

# THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS STUDIES

#### A PIONEER WITHIN BUSINESS STUDIES

The department of Business Studies at Uppsala University was founded in 1958, when Sune Carlson was appointed its first professor. With a background from Stockholm School of Economics, and as head of the United Nation's Bureau of Economic Affairs in New York, he became a pioneer in establishing international business as a research field within business studies.

#### A MODERN UNIVERSITY GIANT

Now situated at Ekonomikum, the department has grown considerably since the days of Professor Carlson. Today it is one of the largest departments at the University with close to 150 employees.

The 3,500 students enrolled at the department each year can choose between both classical and trendy topics. We provide courses in accounting and finance, business law, entrepreneurship, international business, marketing and organizational studies. Prepare yourself for a Scandinavian pedagogical style, with group discussions, problem solving and critical reflection at the centre.

#### INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION

Besides a strong teaching profile, the department's research achievements are also noteworthy. The department's international business profile is visible in the well-known internationalization process (IP) model that was developed by researchers at the department. The department is also well recognized for its research on business networks, and for its contributions to new institutional theory. A number of new PhD students joint us each year, and we proudly host a large national research school in management and information technology (MIT).

#### LANGUAGE AND ENGLISH REQUIREMENT

We do not require any tests proving the level of English language, but nominated students are required to have sufficient knowledge of English in order to attend the classes. People in Sweden are generally very good at speaking English, making it very easy for international students to get around. The Department of Business Studies offers a selection of courses taught in English. For those who want, Swedish language courses can be taken in addition to the regular academic programme.
