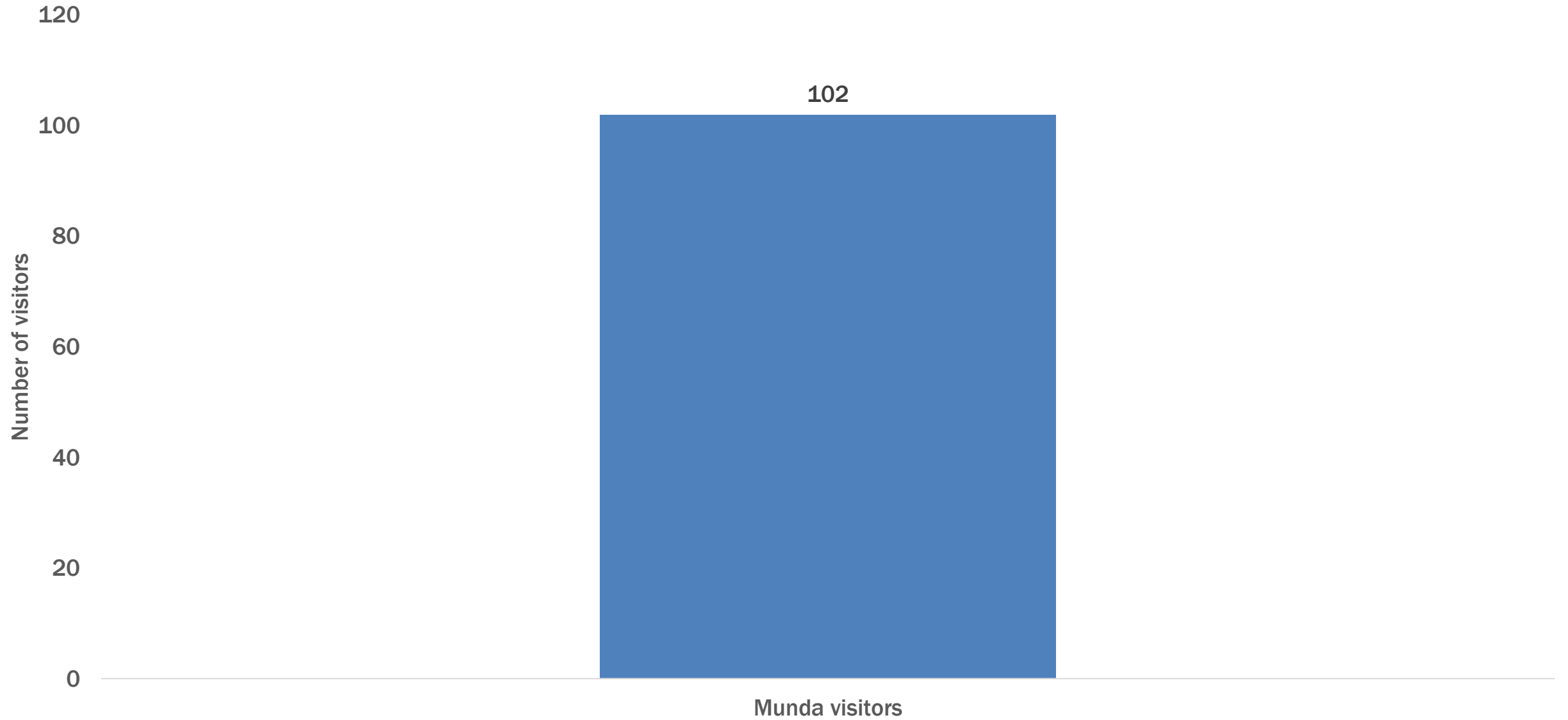

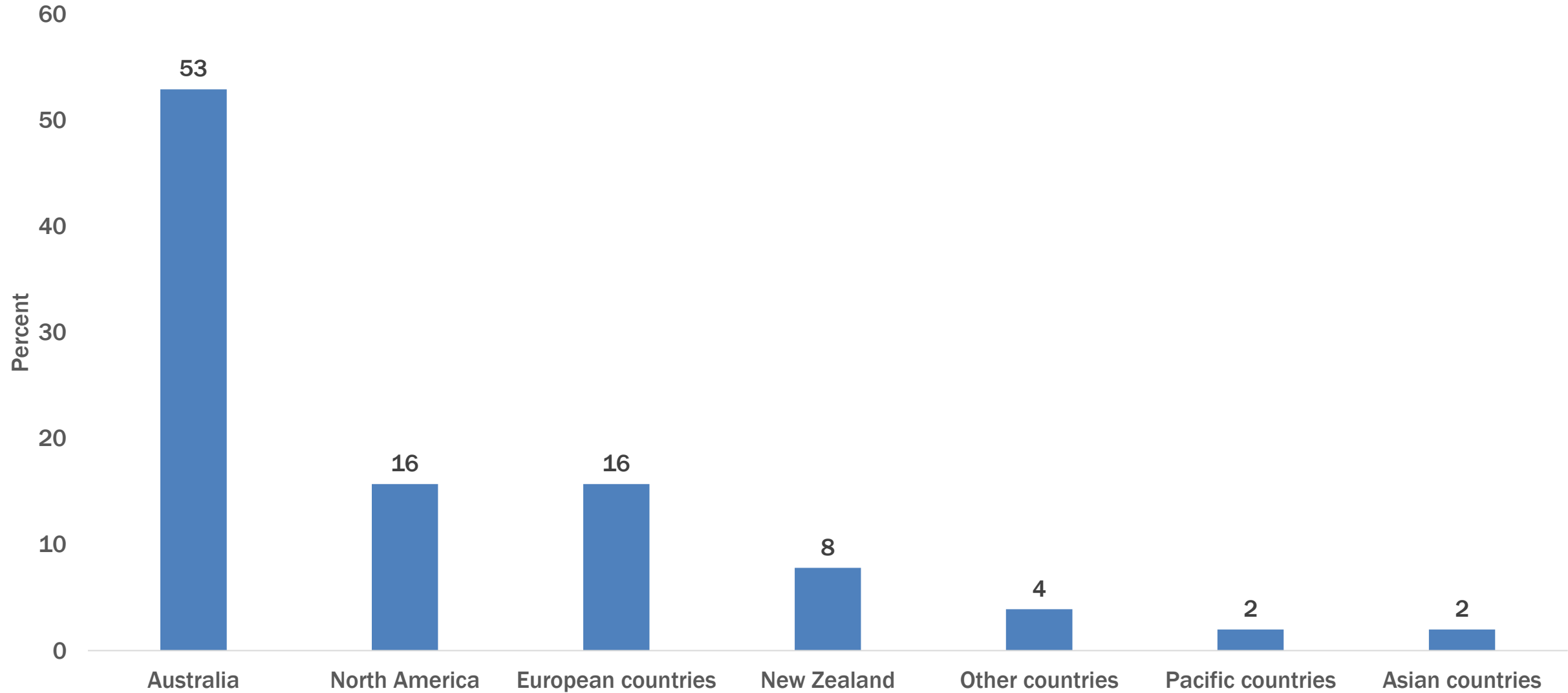

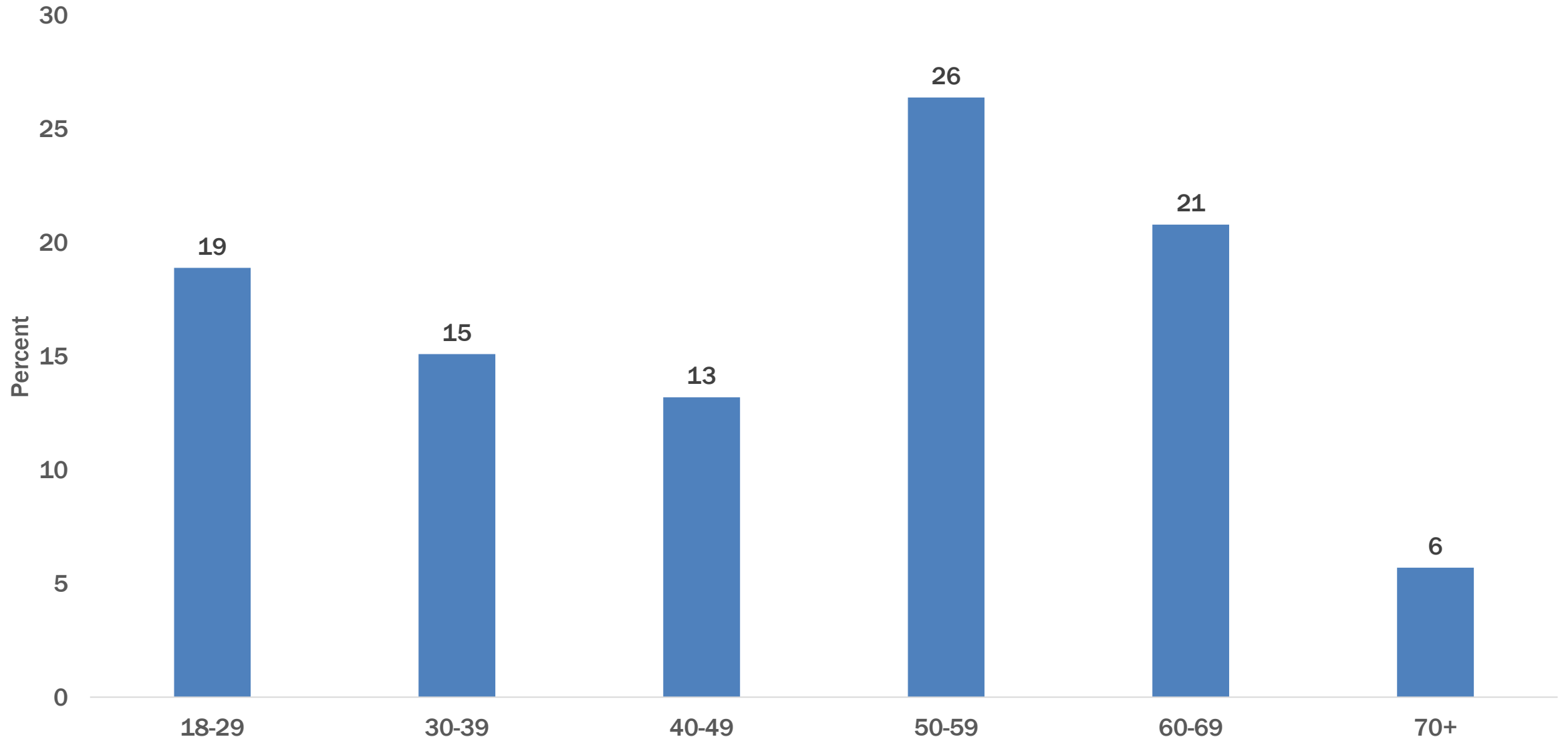


# Country Of Origin

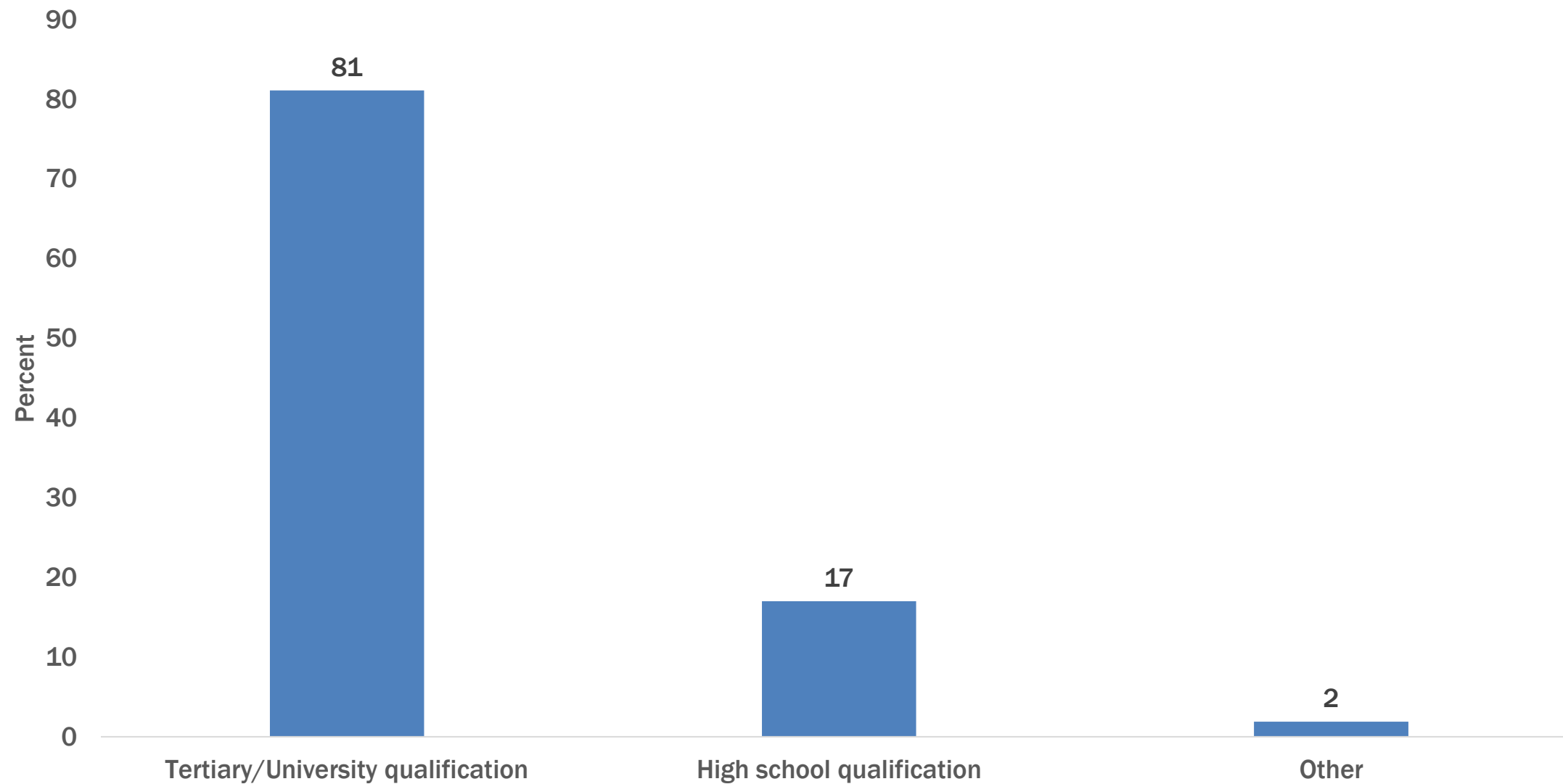

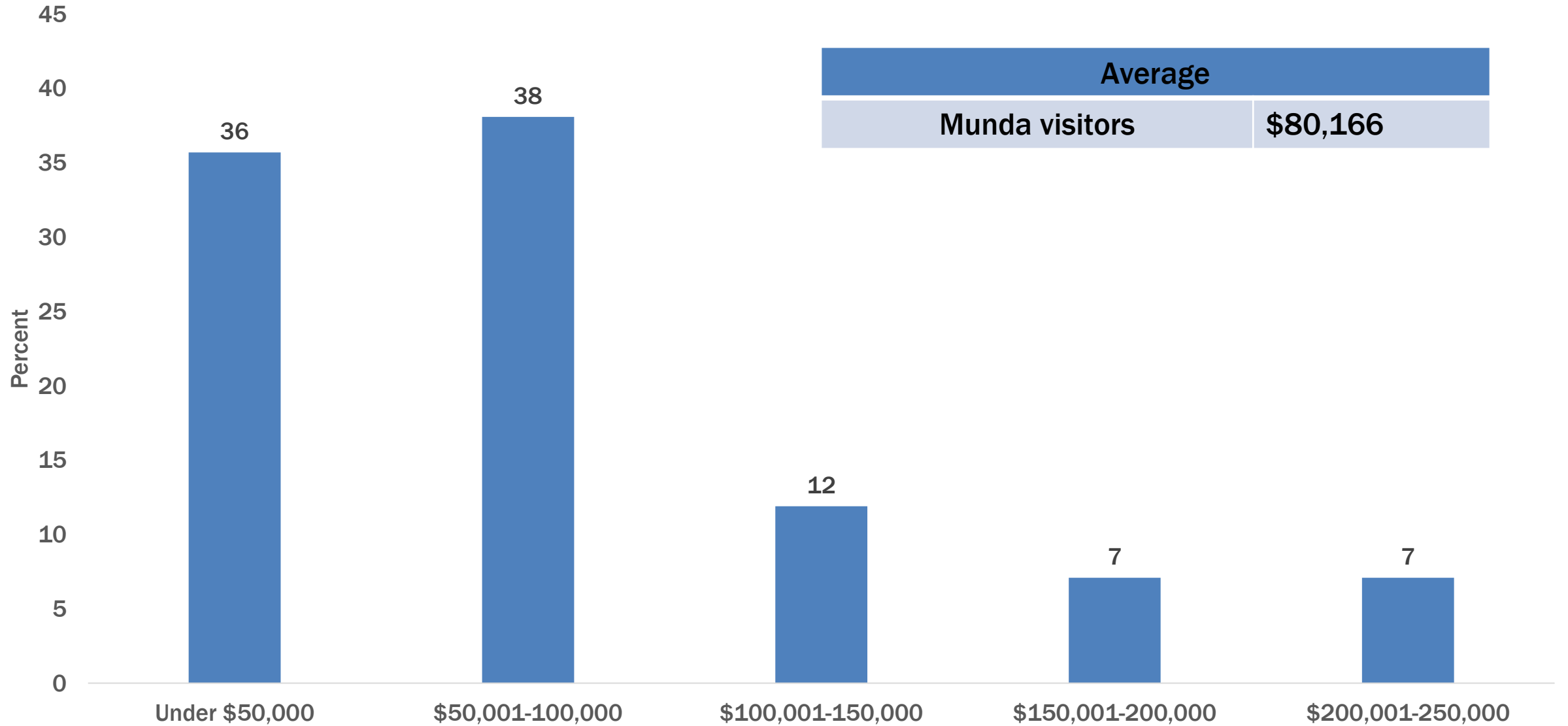

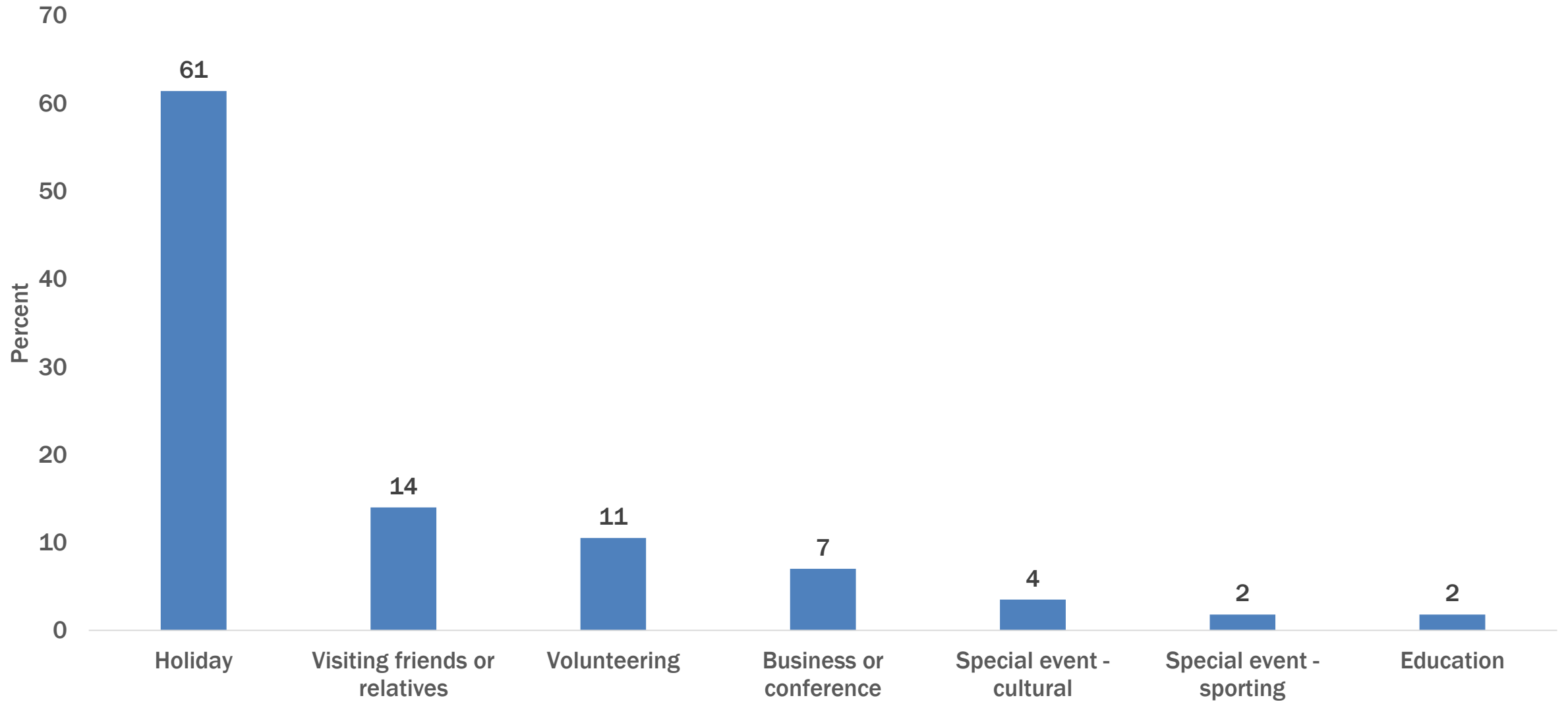

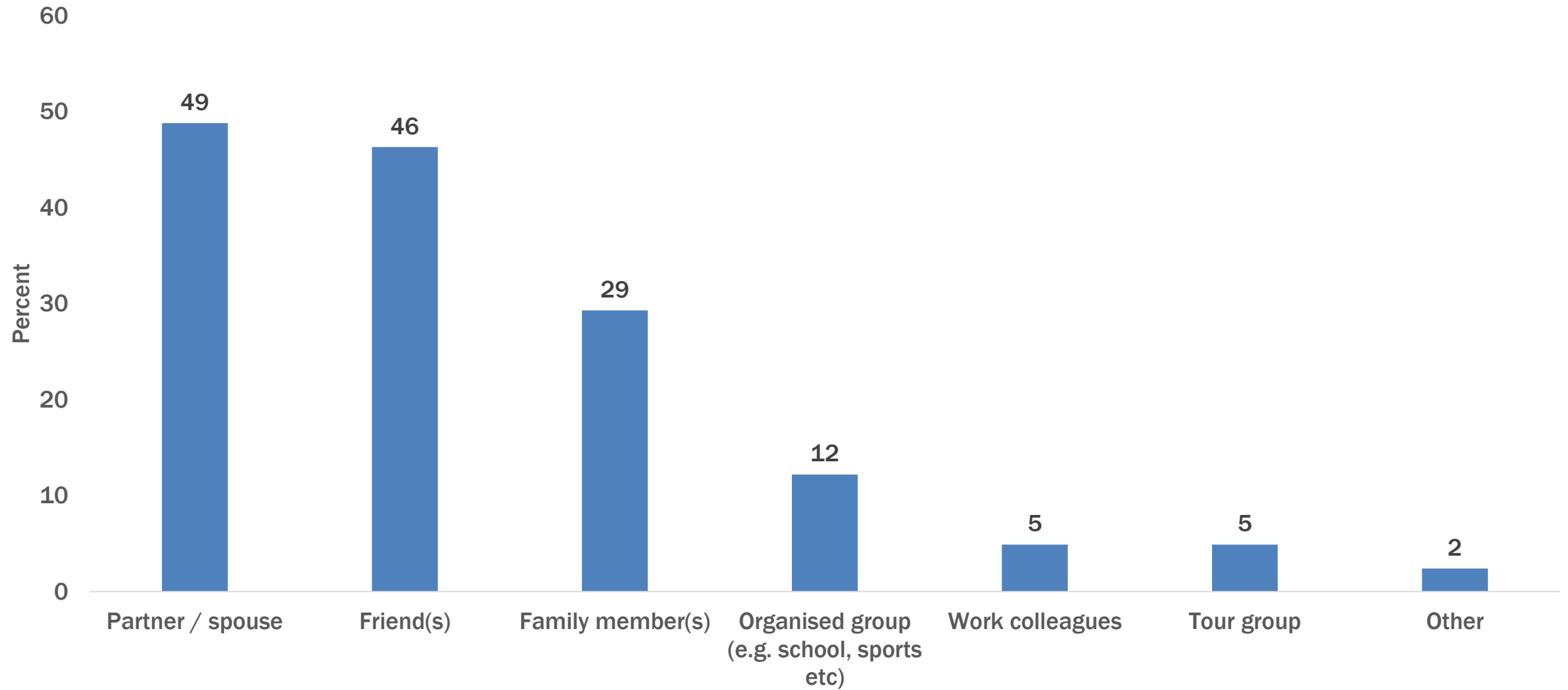

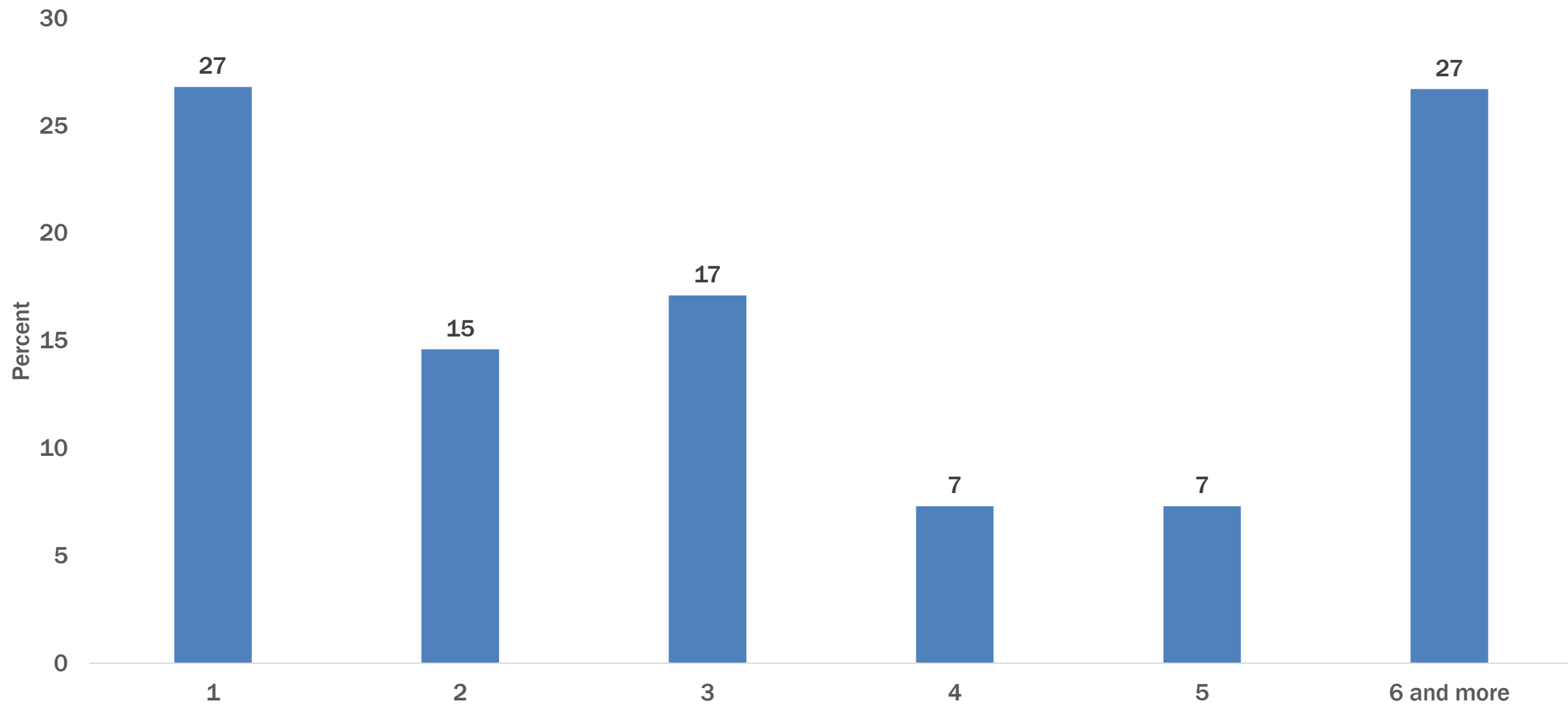

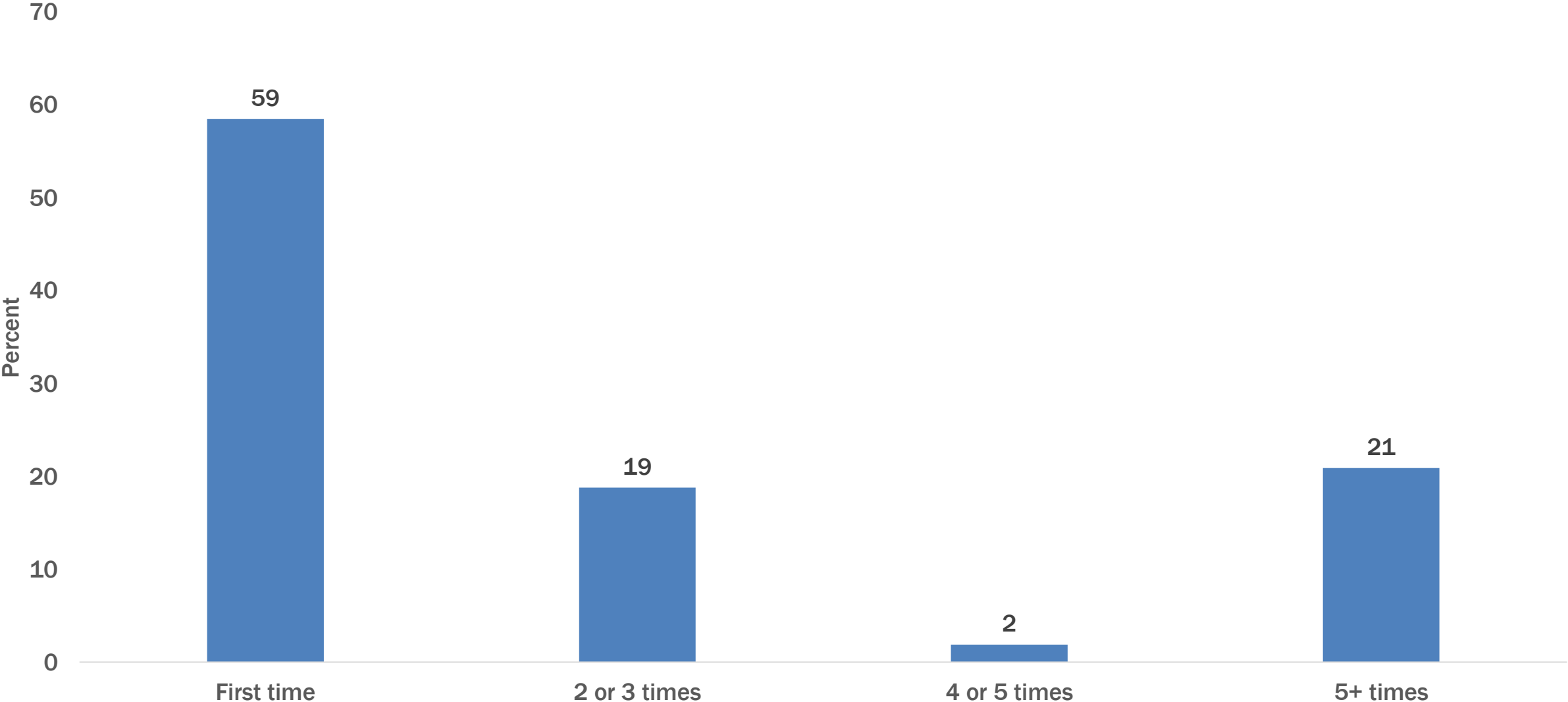

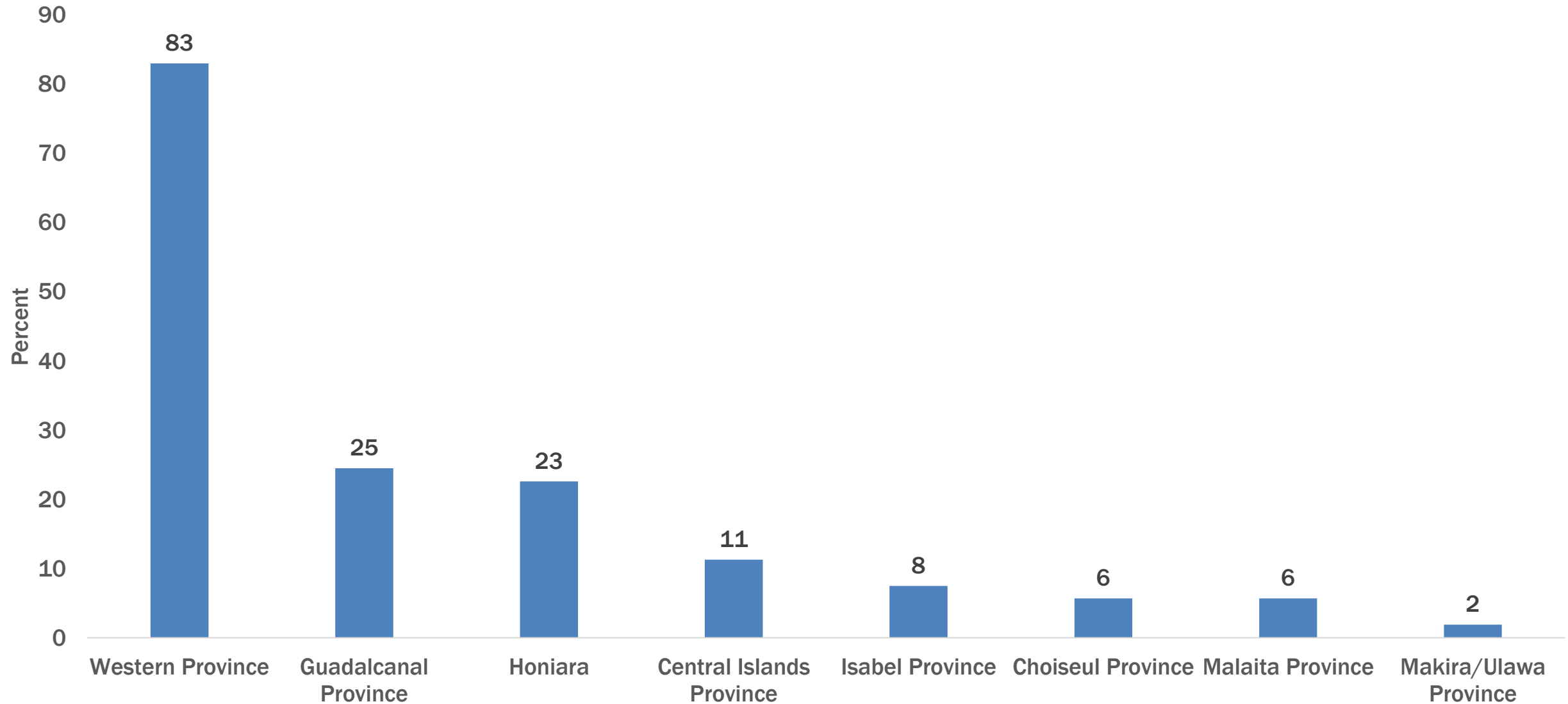

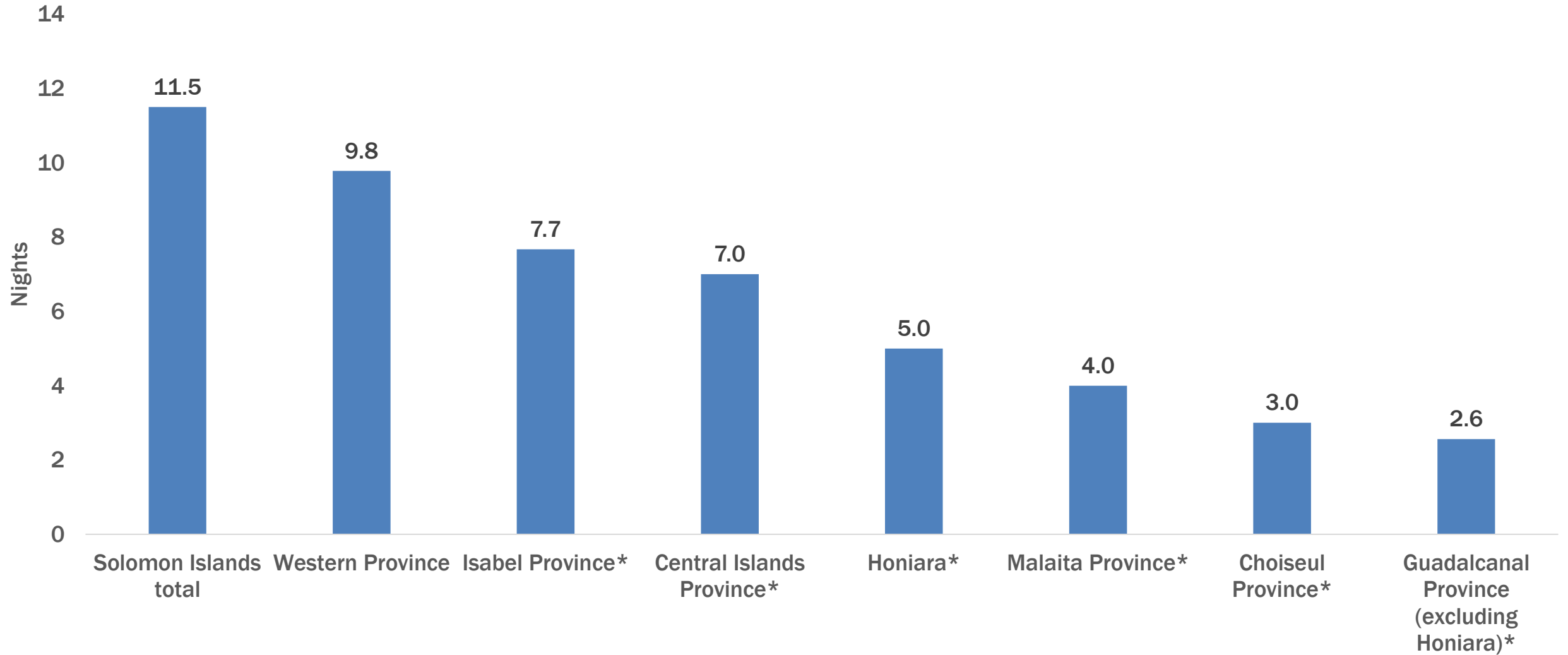


# Provinces Visited



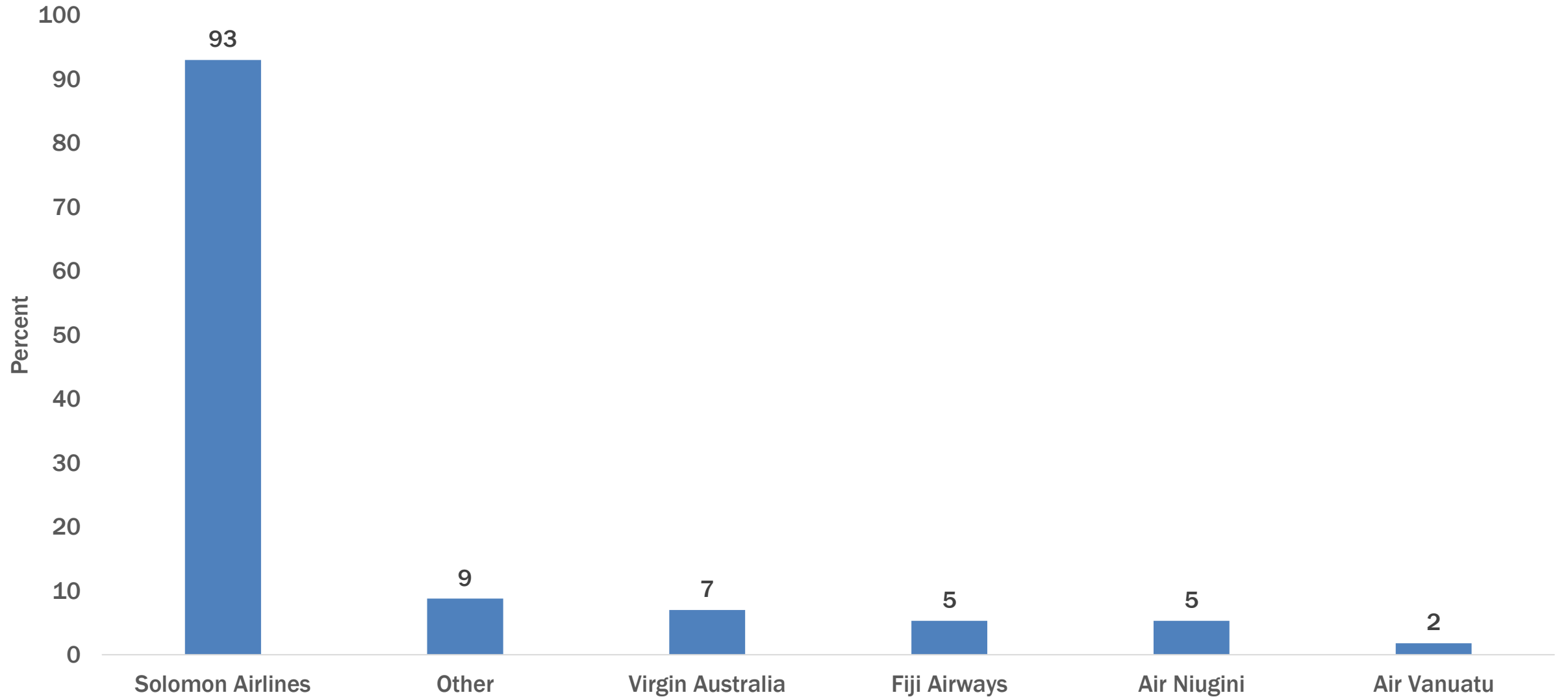

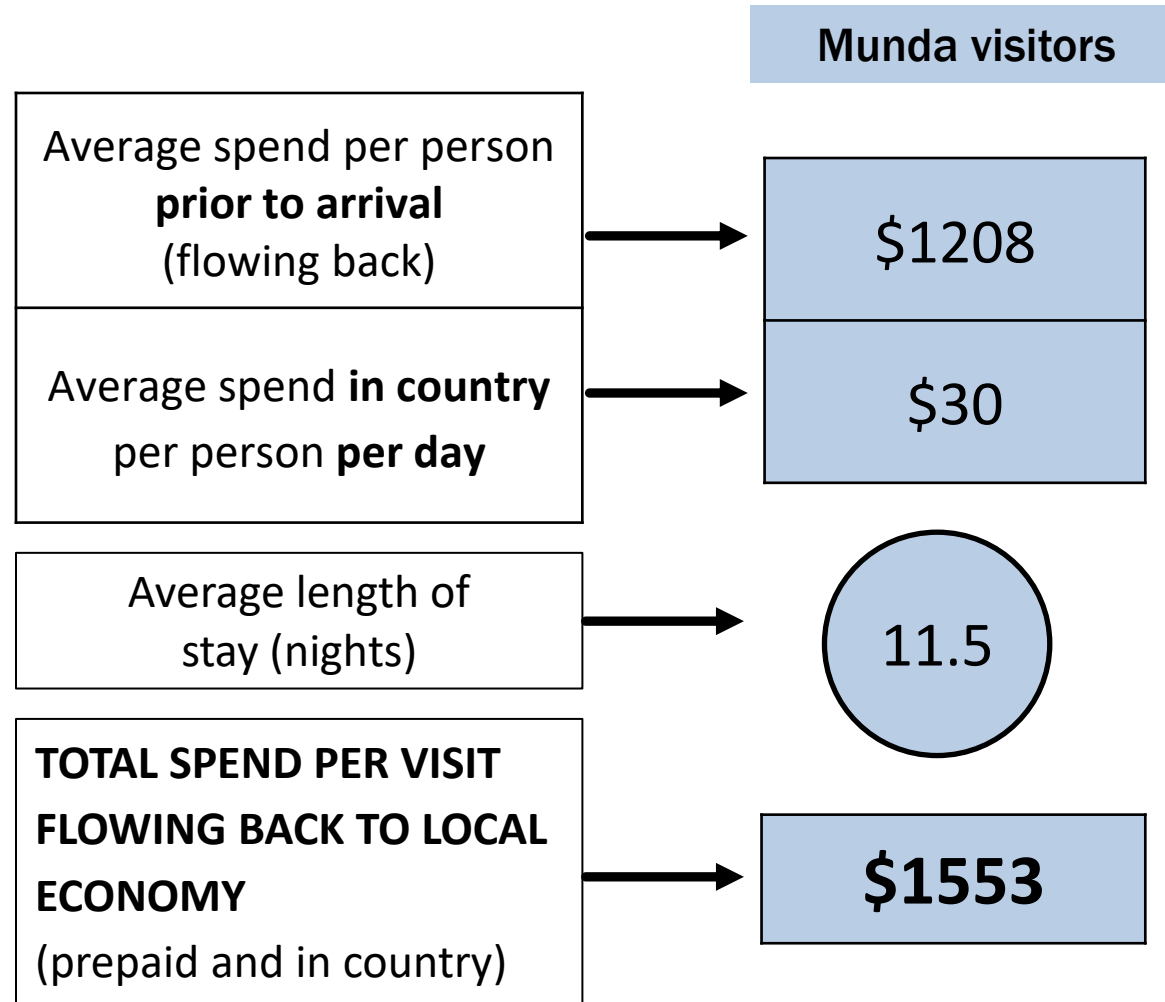

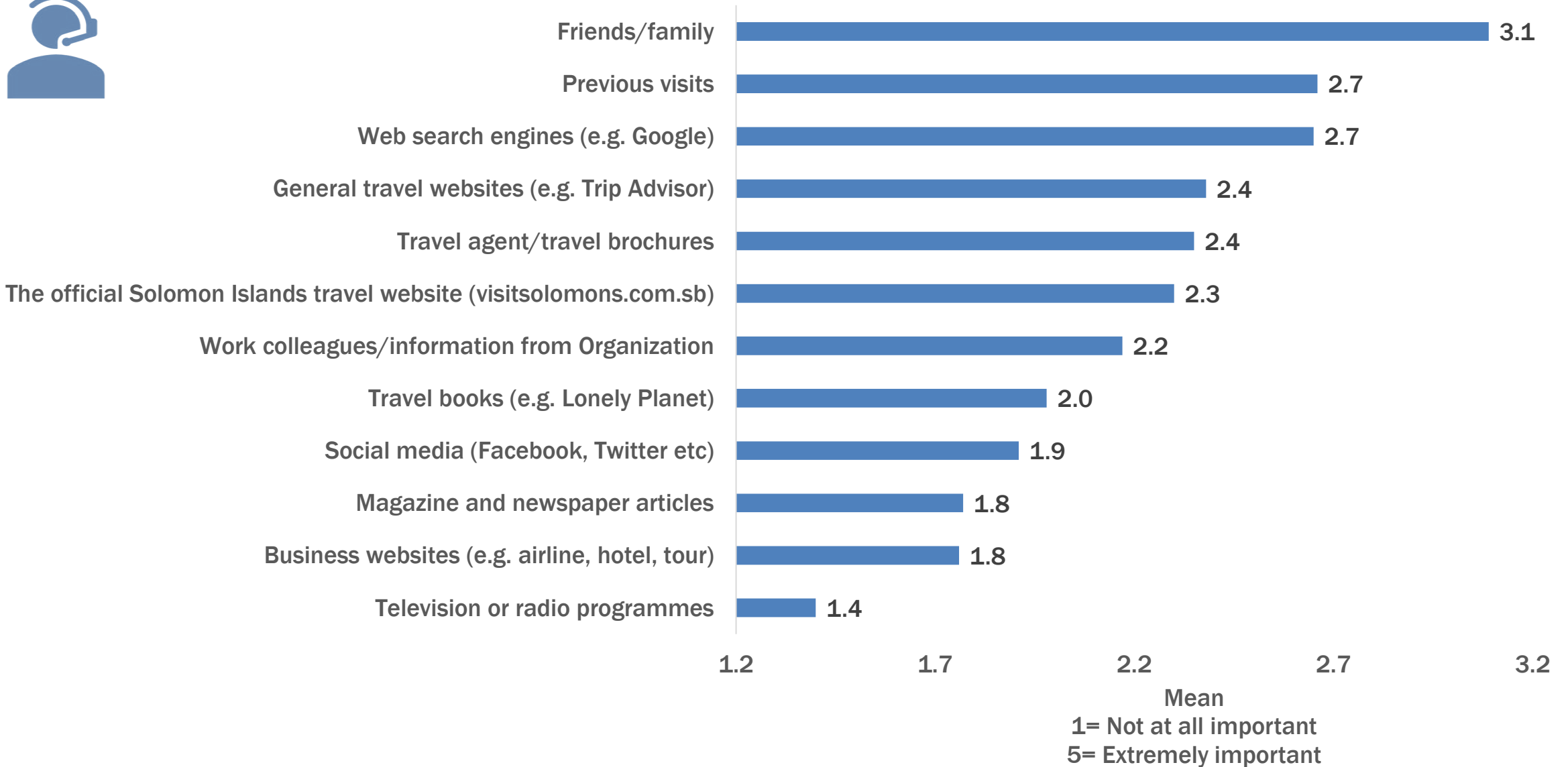

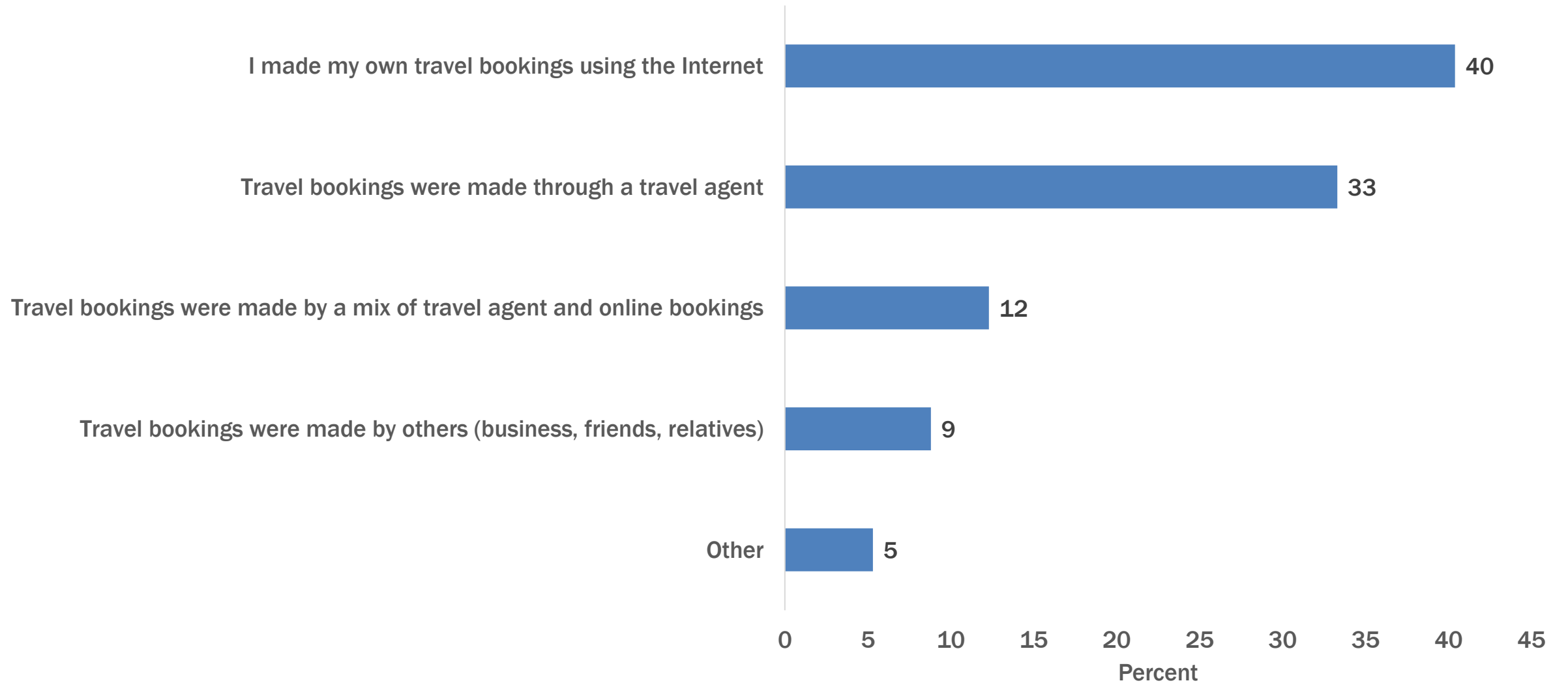

# Importance of Information Sources Used For Planning



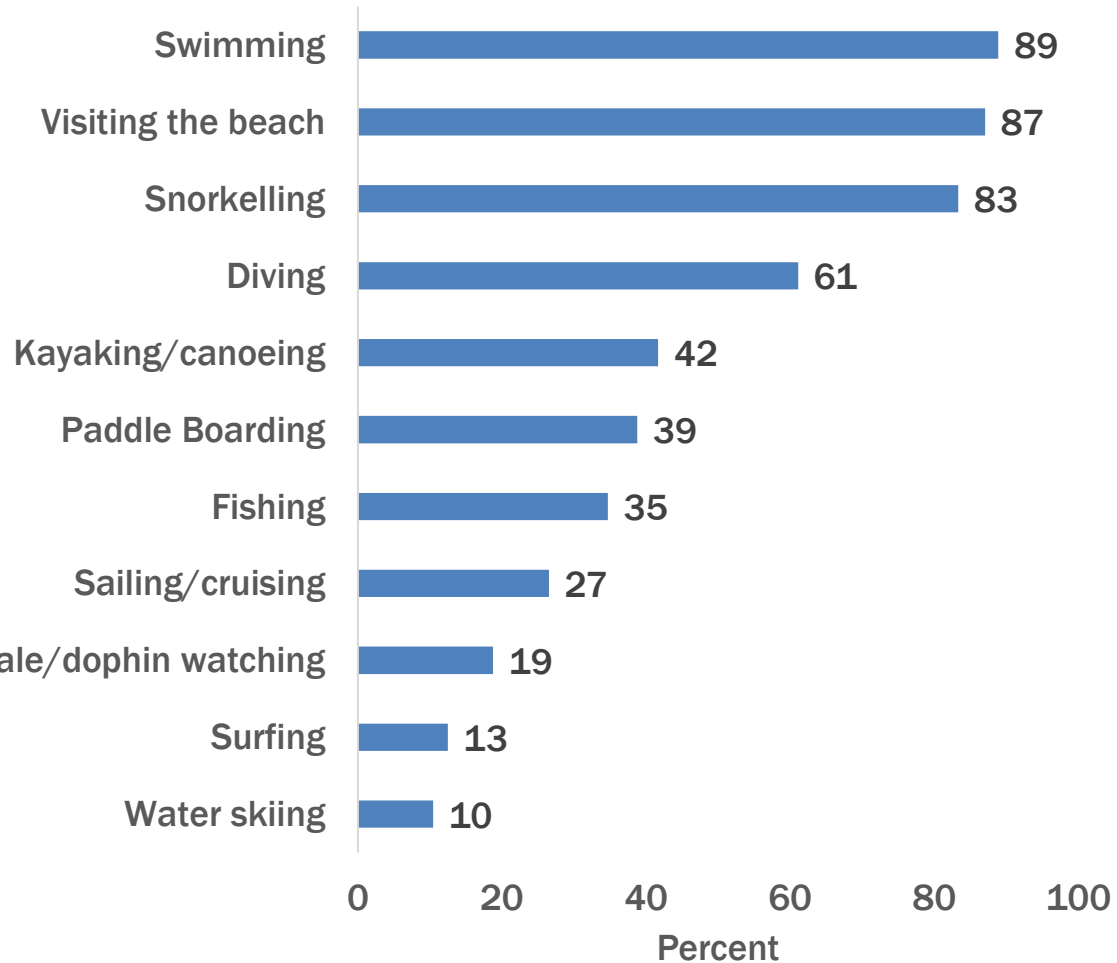

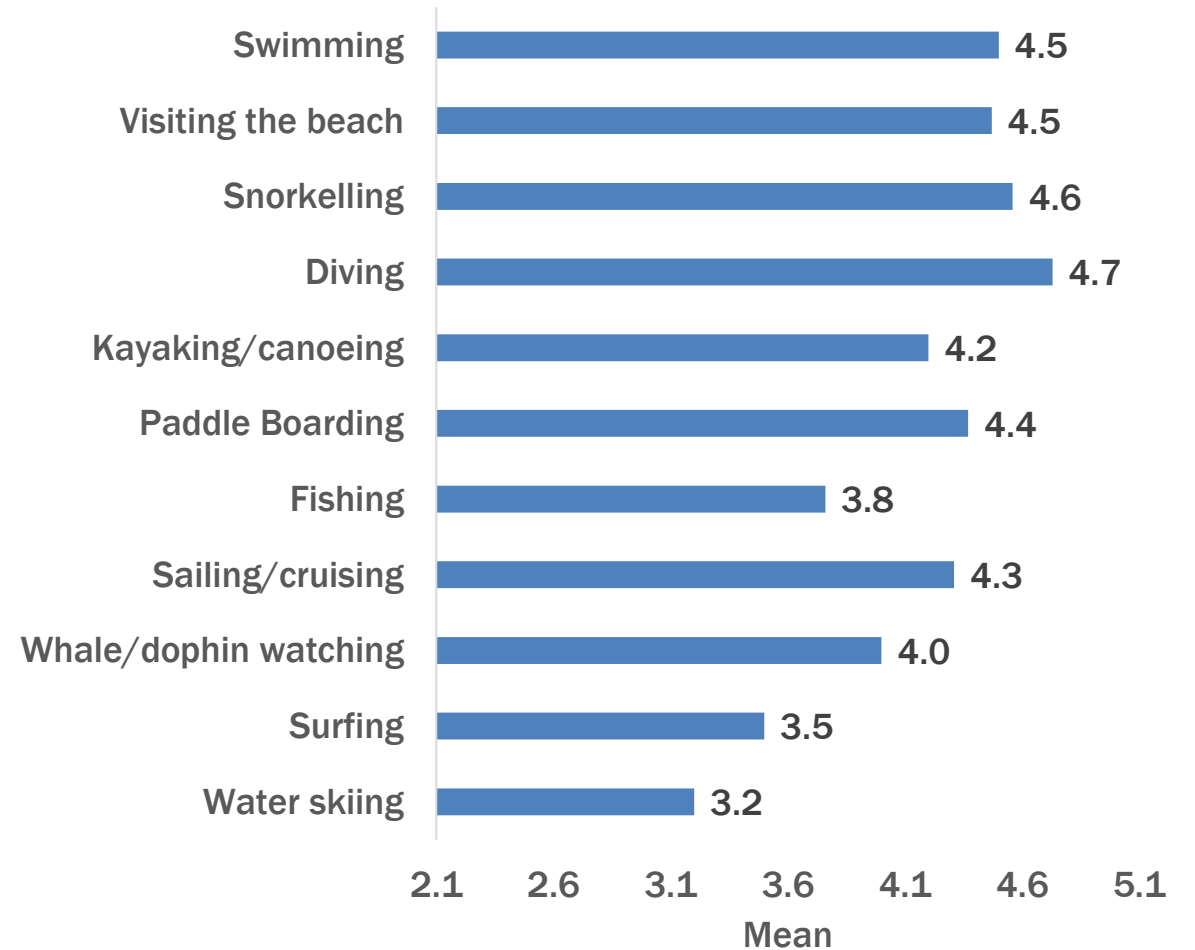

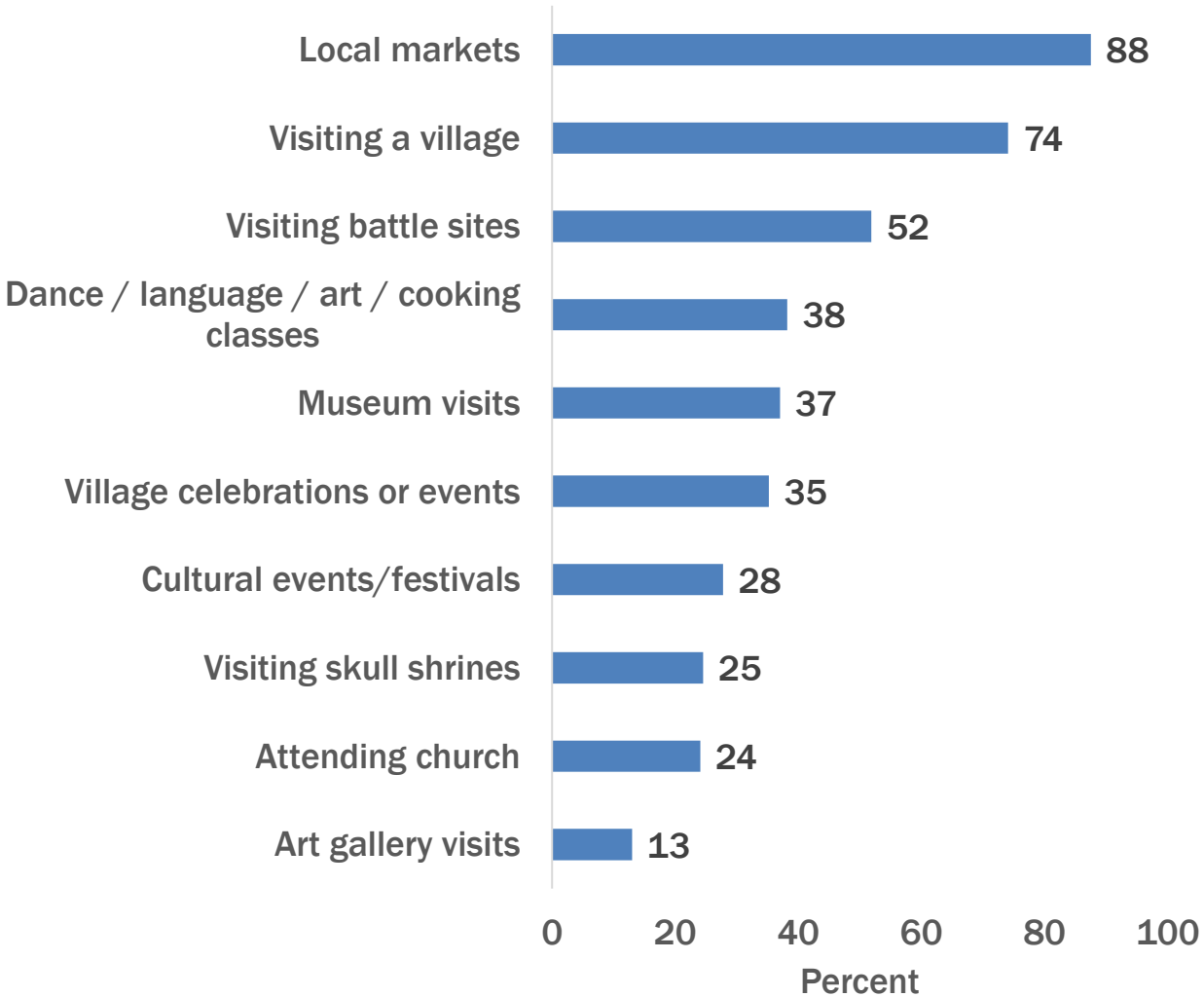

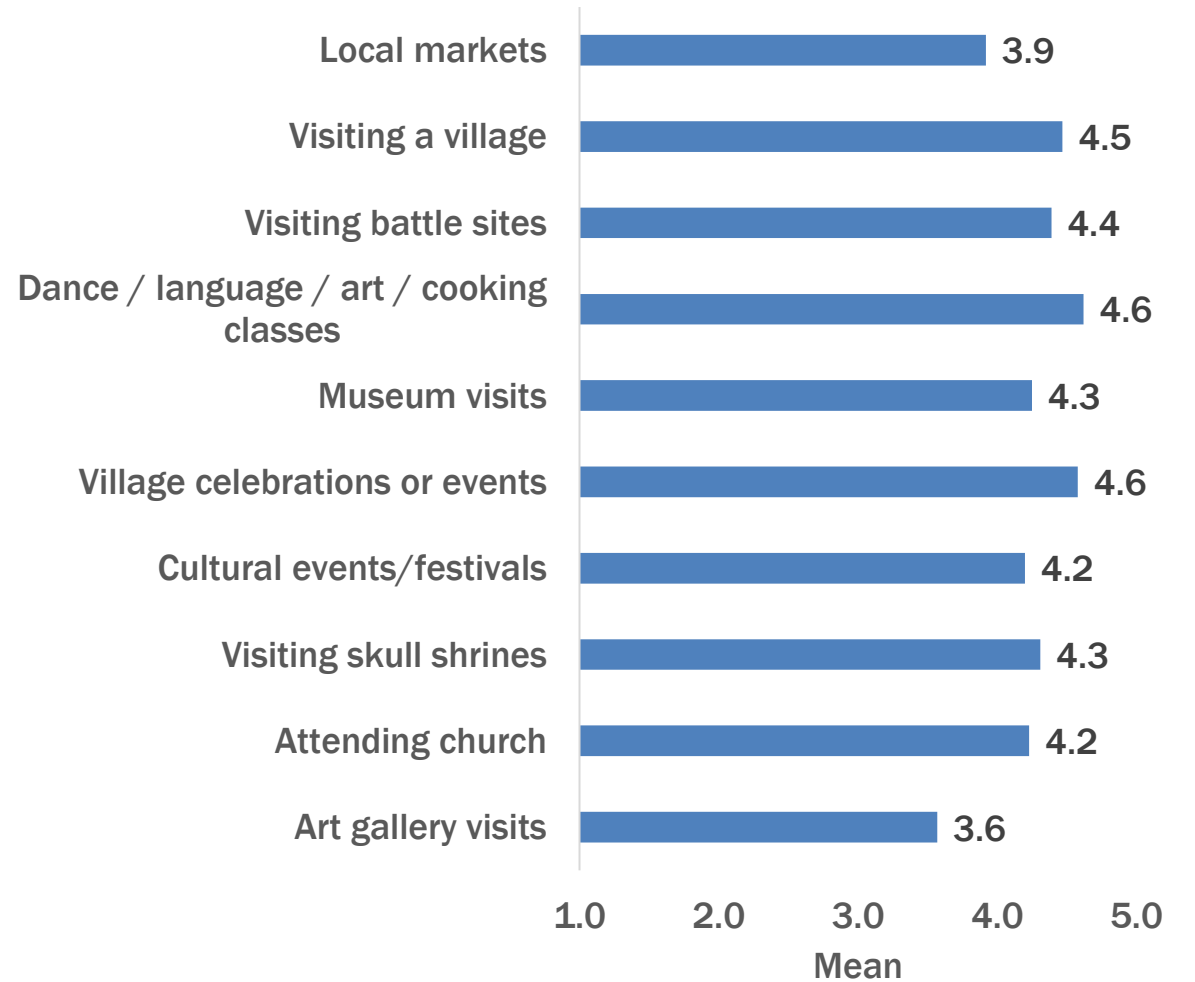

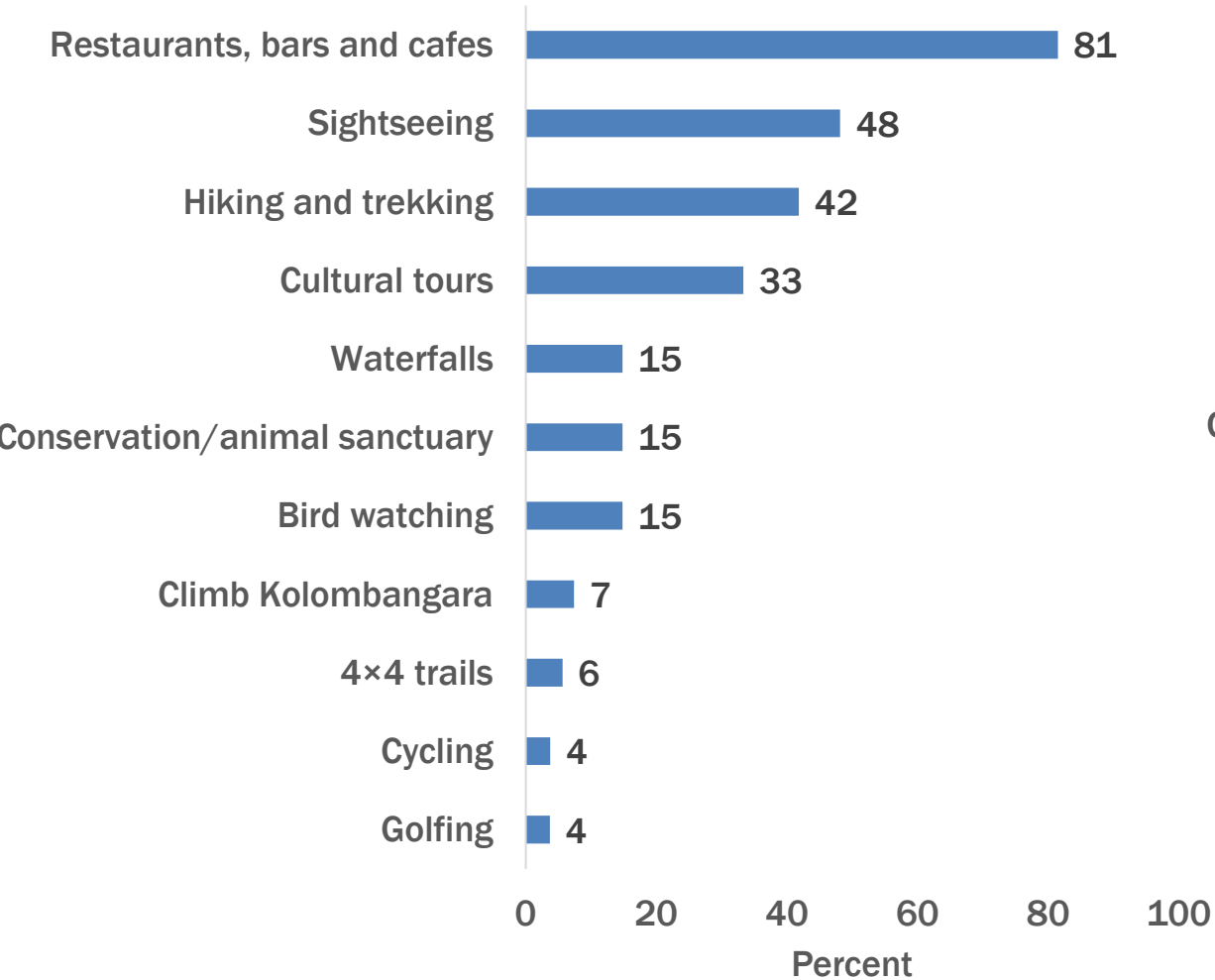

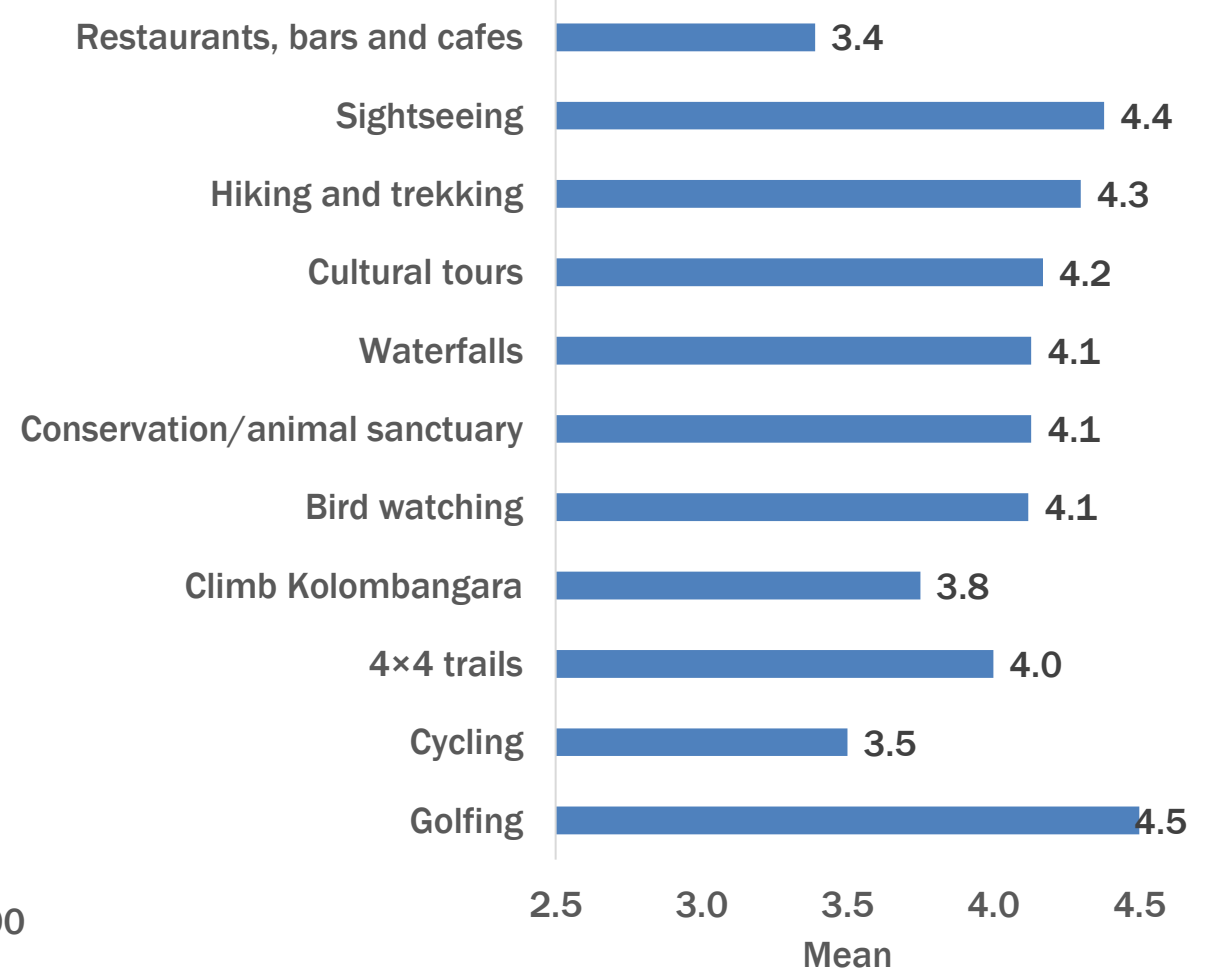

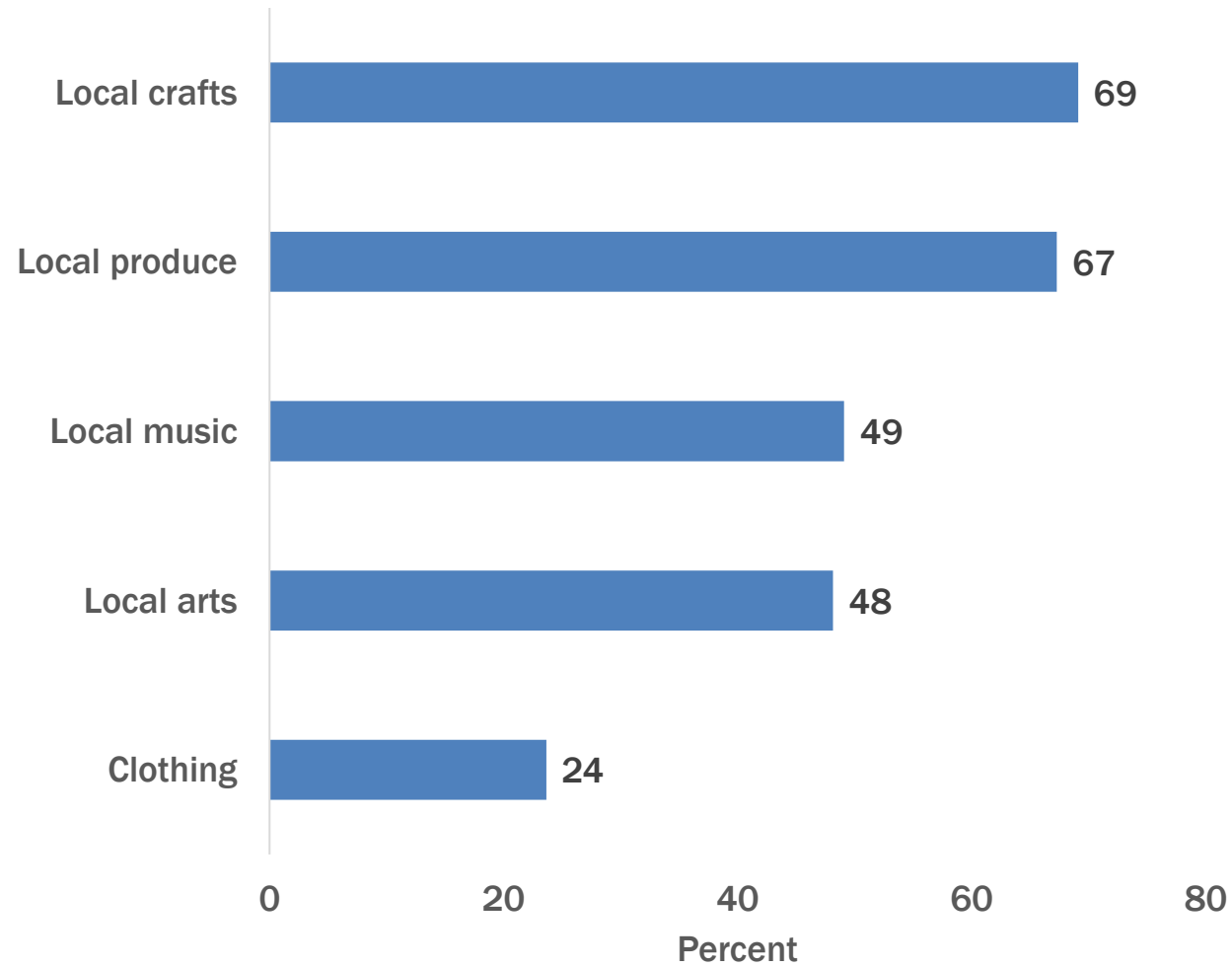

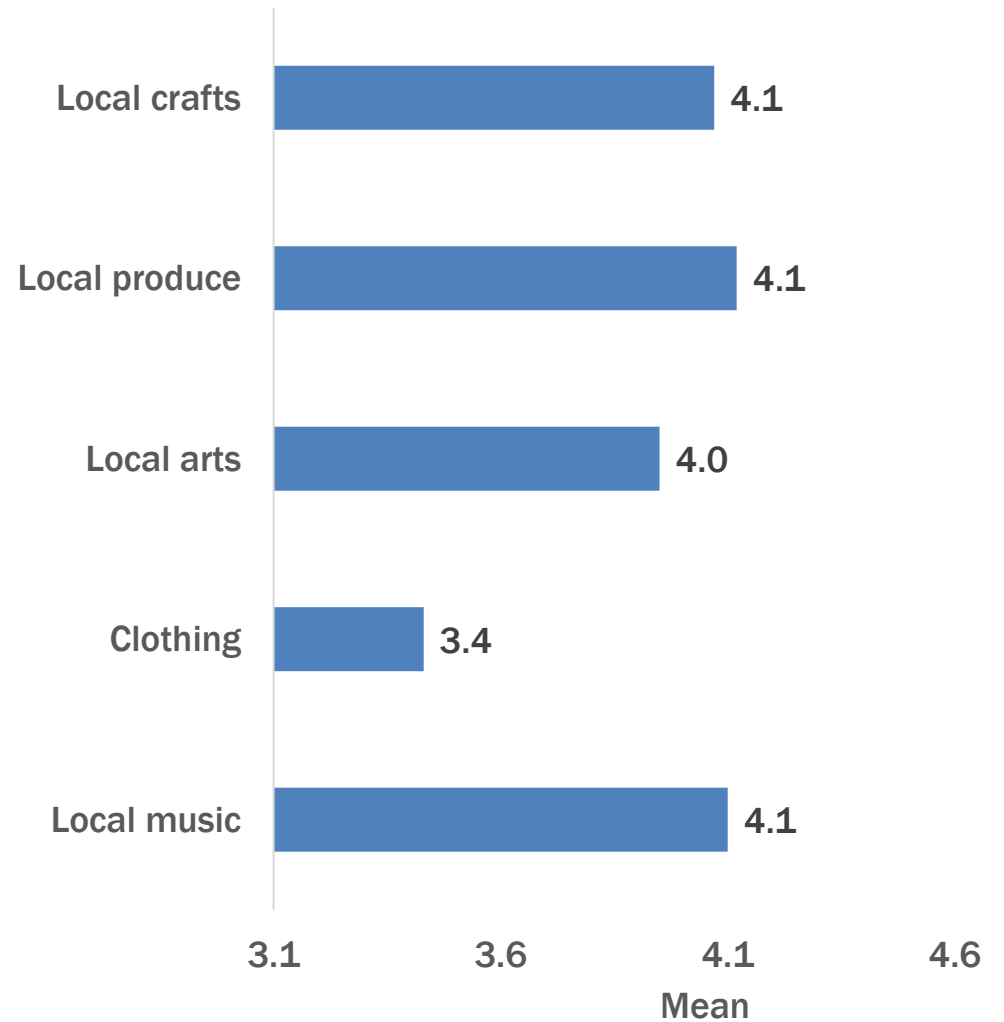

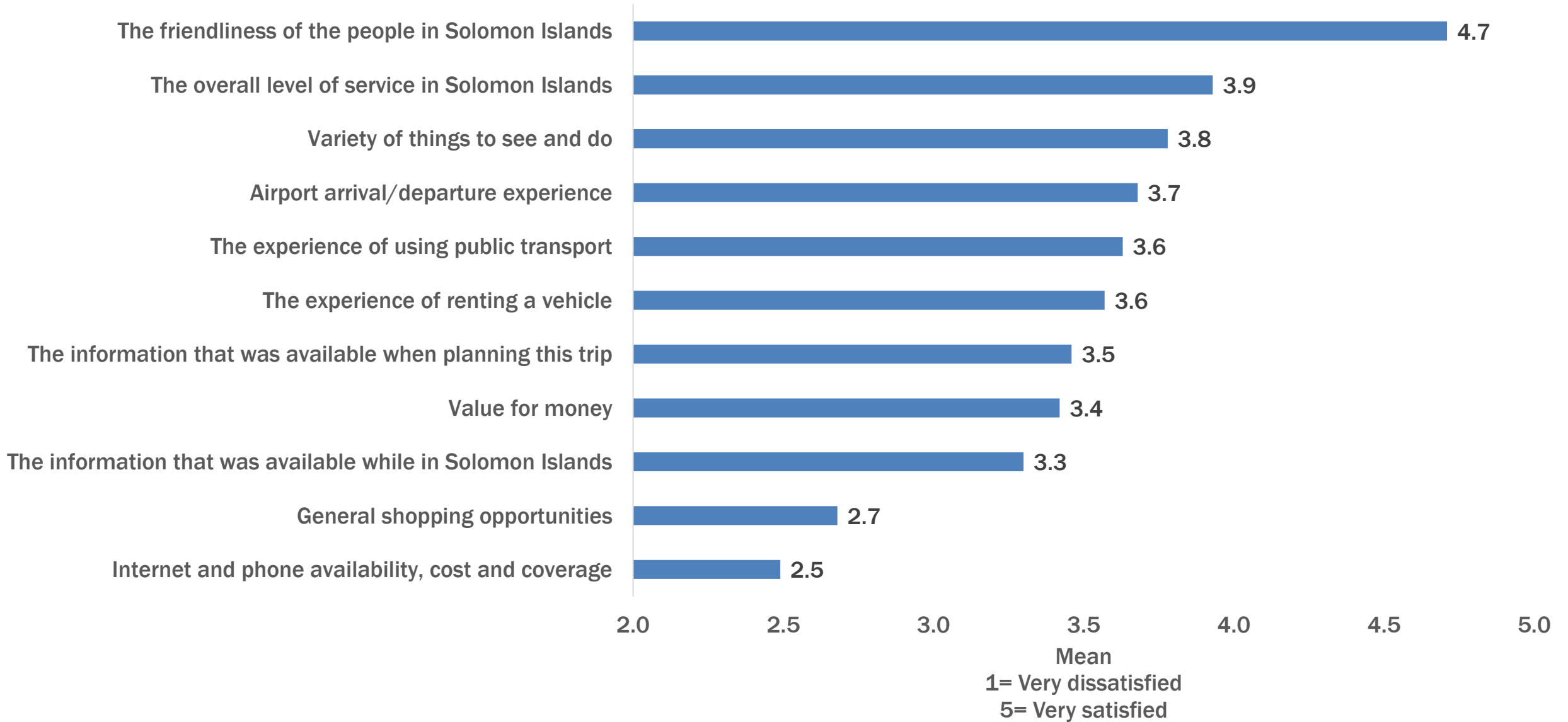

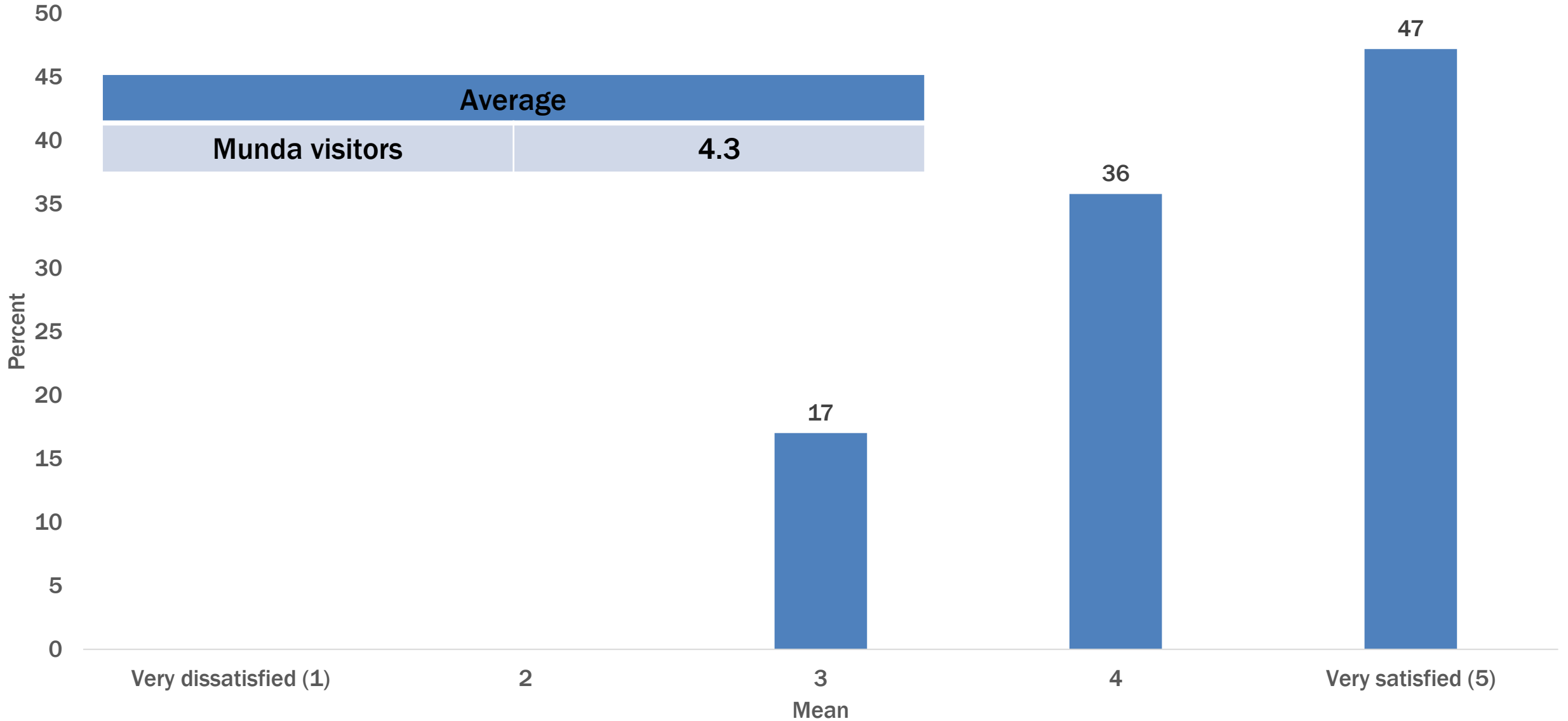
