

# Doug Parke Memorial Scholarship

**Closing date: 31 October**

AUT Business School, in conjunction with a generous donation from a family estate, is pleased to offer a scholarship to a student who is entering his or her second or third year in the Bachelor of Business and is majoring in Accounting. The purpose of the scholarship is to offer support to a student who is in need of financial assistance to continue with his or her study.

## AMOUNT AND TYPE OF AWARD

- There is one Doug Parke Memorial Scholarship offered on a contestable basis each year.
- This scholarship consists of a contribution towards fees of \$1,200 for the Bachelor of Business (for full-time study - 120 points).

## TENURE

- The tenure of this scholarship is for up to one year of full-time study in the Bachelor of Business.

## CRITERIA

All applicants for these scholarships must:

- Be New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.
- Be full-time students enrolling for their second or third year in the Bachelor of Business and enrolling in an Accounting major.
- Have successfully completed their first year of study with a high level of academic achievement.

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Application for this scholarship is through the AUT online scholarship portal. Applicants must upload:

- A written statement outlining the applicant's need for financial assistance to fund their second or third year of study in the Bachelor of Business.
- Written evidence to demonstrate major financial difficulties in the applicant commencing his or her second or third year of study in the Bachelor of Business.

## CONDITIONS OF SELECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

- Short-listed applicants may be required to attend an interview.
- Recipients will be selected under the supervision of the AUT Foundation who shall convene a scholarship selection panel to consider applicants.
- The panel will comprise a representative from the Faculty of Business Economics and Law, a Student Services representative, and an AUT Foundation Trustee.
- The decision of the scholarship selection panel is final. If the panel is of opinion that there is no applicant of sufficient merit, the scholarship will not be awarded.
- The award of this scholarship is conditional on the recipient gaining entry to and enrolling full-time in the second or third year of the Bachelor of Business programme, majoring in Accounting.

- The recipient may be required to participate in service activities organised by the Faculty of Business Economics and Law.
- This scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other fees scholarship. The recipient may hold additional non-tuition fee-based scholarships with the approval of the Faculty of Business Economics and Law.
- The Faculty of Business Economics and Law in conjunction with the AUT Foundation has the power to terminate or suspend a scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a recipient.
