

## Te Ara Poutama, the Faculty of Māori & Indigenous Development Auckland University of Technology

### Visiting Fellowships Programme

Te Ara Poutama, the Faculty of Māori & Indigenous Development at Auckland University of Technology, operates a programme for senior academics from other universities as Visiting Fellows of the faculty.

Visiting Fellows are encouraged to work on joint research projects with Te Ara Poutama staff, deliver guest lectures, or other suitable cooperative activities. While these Fellowships are non-stipendiary, some facilities may be made available to assist in approved cooperative activities. The aim is to broaden the academic experience of both the Visiting Fellow and the relevant academic staff from the Faculty, and to foster inter-university academic cooperation, particularly in the area of research. Visiting Fellowships at Te Ara Poutama may be held concurrently with a similar fellowship at another college or university.

Our general criteria for the selection of Visiting Fellows include:

- evidence of scholarship on any aspect of indigenous studies, language revitalisation, development studies, or a related discipline approved by Te Ara Poutama;
- willingness to work collaboratively and in a way that is respectful to indigenous values;
- commitment to producing research of a high standard
- enthusiasm to foster ongoing academic relationships with staff from Te Ara Poutama.

Application for a Visiting Fellowship should be made on the attached form, and must be accompanied by a two-page curriculum vitae and a covering letter. Applications have to be received at the Te Ara Poutama office by no later than 31 May each year. Visiting Fellowships commence on 01 August. Options of the terms of the Visiting Fellowships appear on the application form.

In some cases, a Visiting Fellowship may be granted even if the Visiting Fellow is unable to visit Te Ara Poutama in person. Technology can enable collaborative projects to be undertaken from the respective universities of the academics involved. This option is available on the application form.
