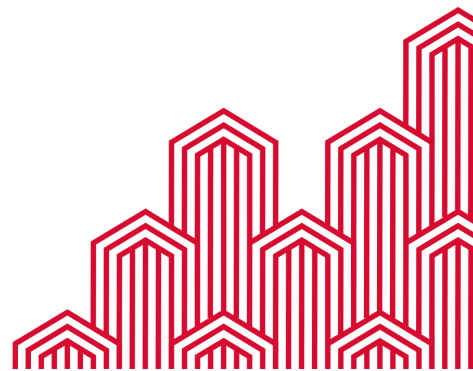

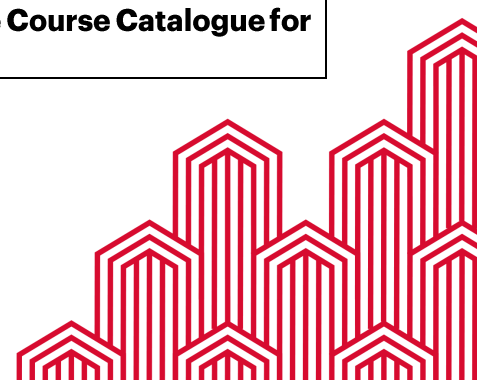
## DRESS CODE

The following forms must be filled for nominations to be complete: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">For Hospitality students</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">For Culinary Arts students</a></li> </ul> </li> <li>2. Students will then receive an email from Institut LYFE with information about how to apply and the online application form.</li> <li>3. Once the application is received, a confirmation receipt will be sent by email.</li> <li>4. 2 weeks after the closing date, students will receive an email to confirm the outcome of their application. Should it be successful, an acceptance letter will also be sent to their email address.</li> <li>5. A mobility Information Pack will be sent by email to all accepted students.</li> <li>6. Accepted students will have to register on our administrative platform and pay a <b>mandatory 300€ fee for on-campus meals</b>. This amount is <b>non-refundable</b>, even if it is not fully used.</li> </ol> <p><b>⚠ Courses are delivered in semester blocks; therefore, students are required to enroll in all the courses listed in the Course Catalogue for the chosen semester.</b></p>
