

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION

A graduate of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Education** will be able to:

- a. Demonstrate advanced knowledge and understanding of specific educational contexts and papers (*Knowledge/Understanding*)
- b. Evaluate research-based and theoretical knowledge pertaining to the field of education through independent scholarship and research (*Personal and Intellectual Autonomy*)
- c. Engage in ongoing self-analysis of learning and practice to continue self and professional development (*Personal and Intellectual Autonomy*)
- d. Act with integrity in research and its application in educational and cultural contexts, especially through understanding and enacting obligations of Te Tiriti o Waitangi and mātauranga Māori. (*Ethical and Professional Dispositions*)
- e. Creatively apply knowledge to problematising, understanding or addressing problems of educational policy and practice (*Inquiry, Research and Creativity*)
- f. Clearly communicate their understanding to others through multiple means, both simple and complex (*Communication*)

A graduate of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Education (Education Practice)** will be able to meet the above requirements related to an education practice context.

A graduate of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Education (Educational Leadership)** will be able to meet the above requirements related to an education leadership context.

A graduate of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Education (Higher Education)** will be able to meet the above requirements related to a higher education context.
