
Professor Duncan Reid DHSc, MHSc (Hons), BSc

Research specialisation: Injury incidence and prevention, awareness of concussion in sport

Experience: Duncan has had 37 years of clinical experience in Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy. His main areas of research are in Sports Injury Incidence and Prevention.

Duncan's experience in Sports Physiotherapy is extensive having been a member of the Olympic and Commonwealth Games Medical team from 1988 until the Sydney Olympics in 2000 and was Chief Physiotherapist for the 1992, 1994 and 1996 Games. He has also been the physiotherapist and physiotherapy coordinator to Rowing New Zealand since 1988. Duncan is the Physiotherapy Advisor for High Performance Sport NZ monitoring the services of physiotherapist's to over 150 elite athletes and supervising research projects in this area. He also has a strong research interest in manual and manipulative therapy especially manipulation to the cervical spine, a topic he has taught both nationally and internationally for over 25 years. He is the past president of the New Zealand Manipulative Physiotherapists Association (NZMPA) and past vice President of the International Federation of Orthopaedic Manipulative Therapists (IFOMT). He is a Fellow of the New Zealand College of Physiotherapy and a life member of NZMPA and Physiotherapy NZ.

He is the deputy editor for the journal, Manual and Manipulative Therapy, Associate Editor for the Journal of Orthopaedic Sports Physical Therapy and is on the Editorial panel of the journals Musculoskeletal Science and Practice, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation and the New Zealand Journal of Sports Medicine.
