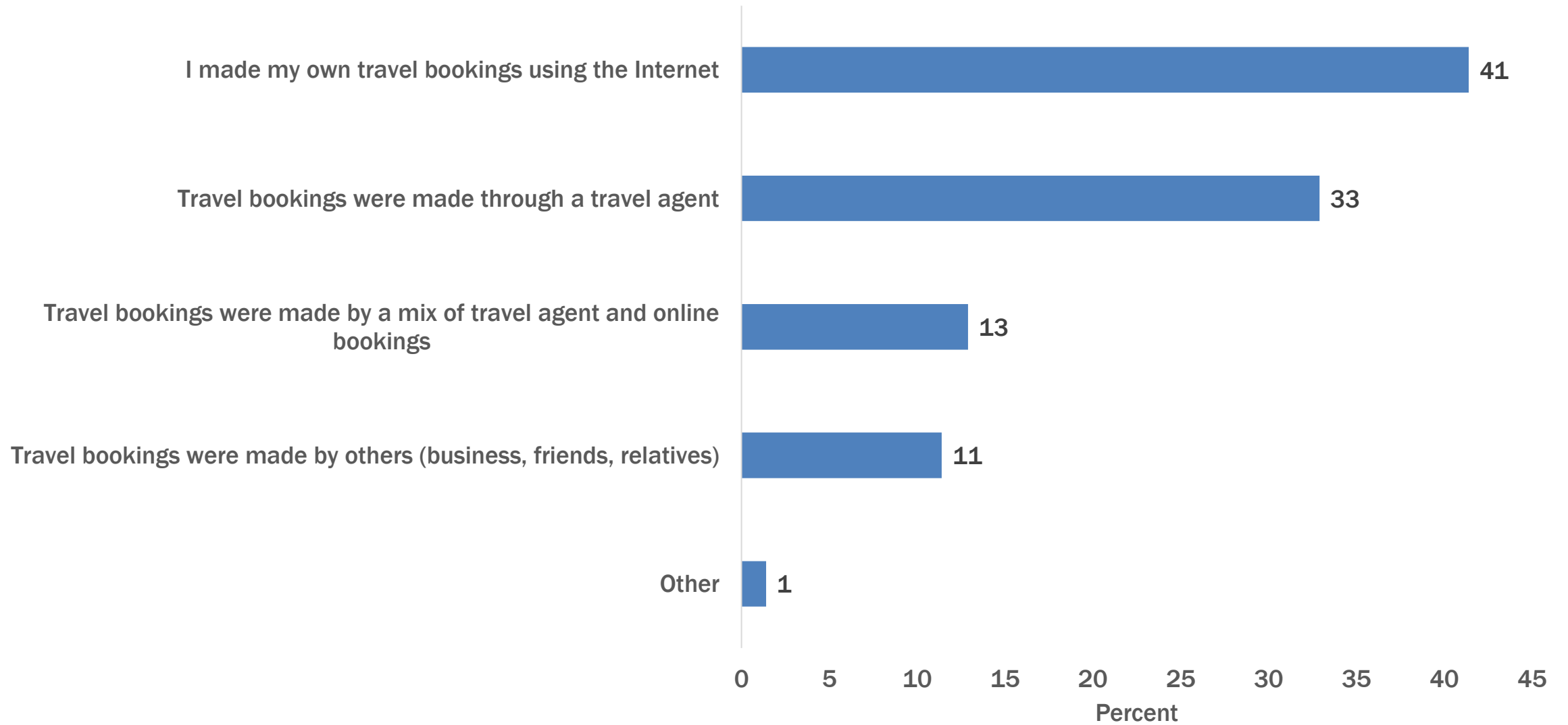

Importance of Information Sources Used For Planning



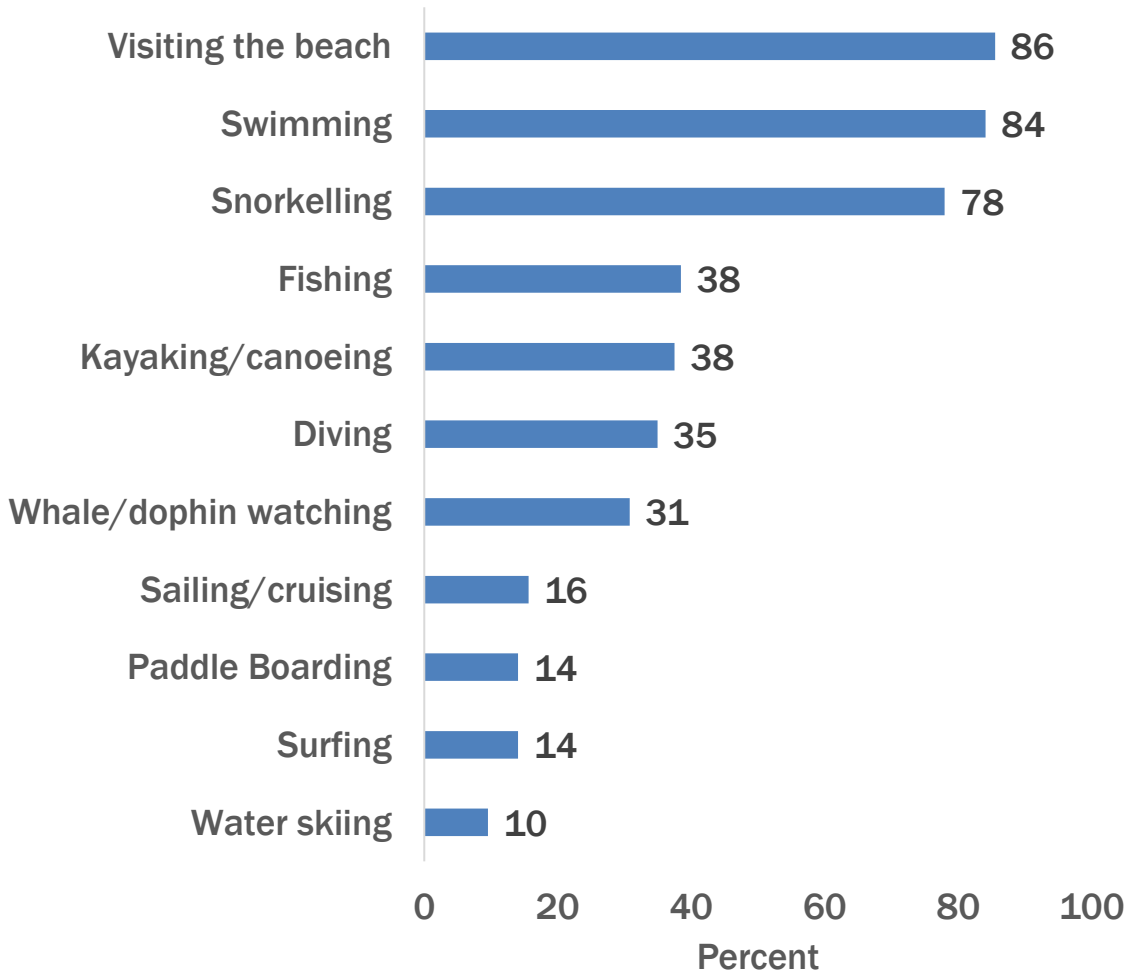

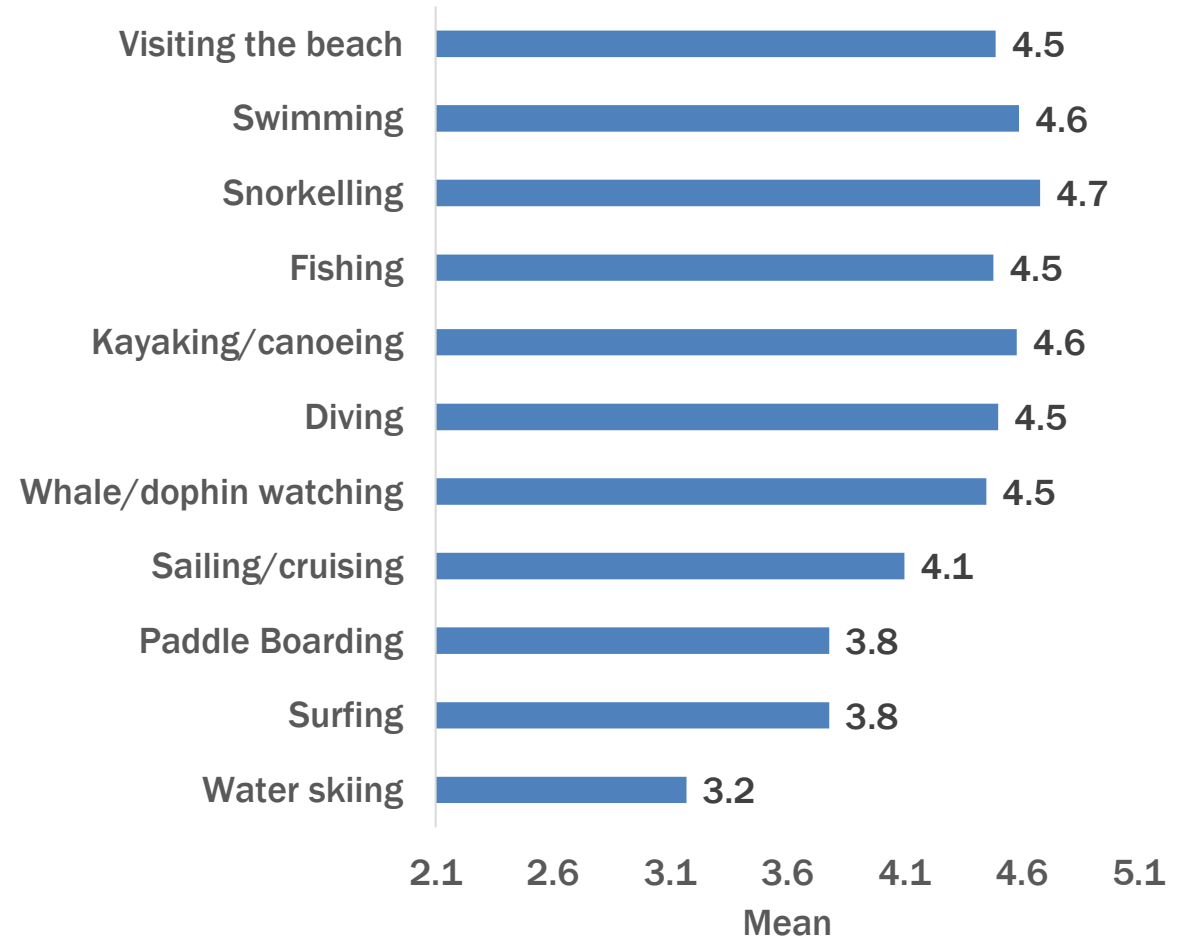

Degree of participation



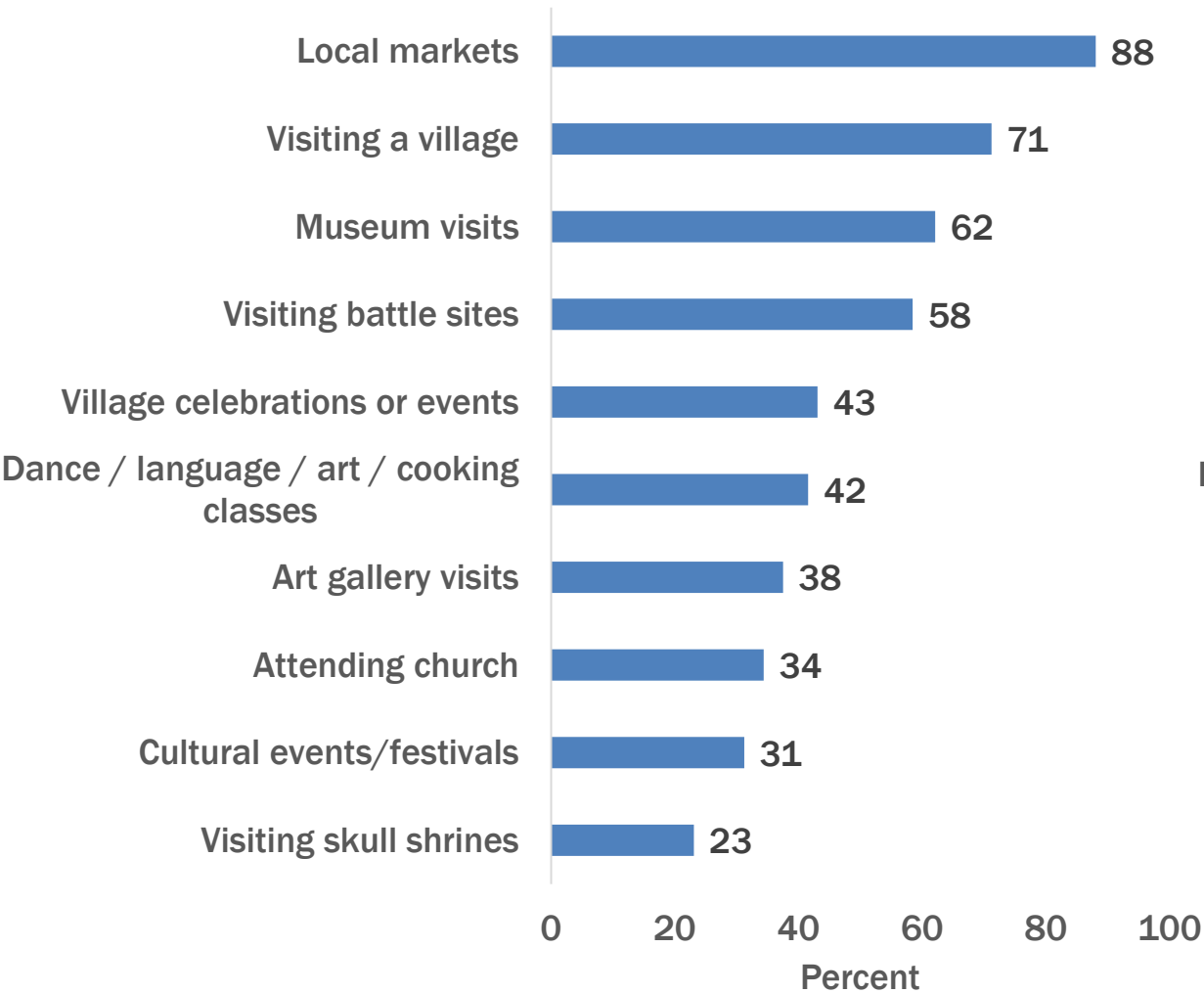

Degree of participation



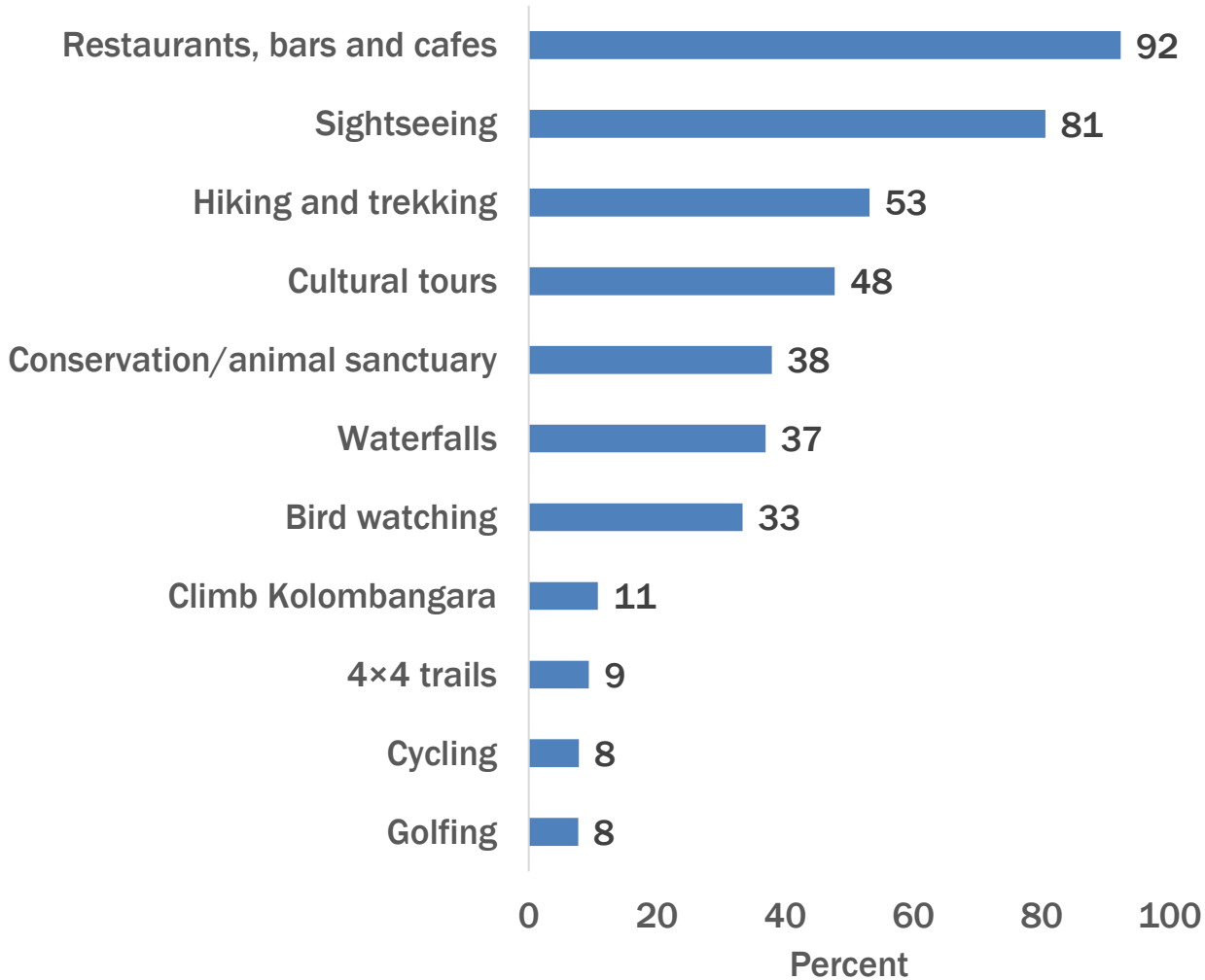

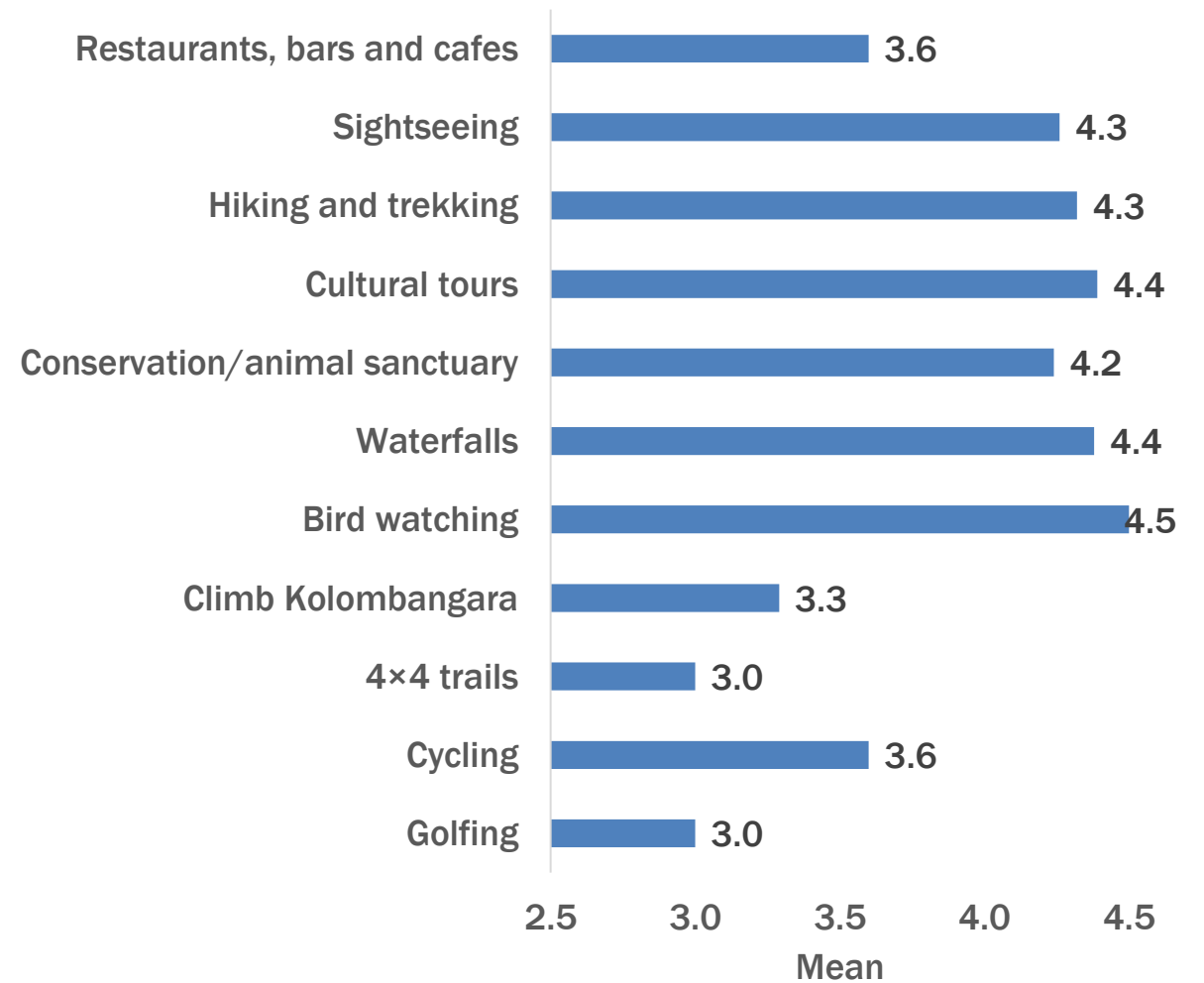

Degree of participation



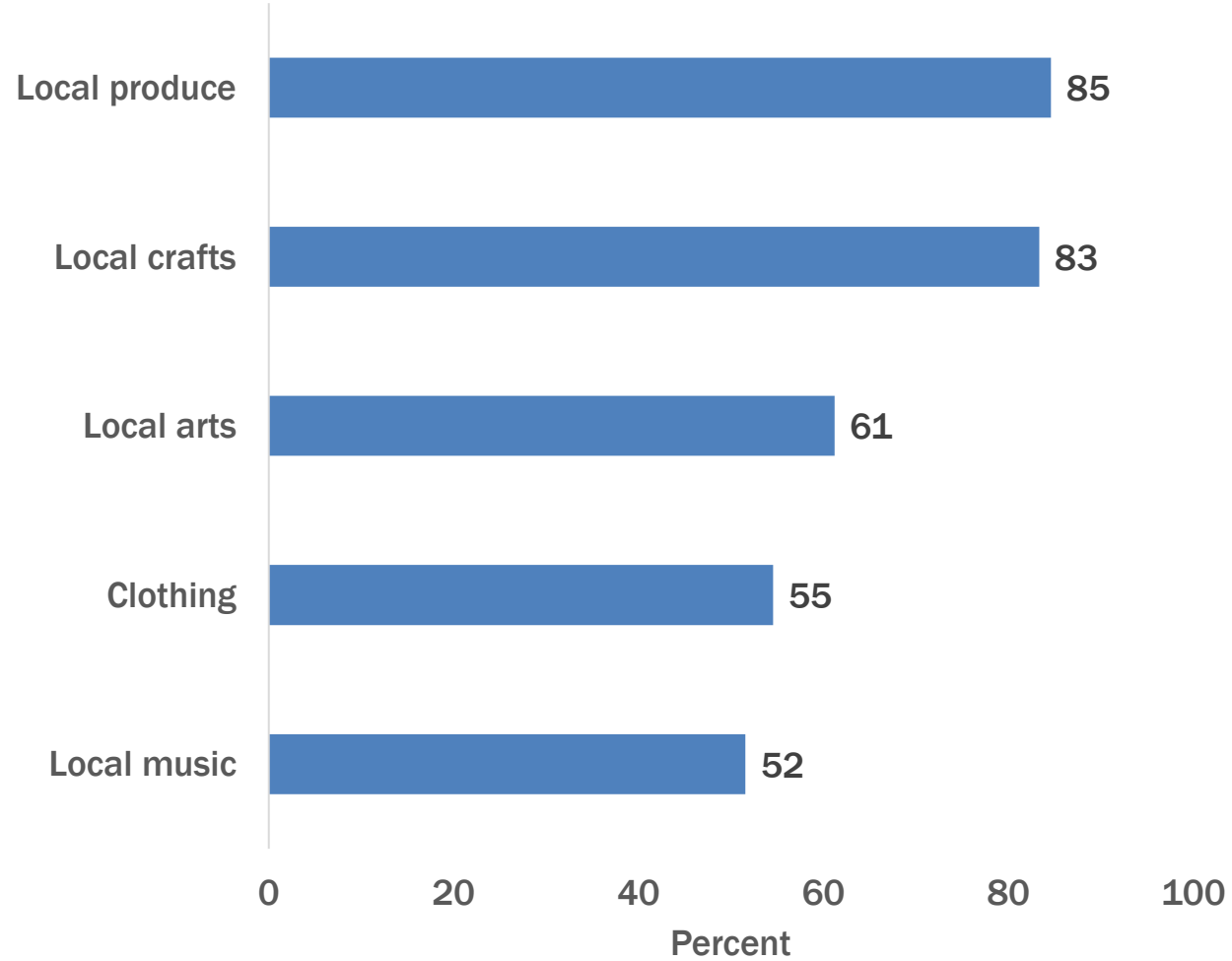

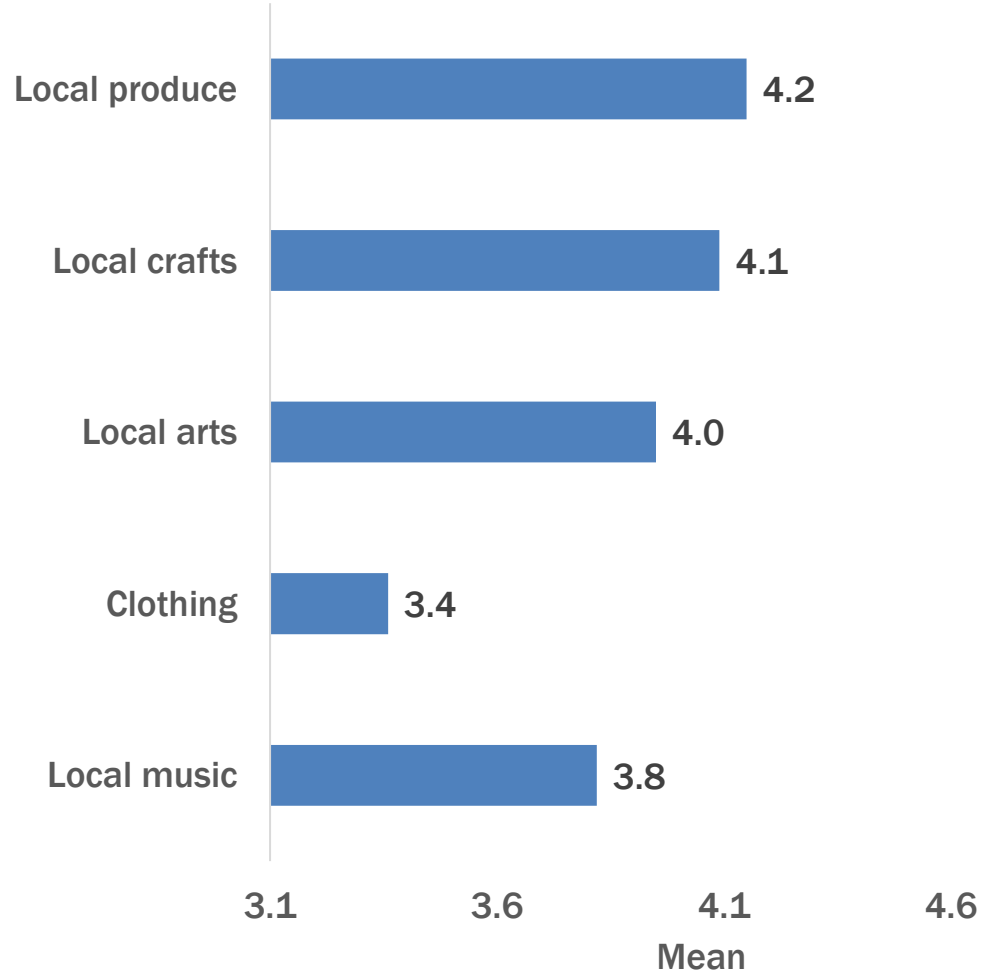

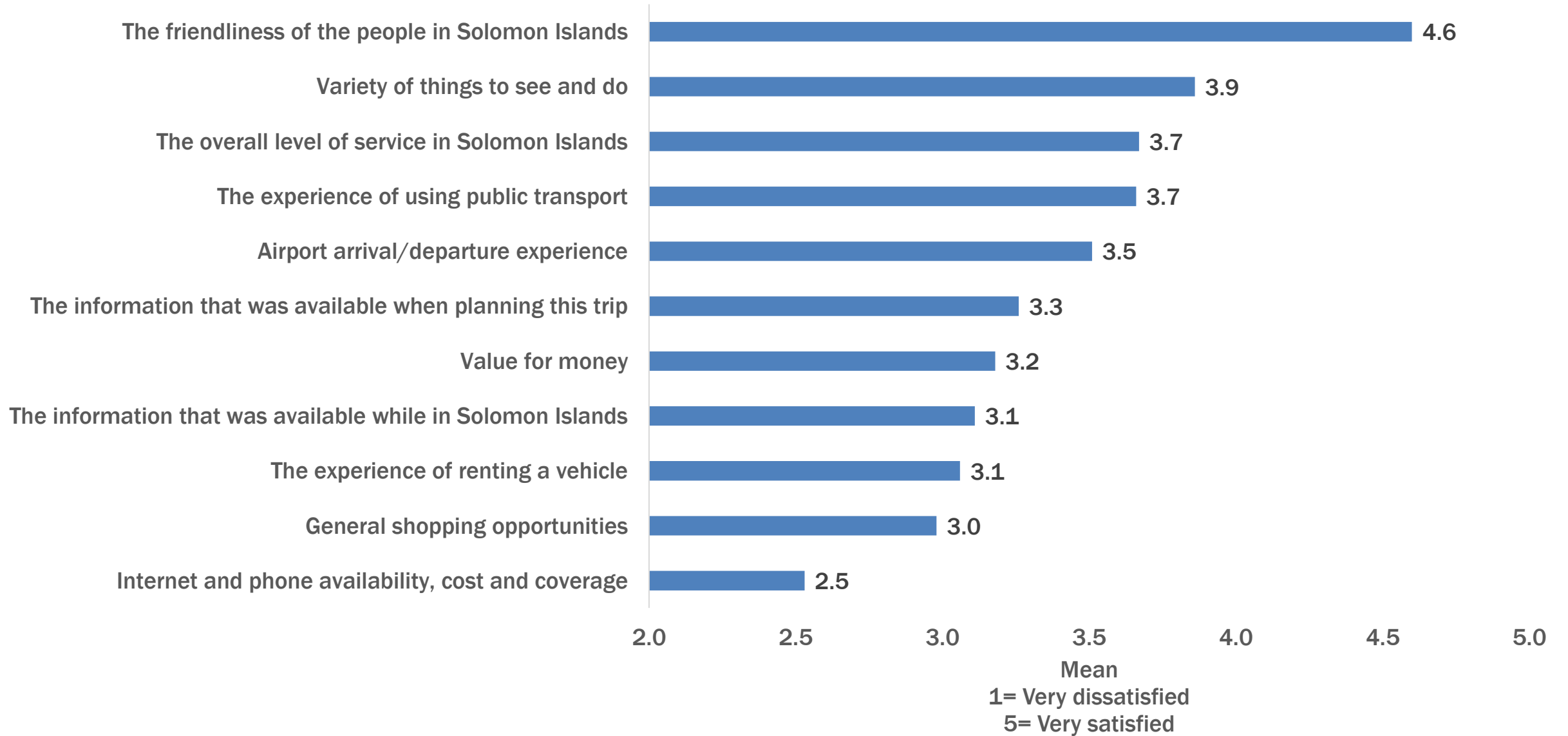

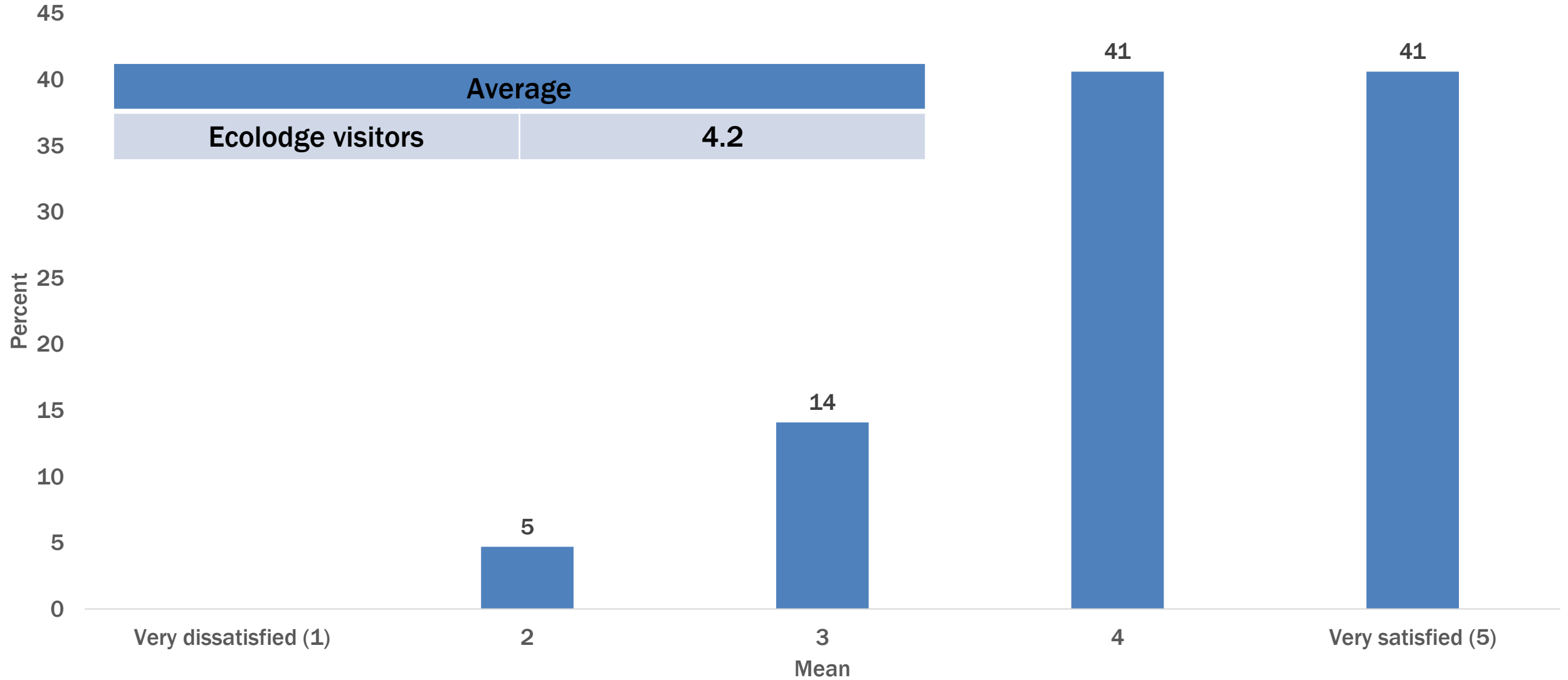
