Christchurch Hospital

Located in central Christchurch, on the edges of Hagley Park, this hospital has over 25 operating theatres covering all operative specialties in both elective and acute work.

Our recently completed Waipapa building is a state of the art Acute Services Unit with 12 operating theatres, Interventional Radiology Suites, a 48 bed Intensive Care Unit and the busiest emergency department in Australasia, which treats more than 83,000 acute patients every year.

Te Nikau - Greymouth

Te Nīkau, Grey Hospital & Health Centre, located in Greymouth on the West Coast of New Zealand's South Island, is a modern health facility that opened in July of 2020. From the most urgent and seriously unwell people, who require emergency or specialist care to those with planned appointments to see their general practice team, there is time and space at Te Nīkau, Grey Hospital & Health Centre for everyone who needs health care. It's bright, modern and designed to support the very best care. The views out to the coast and hills are stunning – the design makes the most of the natural light and beauty of the Coast.

With a building footprint of 8,500m², Te Nīkau Hospital & Health Centre has been designed to support flexible ways of working.

- 56 in-patient beds
- Two negative pressure rooms
- Three operating theatres
- Whānau/Family room & Whare Karakia/Chapel
- Four transitional care units

The facility also houses a 24/7 emergency department, critical care unit, acute and planned medical and surgical services, urgent care, maternity services and outpatient care, radiology, laboratory, kitchen, allied health services and children's ward.



A bit about Greymouth...

Greymouth is a town on the west coast of New Zealand's South Island. Its History House Museum has exhibits chronicling the town's mining and jade-hunting past. With its iconic clock tower and rugged coast, it is the gateway to the West Coast

To the south, Shantytown Heritage Park is a re-created gold rush town with a museum and steam train.

North of Greymouth, the Point Elizabeth Walkway winds along coastal clifftops to the forests of Rapahoe Scenic Reserve, home to abundant birdlife.
